## **Player of the Week - Dec. 10, 2013**

### **Tim Douglas, G, Portland State**

**OGDEN, Utah (Dec 10 2013)** - Portland State's Tim Douglas has been selected as the Big Sky Conference men's basketball player of the week.

Douglas, a 5-foot-10, junior guard from Cerritos, Calif., scored a career-high 27 points with six rebounds, four steals and three assists in a loss to the University of Portland on Saturday, Dec. 7.

Douglas, who transferred to Portland State from Portland, made 8-of-20 shots from the floor, was 5-of-8 from 3-point range and 6-of-9 from the free-throw line. Douglas's six rebounds and four steals were the most he's recorded in a Viking uniform.

This is Douglas' first career Player of the Week honor.

## THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

All 11 Big Sky teams are in action this week in men's basketball...Northern Colorado takes on Colorado Christian on Tuesday night, and then battles UC Riverside in Greeley on Monday, Dec. 16...The Idaho State Bengals look to move to 4-2 as it travels to Utah on Tuesday night. The game will be televised live on the Pac-12 Network. ISU is back on the Pac-12 Network on Saturday as it travels to Washington...Weber State returns to action to face Utah Valley on Wednesday night...North Dakota hits the road Wednesday to face Bowling Green. UND is at home on Sunday against Presentation College...Montana hits the court after a long layoff to take on Idaho in Missoula on Wednesday night. The Griz are also at home on Sunday against St. Martins...Portland State plays host to Idaho on Saturday, while Sacramento State is at home against William Jessup...Southern Utah plays one of the biggest non-conference home games in school history as UNLV comes to Cedar City on Saturday...Northern Arizona takes on Grand Canyon on Saturday at the Walkup Skydome in Flagstaff. The game will be televised live on Fox Sports Arizona...On Sunday, Eastern Washington welcomes UC Irvine to Cheney. The game will be televised live on SWX...Montana State returns to action on Sunday to face the Portland Pilots of the West Coast Conference.

## Around the Big Sky

**RPI REPORT:** The first RPI Report from the Collegiate Basketball News was released this week. Eastern Washington leads the Big Sky with an RPI of 73. North Dakota is second at 106, followed by Idaho State at 125 and Northern Colorado at 170. The Big Sky is rated 23rd out of the 32 Division I conferences. The Big Sky is just behind the Big South and ahead of the Northeast Conference. The Big 12 is rated as the No. 1 conference, followed by the Big Ten, the Big East and the Pac-12. UMass holds the No. 1 overall RPI, followed by Kansas, Wisconsin, and Baylor.

**TOUGH SCHEDULES:** North Dakota's schedule is currently rated the fifth toughest in the nation. North Dakota has taken on Oregon, Wisconsin and Butler, as well as Cal Poly, North Dakota State, and Pacific in Division I games. All but the North Dakota State game was played on the road. Wisconsin has an RPI of 3. Oregon has an RPI of 15. Eastern Washington's schedule is rated 57th. The Eagles recently lost to Saint Mary's, which has an RPI of eight. EWU takes on UConn later this month. The Huskies have an RPI of nine. Idaho State's schedule is rated 84th toughest, and Weber State's is rated 94th. The Big Sky's non-conference schedule strength is rated as the 11th toughest in the nation. The Big Sky is currently 17-43 against Division I teams.

**WANT TO PLAY?:** Weber State has played just four games so far this season. The Wildcats were slated to play at Texas-Arlington last Saturday night, but the game was postponed because of poor weather in the Arlington area. Weber State is one of just four teams in the nation to enter the week having played fewer than five games. Weber State will play its fifth game of the season Wednesday night at Utah Valley, where the Wildcats haven't played in eight years, and are 0-2 all-time. It will mark Weber State's fourth game in the state of Utah, as the Wildcats have played two at home, and one at BYU. The only out-of-state game for Weber State was a loss to Colorado State. The game against UT-Arlington has yet to be rescheduled. It was going to be played as a return game as part of the BrackBusters series. UT-Arlington lost at Weber State in February of 2012 on BracketBusters Saturday.

**MID-MAJOR TOP 25:** No Big Sky conference teams are ranked in this week's CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25. Northern Colorado (14) and Eastern Washington (10) are both receiving votes. Weber State, Montana and Northern Colorado have all been ranked this season. Wichita State has maintained is No. 1 ranking. Harvard is second, followed by Gonzaga.

**IN THE NCAA STATS:** Idaho State ranks second in the nation in steals per game with an average of 11.4 VCU is the leader at 12.7 per game. The Bengals are the only Big Sky team to rank in the top 10 of a major statistical category. The Bengals are also 11th in the nation in 3-point field-goal percentage, with a .437 percentage. Northern Colorado is 15th in 3-point field-goal percentage defense (.260). North Dakota is 12th in turnover margin (4.9). Weber State is 16th in turnovers per game at 9.8...Montana is 18th in 3-point field goals per game (9.0). North Dakota's Troy Huff ranks 12th in the nation in scoring at 22.7 points per game. Eastern Washington's Tyler Harvey is 10th in 3-point field goals per game at 3.75. Harvey is 22nd in 3-point field goal percentage (.492)...Sacramento State's Mikh McKinney ranks 20th in free-throw percentage (.917)...ISU's Jeffery Solarin is 21st in field-goal percentage (.625)...ISU's Evan Hall is 23rd in steals per game (2.6).

**Tip-ins:** EWU sophomore Tyler Harvey has scored in double figures in 12 straight games dating back to last season...Eastern Washington has seven foreign players on its roster, which ties Maine and Nicholls for the most among Division I teams...PSU is 4-1 at home this season. The Vikings are 34-5 in non-conference home games at the Stott Center since the start of the 2006-07 season...Montana State's Paul Egwuonwu recorded his third double-double of the season with 14 points and 11 rebounds in a win over Walla Walla...Sacramento State junior guard Dylan Garrity sat out the second half of a loss to UTEP with an ankle injury. Garrity ranks 30th in Big Sky history with 353 assists. He is just three behind former Montana State star Mick Durham, who is the league leader in coaching victories...PSU's Tim Douglas, who sat out last season after transferring from Portland, has scored in double figures in all seven of his games for the Vikings...Weber State senior center Kyle Tresnak needs 93 points to reach 1,000 for this career...
