UM'S BRAY NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (November 26, 2013) - Montana's Brooke Bray has been named the Big Sky Conference Volleyball Player of the Week for the matches played the week of November 18 through November 25.

Bray, a senior from Lake Tapps, Wash., averaged a team-high 3.25 kills on .380 hitting and 2.0 blocks per set as Montana defeated both Sacramento State and Montana State to end the regular season on a three-match winning streak.

In Saturday's five-set win over the Hornets, Bray matched a career high with 19 kills on .485 hitting and added eight blocks. In Monday's 3-0 sweep over the Bobcats, Bray had seven kills on .176 hitting and added eight more blocks as the Grizzlies won at Bozeman for the eighth straight year.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Ashley Wright, Eastern Washington - Wright wrapped up her Eastern career on a high note, recording 10 kills on Eastern's 16 swings in its four-set victory over Weber State last Saturday, Nov. 23. She hit .625 (10-0-16) against the Wildcats, adding two digs and a block. She went for three kills and a match-high five blocks versus Idaho State last Thursday, adding two digs.

Makenzie Filer, Idaho State - Filer posted a career high 13 total blocks in Saturday's five set loss to Portland State. She also posted 15 kills...On Thursday, in the Bengals' three-set win over Eastern Washington, Filer posted 11 kills on 19 attempts with only two errors for a .474 attack percentage.

Brooke Bray, Montana - Bray averaged a team-high 3.25 kills on .380 hitting and 2.0 blocks per set as Montana defeated both Sacramento State and Montana State to end the regular season on a three-match winning streak...In Saturday's five-set win over the Hornets, Bray matched a career high with 19 kills on .485 hitting and added eight blocks. In Monday's 3-0 sweep over the Bobcats, Bray had seven kills on .176 hitting and added eight more blocks as the Grizzlies won at Bozeman for the eighth straight year.

Lisa Parlich, North Dakota - Parlich helped UND earn its first-ever Big Sky Conference title with a pair of sweeps this week. The senior hit .591 in a huge win over Northern Arizona Thursday. She finished 15 balls on just 22 swings in the win adding four total blocks. The Big Sky Conference's leader in hitting then tallied seven kills and five total blocks Saturday to clinch the league title in her final home match. She went over 400 blocks in her career and inched within 26 kills of 1,000 at UND...For the week, Parlich recorded 22 kills on 44 swings with eight attack errors (.318).

Andrea Spaustat, Northern Colorado - Spaustat had a well-rounded weekend for the Bears, helping them to two wins, but her biggest contribution came at the service line. She combined for eight service aces, with no errors against Southern Utah and Northern Arizona, a pair of victories that secured a playoff spot for Northern Colorado. Spaustat had 13 kills, eight digs and a career-high six aces against the Lumberjacks Saturday, and she finished with 20 kills (2.50 per set) while hitting .240, 11 digs and four total blocks for the weekend.

Garyn Schlatter, Portland State - Schlatter led the Vikings to a pair of victories on the final week of the regular season. She helped Portland State secure a share of the Big Sky Regular Season Championship with 94 total assists (10.44 aps) along with 10 kills, 17 digs, seven blocks and a pair of service aces. Schlatter helped the Vikings finish the regular season with a season-high nine-match winning streak...Schlatter, a native of Canby, Ore., started the week with 39 assists in a win at Weber State. She posted three kills, seven digs, four blocks, and a pair of aces in the win over the Wildcats...Schlatter, in the final regular season match of her career, posted a season-high 55 assists in the Vikings' five-set comeback win over Idaho State. She spread the ball around the court allowing three Vikings to post double-figure kills. She finished with seven kill for the match including PSU's final two points to secure the 15-12 win in the fifth and decisive set. She added 10 digs for her team-leading ninth double-double of the season...Schlatter has 1,146 assists for the season (10.71 assists per set) to go along with 209 digs, 112 kills, and 81 total blocks including five solo blocks.
