Kareem Jamar, Forward/Guard, Montana



Kareem Jamar of The University of Montana has been selected as the Big Sky Conference men's basketball Player of the Week for games played between Feb. 4-9.

Jamar, a 6-foot-5 guard/forward from Venice, Calif, averaged 16 points, 8.5 rebounds. 6.5 assists, 2.5 steals and two blocks per game as the Grizzlies picked up home victories over Northern Colorado and North Dakota on an historic weekend. In the two games, Jamar shot .545 percent from the field, and .857 percent from the free-throw line.

Jamar netted 18 points with eight rebounds, seven assists, three steals and three blocks in Montana's 73-63 win over Northern Colorado on Thursday. He was 7-of-11 from the field and 4-of-5 from the free-throw line. Montana clinched a berth in the Big Sky Championship with the win.

On Saturday, the All-Conference player netted 14 points with nine rebounds, six assists, two blocks and a steal in a 78-58 victory over North Dakota.

Montana has won 25 consecutive Big Sky Conference regular-season games, a league record. The previous mark of 24 was set by Weber State 43 years ago. Montana also set the league record for consecutive regular-season home victories with 24. The previous record was 23 set by Idaho 30 years ago.

Including postseason games, Montana has won 27 straight over Big Sky competition and 27 straight at home over Big Sky teams.

Montana has won 14 straight games, which ties the longest winning streak in school history. UM's streak is currently tied with Memphis for the second-longest active streak in the nation. Akron has won 15 games.

THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

Montana's streak will hit its stiffest challenge this week as it travels to second-place Weber State on Thursday night. The Grizzlies head to Ogden riding a record 24-game regular-season conference winning streak. They haven't lost a league game since last Jan. 14 in Ogden...Before WSU takes on UM, the Wildcats battle rival Idaho State on Monday. The Wildcats can clinch a postseason bid with a win. WSU also plays host to Montana State this week...The slate also features some key games for teams hoping to remain in the hunt for postseason berths...Northern Arizona, which currently sits in seventh place, travels to Northern Colorado, which is a game back of the Lumberjacks...NAU travels to North Dakota on Saturday...UND (7-7) plays host to Sacramento State (7-7) on Thursday...MSU (7-7) is at Idaho State on Thursday...Portland State (3-11) plays host to Southern Utah (8-6) on Thursday and as it looks to snap an eight-game losing streak...Eastern Washington (5-9) plays host to Southern Utah on Saturday...Also on Saturday, UM is at ISU.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

GRIZZLIES SET STANDARDS: Montana beat Northern Colorado and North Dakota at home to etch its name alone in the Big Sky record book. Montana has won 25 straight regular-season conference games, breaking the previous mark of 24 set by Weber State 43 years ago. Montana has also won 24 straight regular-season home conference games, eclipsing the previous record of 23 set by Idaho 30 years ago. Including postseason games, UM has won 27 straight over Big Sky teams and 27 in a row over Big Sky teams at home. Montana enters this week having won 11 consecutive regular-season conference road games. The record is 13 set by Weber State from 1967-68 through 1969-70. The Grizzlies play at Weber State on Thursday. UM hasn't won a regular-season game at Weber State since Feb. 12, 2004. UM did beat WSU in the 2010 Championship game at the Dee Events Center. Montana's last conference loss occurred Jan. 14, 2012, at Weber State, 80-64. Montana's 14-game winning streak is tied for the second-longest active streak in the nation with Memphis. Akron has won 15 straight games. It also ties the longest winning streak in school history, set last season. Montana has clinched a spot in the Big Sky Championship for the 12th consecutive season. Montana is one of eight remaining Division I teams without a conference loss. The others are: Louisiana Tech (12-0), Gonzaga (10-0), Norfolk State (10-0), Miami, Fla. (10-0), Akron (10-0), Memphis (9-0) and North Carolina Central (9-0). No Big Sky team has ever won more than 15 regular-season conference games in a season. This is the first season that league plays are playing 20 conference games. Weber State went 15-0 in 1968-69, and finished 15-1 in 2008-09. Montana was 15-1 last season. Grizzly coach Wayne Tinkle has 80 conference wins, which ranks seventh all-time in league history.

