UND'S PIOSKE NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (November 4, 2013) - North Dakota's Anna Pioske has been named the Big Sky Conference Volleyball Player of the Week for the matches played the week of October 28 through November 3.

Freshman Pioske recorded 44 combined kills in a pair of road wins for North Dakota this week. Pioske tallied a career-best 23 kills finishes in a five-set win at Idaho State. The outside hitter added eight digs and five total blocks. Six of her kills came in the fifth set alone on just eight swings without an error.

Saturday, she tallied 21 kills with eight digs and four total blocks to help UND defeat Weber State, 3-1, and clinch a berth into the Big Sky Conference Tournament. It marked the 17th win in its last 19 matches and gave UND a 13-1 league mark, two games ahead of Portland State.

Again, she saved her best for the final set, hammering home seven of her kills in that fourth frame on 12 swings without an error.

For the week, Pioske averaged 4.89 kills, 1.78 digs and 1.0 blocks per set. She hit .341 with 44 kills on 91 attempts with 13 errors.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Kelsey Julian, Eastern Washington - Julian was Eastern's best player this past weekend, notching her first career double-double against Montana on Thursday before propelling the Eagles to a win over Montana State on Saturday. She tallied a team-high 16 kills against the Griz to go along with a career-best 10 digs. She recorded 45 total attacks against Montana, committing just four errors. Julian led EWU with 12 kills against Montana State on just 23 swings, adding six digs. She hit .309 for the weekend and averaged 3.50 kills per set and 2.00 digs per set.

Lori Mendenhall-Lee, Idaho State - Mendenhall-Lee posted 52 assists in the Bengals 3-2 loss to North Dakota on Friday and 40 in the Bengals sweep of Northern Colorado...Against North Dakota, she also posted seven digs, four blocks and three kills. Against Northern Colorado, she posted eight digs, two blocks and two kills.

Kayla Reno, Montana - Reno averaged 3.43 kills on .149 hitting as Montana split at home against Eastern Washington and Portland State. In Thursday's 3-1 win over the Eagles that gave the Grizzlies their first season sweep of EWU since 1995, Reno had a team-high 15 kills on .218 hitting and added 14 digs and 2 blocks. In Saturday's 3-0 loss to Portland State, Reno had 9 kills and 9 digs.

Kennadie Clute, Montana State - Despite dropping a pair of matches, Montana State freshman Kennadie Clute had a monster weekend for the Bobcats averaging a whopping 6.00 kills per set, while hitting a respectable .218 from the floor. In addition, Clute averaged 1.86 digs per set. She had her best match of the weekend against Eastern Washington, pounding down 27 kills in four sets. She finished with a .241 attack mark, while chipping in eight digs. Against Portland State, Clute recorded 15 kills and five digs. On the season, she has been in double-figure kills in all 25 matches. Clute is the top freshman in the nation in kills and points per set and ranks among the top 25 in the country in both categories, as well.

Janae Vander Ploeg, Northern Arizona - Vander Ploeg continued her hot play of late with an 18-kill performance in NAU's sweep of Sacramento State Saturday night. Her 18 kills led all players and she hit .417, also the best percentage of any player in the match. Her final two kills of the night finished off the victory after the Hornets held off five match points to force a 24-24 tie in the third set. Vander Ploeg also picked up five digs to continue her streak this season of totaling at least five digs in every match as well as three of the Lumberjacks' four service aces. Over her last seven matches, Vander Ploeg is averaging 3.86 kills per set and has reached the 18-kill plateau on four occasions.

Ashley Guthrie, Northern Colorado - Guthrie added a new accomplishment to her young career this weekend, recording her first triple-double in a close, five-set loss to Weber State. Guthrie had 50 assists, 10 digs and a career-high 10 kills in the match. She doubled her previous career-high of five kills while hitting .833 on 12 attempts with no errors. The next night, Guthrie recorded 36 assists, five kills and three digs at Idaho State. Combined for the weekend, Guthrie collected 86 assists (10.7 per set), 13 digs (1.62 per set), two block assists and 15 kills (1.88 per set) while hitting .750 on 20 attacks with no errors.

Aubrey Mitchell, Portland State - Mitchell helped the Vikings to a perfect 3-0 Big Sky Conference week while they dropped just one set in the process. Mitchell tallied 31 kills (3.10 kills per set) while hitting .328 (31-10-64) in PSU's three road victories. She also added seven blocking assists to score 34.5 points...Mitchell and the Vikings started the week by defeating Eastern Washington in four sets. She tallied 10 kills in the match with four blocking assists. Mitchell has been the closer for the Vikings all season long and she continued that trend finishing out two of the four sets, including the fourth, with kills...Mitchell tallied eight kills hitting .583 at Montana State Friday night while recording just one attacking error in the process. The Vikings spread the ball around with five players having six or more kills with the team leader only tallying 10. Mitchell added a blocking assist in the match...Mitchell recorded a match-high 13 kills in the Vikings three-set sweep of Montana Saturday night to finish out the week. She hit .400 against the Grizzlies marking the sixth time this season that she hit over .400 with at least 10 kills in a match. She again added a pair of blocking assists for a match-high 14.0 points...Mitchell leads Portland State with 148 kills (3.02 kps) in Big Sky action and is hitting .308, ninth in the league. She also has 41 total blocks including a pair of solo blocks. Her 3.46 points per set is also tops on the team in league play.

Audrey Biggs, Weber State - Biggs, a 6-foot-1 native of Pleasant Grove, Utah, averaged 3.67 kills per set in helping the Wildcats to a split during two home matches over the weekend...In nine total sets, Biggs had 33 kills, 15 digs, and scored 36 total points, while hitting .207...During Weber State's thrilling five-set win over Northern Colorado on Friday, she had a match high 19 kills and hit .325, helping the Wildcats to earn a season sweep of the Bears...Against North Dakota on Saturday, Biggs had 14 kills, two service aces and two blocks as Weber State went toe-to-toe with the league-leaders.
