LAST WEEK IN BIG SKY

* Idaho State fell in the first round of the NCAA Championship to host Hawai'i, 3-1. The Bengals received the automatic berth to the NCAA after winning the conference championship title.

*This was the second time ISU competed at the NCAA. The first appearance came in 1990 when ISU lost to UC Santa Barbara, 3-0.

* A Big Sky team hadn't win a set in the NCAA Tournament since 2009, when Northern Colorado won a set in a 3-1 loss against Washington. The last time a Big Sky team won a set against Hawai'i in the NCAA Tournament was in 2001 when Eastern Washington won a set in a 3-1 loss.

* This was the third time in four season that a Big Sky team played Hawai'i. Portland State lost 3-0 in 2010 and Northern Colorado lost 3-0 in 2011.

IDAHO STATE AT BIG SKY CHAMPIONSHIP

* Idaho State earned the automatic berth to the NCAA Championship after defeating No. 6 seed Northern Colorado, 3-1 in the quarterfinals; No. 2 seed North Dakota, 3-1 in the semifinals and No. 1 seed and tournament host Portland State, 3-0 in the championship.

* It was no easy task for ISU to get to the NCAA Tournament. The Bengals had to play three tough matches in two days to get there.

* Idaho State started out playing the No. 6 seed Northern Colorado. You might recall last season in the championship match where these two teams face each other. ISU had a two set lead going into intermission but NC came out swing to win the championship and head to the NCAA Tournament. The Bengals beat the Bears 3-0 in both Pocatello and Greeley this season.

* After that win, ISU had to play again that night. But this time against the No. 2 seed and co-regular season champion North Dakota. ISU came out on fire, winning the first two sets. They lost the third set to UND but came out in the fourth to win 25-12. North Dakota beat ISU both times during the regular season. ISU lost 3-1 in Grand Forks and 3-2 in Pocatello.

* After that win, ISU hung around to see who they would face in the championship match. It would either be Portland State or Montana. The Grizzlies were coming off a 3-2 win over Northern Arizona that morning and the Vikings dominated the second semifinal match and won 3-0.

* ISU ended up facing the No. 1 seed and tournament host Portland State in the championship match. PSU won both matches during the regular season. It won 3-1 in Portland and a come from behind 3-2 win in Pocatello just a week before.

* Something was just on for the Bengals. They came out to win the first set 25-18. It looked like PSU was going to come back and win the second set as it was up 24-22 but then ISU took a timeout. After the timeout, ISU was able to take the next point off of a kill by tournament Most Valuable Player Makenzie Filer. Another kill by Filer and ISU tied the set at 24. PSU would then go up but ISU had an answer. The set was tied at 27 before ISU took the set with a kill by Tressa Lyman and an attack error by Kaeli Patton.

* After the intermission, the Bengals kept the fire going and took the third set and the win. After the match, Filer was named tournament MVP. She was joined on the all-tournament team by teammates Lori Mendenhall-Lee and Kylee Searle-Sessions.

* Others named to the All-Tournament team were Portland State's Garyn Schlatter, Leigh-Ann Haataja, North Dakota's Ronni Munkeby and Northern Arizona Janae Vander Ploeg.

ISU'S TEICHERT NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE COACH OF THE YEAR

OGDEN, Utah (December 3, 2013) - Idaho State's Chad Teichert has been named the 2013 Big Sky Conference Volleyball Coach of the Year after leading his team to an automatic berth to the NCAA.

The honor is the second for Teichert, who was selected in a vote by his fellow conference coaches. Teichert was also named COY last season after a second-place finish with a 23-8 overall and 16-4 conference records.

Teichert had three players named to the All-Conference team this season. Lori Mendenhall-Lee and Tressa Lyman were both named First Team, while Makenzie Filer was named Honorable Mention.

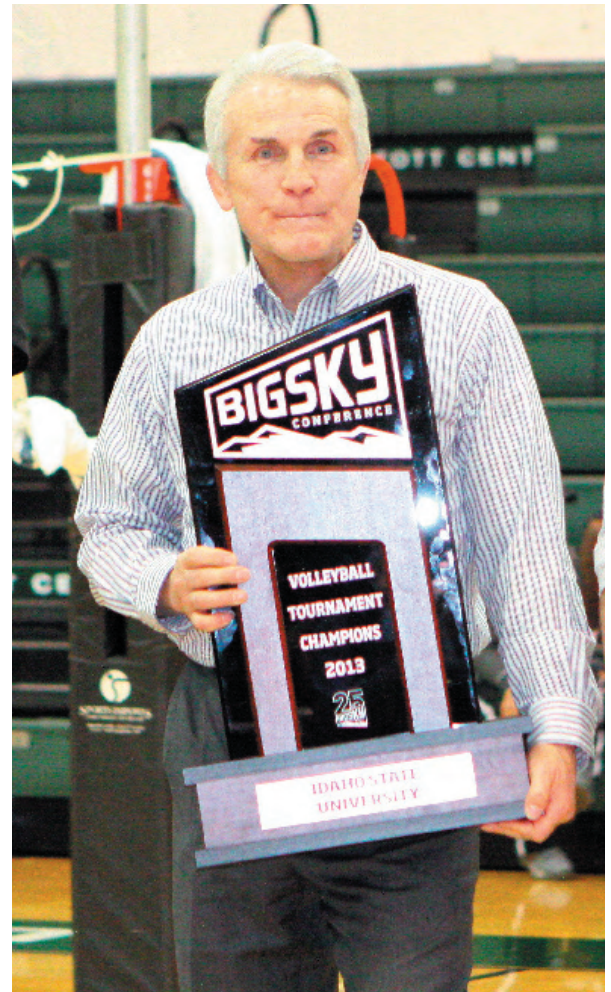
The Bengals, 23-11 overall and 14-6 in league play, were the No. 3 seed at the 2013 Big Sky Conference Championship. They defeated No. 6 seed Northern Colorado 3-1 in the quarterfinals. That same night, ISU defeated co-regular season champion and No. 2 seed North Dakota 3-1. On Saturday, the Bengals came back to defeat the No. 1 seed and tournament host Portland State 3-0.

On Sunday, ISU found out they will be traveling to Honolulu, Hawai'i to face the No. 11 seed Hawai'i at 10:30 p.m. Mountain on Friday. The winner of that match will move to the second round of the NCAA on Saturday at 10 p.m. Mountain.

After the Big Sky Championship, Filer was named tournament Most Valuable Player, while Mendenhall-Lee and Kylee Searle-Sessions were named all-tournament.

Teichert is in his sixth season with Idaho State. Before coming to ISU, Teichert was perhaps the most successful high school coach in Wyoming history, leading three separate schools for a cumulative record of 397-83 (.827), winning 10 state titles in 16 years, including a run of eight straight titles.

His teams at Cokeville (1983-93) Mountain View (1994-98) and Green River (1998-2000) combined to win 43 of the 65 tournaments they entered as well, a .661 tournament championship percentage.
