# **Derrick Barden, F, Northern Colorado & Kareem Jamar, G/F, Montana**

Northern Colorado's Derrick Barden and Montana's Kareem Jamar have been selected as the co-Big Sky Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week for games played from Monday, Dec. 23, through Sunday, Dec. 29.



Barden, a 6-foot-5 senior forward from Detroit, Mich., scored 18 points with 14 rebounds as the Bears opened conference play with an 84-66 conference home win over North Dakota on Dec. 29. Barden made 7-of-11 shots from the floor, and was 4-of-4 from the free-throw line. It was Barden's third double-double of the season. Barden leads the Big Sky in rebounding with an average of 9.2 per game. Barden has been named Big Sky Player of the Week twice this season and three times in his career.



Jamar, a 6-5, senior forward/guard from Venice, Calif., scored 26 points with eight rebounds, three assists and a block in Montana's 72-71 non-conference win at Idaho on Dec. 28. Jamar made two free throws with 4.1 seconds remaining to lift UM to the win. The Grizzlies trailed by as many as 15 points late in the first half. Jamar went 11-of-12 from the free-throw line, making his final 11, including eight in the second half. Jamar made 7-of-10 shots from the floor, and was 1-of-3 from 3-point range. The reigning Big Sky MVP has been named Player of the Week twice this season and six times in his career.

## THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

Ten conference games are on this week's slate...Two-time defending champion Montana is at home, taking on Northern Arizona on Thursday and Sacramento State on Saturday. The Grizzlies have combined to go 34-2 in conference play the last two seasons...Preseason favorite Weber State battles Eastern Washington at home on Thursday and Portland State on Saturday. The Eagles have lost four straight entering conference play...Montana State is at home against Sacramento State on Thursday and NAU on Saturday...Idaho State opens league play at home against Portland State on Thursday, and then welcomes EWU to Pocatello on Saturday...North Dakota returns home to face Southern Utah on Thursday. UND opened league play Sunday with a loss at Northern Colorado...The Bears play host to Southern Utah on Saturday. Northern Colorado is 6-0 at Butler-Hancock Sports Pavilion so far this season, and lead the Big Sky with a 7-3 overall record...Southern Utah enters league play looking to snap an eight-game losing streak.

## Around the Big Sky

**ONE DOWN, 109 TO GO:** Northern Colorado beat North Dakota 84-66 in the first conference game of the 2013-14 season on Sunday. Derrick Barden scored 18 points with 14 rebounds to lead the Bears, who moved to 6-0 at home this season. The Bears went on a 25-0 run in the first half and never looked back. Northern Colorado shot .604 percent from the field and held a 41-25 advantage on the boards. Northern Colorado beat North Dakota to open conference play in 2012-13, but then lost five straight league games. The Bears are at home on Saturday vs. Southern Utah, which enters league play on an eight-game slide. A total of 110 conference games will be played this season, with each of the 11 teams playing 20 conference games. The top seven teams qualify for the Big Sky Championship, which will be played March 13-15 at the site of the regular-season champion.

**PICKING UP FROM LAST YEAR:** Two-time defending league champion Montana opens conference play on Thursday night at home against Northern Arizona, and then takes on Sacramento State at Dahlberg Arena on Saturday. Wayne Tinkle's club enters conference riding a four-game winning streak. Montana won its final five conference games last season en route to a 19-1 league record. Including postseason play, Montana has won 31 straight games over Big Sky teams at home. Montana hasn't lost a home game against a Big Sky team since falling 73-67 to Montana State on Feb. 27, 2010. Montana has won 26 straight over Big Sky teams in regular-season play, a conference record. NAU hasn't won at Montana since 2008. Sacramento State hasn't won at Montana since beating the Grizzlies in a Big Sky first-round game on March 8, 2003. Including the postseason, UM is 38-2 against Big Sky teams the past two seasons, with both losses coming at Weber State.

**RAHE PASSES ABEGGLEN:** Weber State coach Randy Rahe picked up his 153rd career victory on Saturday as the Wildcats beat Northern New Mexico 75-49. Rahe moved past former Weber State coach Ron Abegglen into a tie for seventh place on the Big Sky's all-time win list. Rahe is tied with former Gonzaga and Montana State coach Hank Anderson with 153 wins. Rahe is one win away from tying former Montana coach Mike Montgomery for a tie for sixth place. Montana coach Wayne Tinkle has 146 career victories, and is in 10th place on the Big Sky's all-time wins list. Both Tinkle and Rahe are in their eighth seasons at their respective schools. Former Montana State coach Mick Durham is the all-time leader with 246 career wins. Former Boise State coach Bobby Dye is second with 214. Rahe enters conference play with 92 conference wins, which is fifth-most in league history. He is two wins behind former Weber State coach Neil McCarthy, and just seven behind former Northern Arizona coach Mike Adras. Durham is the all-time leader in conference wins with 123. Dye is second with 102. Tinkle enters conference play with 85 league wins, which ranks seventh in league history. He will tie Abegglen for sixth place on the list with one more win.

## AROUND THE BIG SKY

**RPI UPDATE:** The Big Sky moved up one spot to 23rd among Division I conferences in this week's RPI Report. The Big Sky is just behind Patriot, and just ahead of the WAC. Montana improved 81 spots in the RPI this week, and now has the top mark for Big Sky teams at 113. Eastern Washington is second at 147, followed by Northern Colorado at 166. The Big Sky's non-conference schedule strength ranks eighth in the nation. Seven of the 11 league schools have played schedules that rank in the top 90 toughest in the nation. North Dakota's schedule strength is rated 17th, followed by SUU (35), EWU (49), WSU (51), ISU (68), UM (74) and NAU (90). Big Sky teams have played 13 schools currently ranked in the top 50 in the RPI, including Wisconsin (3), Oregon (9) and Arizona (10). Syracuse, UMass and Wisconsin, Kansas and Iowa State are the top five teams. The top five conferences are the Big 10, Big 12 and Big East., Pac-12 and ACC.

**IN THE NCAA STATS:** Idaho State ranks 10th in the nation in steals per game at 9.8. North Dakota is 15th with an average of 9.2. Montana is 15th in fewest turnovers per game (10.0).. EWU is 28th in the nation in 3-point field goals made per game (8.5)... Sacramento State's Mikh McKinney is fourth in the nation with a free-throw percentage of .941...EWU's Tyler Harvey ranks eighth in the nation with an average of 3.55 3-pointers per game... North Dakota's Troy Huff is 14th in scoring (21.8 points per game) and 18th in steals per game (2.45)...Sac State's Dylan Garrity is 28th in the nation in assist/turnover ratio at 3.0.

**Tip-ins:** Sacramento State junior Dylan Garrity is now tied for 25th in league history with 363 assists. He needs 29 more to move into a tie for 20th...PSU junior guard Tim Douglas has scored in double figures in all nine games he's played for the Vikings... Montana made 18-of-18 free throws in the second half of a 72-71 win over Idaho. The Griz were 26-of-32 from the charity stripe in the game...WSU's Kyle Tresnak recorded a career-high five blocks in a win over Northern New Mexico...WSU enters conference play having won 18 straight regular-season conference home games...Big Sky teams are 23-62 vs. other Division I teams.