WEBER CAN CLINCH: Weber State can become the second Big Sky team to clinch a spot in the postseason with a win over Idaho State on Monday night. The game will be televised live on Altitude2. Weber State has won 13 straight regular-season conference home games. ISU hasn't beaten the Wildcats in Ogden since 2007. The Wildcats are seeking their seventh straight trip to the Big Sky Championship. Weber State coach Randy Rahe enters Monday's game with 85 conference wins. He can tie former Weber State coach Ron Abegglen for fifth place on the Big Sky's all-time conference wins list.

TRIPLE-DOUBLE FOR SALDIVAR: Less than 48 hours after recording a double-double, Northern Arizona senior Stallon Saldivar recorded the first triple-double in Lumberjack men's basketball history. Saldivar scored 13 points with 11 rebounds and 10 assists in a 77-74 overtime loss to Eastern Washington. Saldivar became the third Big Sky player since 2000 to record a triple-double. Montana's Kareem Jamar had one last year. Weber State's Eddie Gill had a triple-double in 2000. Saldivar recorded 27 assists in three games last week, bringing his career total to 484. He ranks eighth on the Big Sky's all-time list and is just 19 from moving into sole possession of sixth place.

CHERRY THIRD IN STEALS: Montana senior Will Cherry recorded eight steals last week to hike his career total to 254. Cherry moved into third place on the Big Sky's all-time list. Nevada's Kevin Soars is second with 255. Sacramento State's DeShawn Freeman holds the record with 283. Cherry has at least eight games remaining to catch Freeman.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

EAGLES FROM DOWNTOWN: Eastern Washington rallied from an 18-point deficit with under eight minutes to play to beat Northern Arizona 77-74 in overtime on Saturday. The Eagles hoisted 43 3-pointers, tying the single-game Big Sky record. Eastern Washington also attempted 43 3-pointers in a 2010 win over New Home Christian. The Eagles made 14 3-pointers against the Lumberjacks, including nine in the final eight minutes of regulation and overtime. Freshman Tyler Harvey came off the bench and hit four 3-pointers and finished with a career-high 14 points. Prior to Saturday, Harvey had 17 total points and three 3-pointers in 14 games. The win snapped Eastern Washington's 13-game road losing streak dating back to last season.

RPI REPORT: Montana remained 118th in this week's RPI, unchanged from a week ago. Weber State improved seven spots from 136 to 129. North Dakota improved 31 spots to 248. The Big Sky remained 28th among Division I conferences. The Big Ten is the top conference, followed by the Mountain West and Big East.

ROGERS IN TOP 10: Northern Arizona senior Gabe Rogers made 14 3-pointers in three games last week, to hike his career total to 216, which ranks 10th in Big Sky history. He needs two more to tie former Montana player Kevin Criswell for ninth place. Weber State's Scott Bamforth made 207, which ranks 13th in league history.

Tip-ins: Sacramento State's Mikh McKinney scored 30 points in a win over Portland State. It was the most points by a Hornet since Loren Leath scored 41 on Jan. 13, 2009...In 49 career games, Hornet guard Dylan Garrity has 305 career assists.... Northern Colorado 13-of-18 shots from the floor and 16-of-17 free throws in the second half of its 85-72 win over Montana State...Weber State ranks second in the nation in 3-point field-goal percentage (42.5 percent) and is third in 3-point field-goal percentage defense (26.8 percent)....PSU's Aaron Moore recorded back-to-back double-doubles last week. He has six in his last 12 games...SUU's Jackson Stevenett has scored in double figures in 17 straight games...Sac State's John Dickson needs five blocks to become the 24th player in league history with 100...UND's Troy Huff has scored at least 21 points in six of his last seven games...Home teams are 50-26 in conference games. Portland State is the only team without a conference road win. The Vikings are 0-12 overall on the road, 0-8 in league...SUU had a five-game winning streak snapped at Weber State. It was the Thunderbirds' longest winning streak since the 2001-02 season...SUU's Jayson Cheesman has 53 blocks and is just 11 away from a single-season school record...MSU played without center Paul Egwuonwu and forward Flavien Davis last week. Both are expected back this week.
