TV Games: Northern Arizona will have a couple of TV games this week. On Thursday at 6:35 p.m. Mountain, the Lumberjacks will host Northern Colorado. On Saturday at 2:05 p.m. Mountain, North Dakota will travel to NAU. Both games can be seen on NAU-TV/FCS.

Watching Career Records: Kylie Kuhns ranks second in career rebounds with 1,125. She is chasing the record of 1,174 set from 2004-08 by Natalie Doma of Idaho State. Kuhns became the fifth player in Big Sky history to have more than 1,000 rebounds...Amy Patton is chasing a record of her own. She is chasing the career points scored. Currently she is ranked fifth in Big Sky history with 1,852 points. The record of 2,296 was also set by Natalie Doma from 2004-08.

Individual Single-Game Ranks: On Nov. 24, NAU's Amy Patton tied the single-game record for points scored with 41 against Bradley. She became the fourth person to tie that record...That same game, Patton had 10 steals, which ranks tied for second in single game, and she also is tied for third in field-goals attempted with 29...On Dec. 1, against Oregon State, SAC's Se'nyce Parris made nine 3-pointers, which ties for first in single-game history. She also ranks tied for seventh with 39 points scored. And on Nov. 24, PSU's Angela Misa had 21 rebounds against Butler, which ranks tied for sixth in a single game.

Team Single-Game Ranks: On Dec. 8, Southern Utah scored 15 3-pointers against San Jose State. That ranks tied for fourth in a single-game...Northern Colorado ranks four times in a single-game as they defeated Johnson & Wales on Dec. 30. NC ranks tied for first in rebounds with 71, tied for fourth in 3-point field-goals made with 15, eighth in 3-point field-goals attempted with 36, and tied for ninth with 102 points scored.

NC'S OOSDYKE NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (February 11, 2013) - Northern Colorado's Lauren Oosdyke has been named Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week for the games played the week of Feb. 4-10. This is the second POTW honor for Oosdyke this season.

Oosdyke, a senior from Coto de Caza, Calif., averaged 16.5 points and 7.5 rebounds in a pair of important home victories that moved Northern Colorado into a tie in the loss column for first.

She shot .579 from the field and made both of her 3-point attempts. She added 15 rebounds for the week and a couple of steals. Against Montana, Oosdyke missed a double-double by one rebound with 14 points and nine boards, while in the win over Montana State, Oosdyke led all scorers with 19 points, had three assists, six rebounds and shot 80 percent from the free throw line, making 8-of-10.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Aubrey Ashenfelter, Eastern Washington - Ashenfelter was solid on both ends of the floor this weekend, contributing an all-around effort in Eastern's home split against Sac State and Northern Arizona. Ashenfelter averaged 10 points, 5.5 rebounds, three steals and 2.5 assists. She hit two 3-pointers against the Hornets and had five rebounds to help EWU avenge a loss from earlier in the season, and then tallied a team-leading 13 points to go along with six rebounds, four assists and career-high-tying five steals against the Lumberjacks. Ashenfelter was also given the hardest assignment on the floor in guarding Big Sky leading scorer, Amy Patton.

Cydney Horton, Idaho State - Horton scored a career-high 28 points, 21 coming in the second half, to lead the Idaho State women's basketball team to a 60-50 win over Southern Utah in Cedar City, Utah. Idaho State is now 13-9 overall and 8-5 in Big Sky Conference play...Horton scored her 28 points on 11-of-14 shooting from the field and was 8-of-10 from the field in the second half.

Katie Baker, Montana - Baker averaged 10.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game as Montana split the Northern Colorado-North Dakota road trip. Baker had 7 points, 7 rebounds and 2 assists Thursday in Montana's 54-41 loss to the Bears and 13 points, 8 rebounds and 3 blocks in Saturday's 61-42 victory over UND.

Madi Buck, North Dakota - Buck etched her sixth double-double of the season with a 19-point, 11-rebound effort in Thursday's win over Montana State. Buck scored 16 of her final tally after half-time, draining three triples in the opening six minutes to put UND in front for good. She added seven points, five rebounds and two blocks Saturday against Montana.

Amanda Frost, Northern Arizona - Frost averaged 10.3 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 3.3 assists per game while shooting 59.1% from the field to lead NAU to wins over Southern Utah and Eastern Washington. She made the game-winning layup with four seconds left in overtime to help NAU top Southern Utah while totaling 12 points on 5-of-7 shooting with four rebounds, three assists, and two steals. At Portland State Frost totaled seven points, four rebounds, and five assists as NAU lost by just five and at Eastern Washington she scored 12 points on 5-of-8 shooting with four rebounds, two assists, and four steals in the Lumberjack win. She shot 13-of-22 for the week and 3-of-7 from 3-point range while totaling 12 rebounds, 10 assists, and six steals.

Courtney VanBrocklin, Portland State - VanBrocklin averaged 19.5 points per game as the Vikings went 1-1 last week in Big Sky Conference play. She averaged 4.5 rebounds per game along with 3.5 assists. She shot .565 (13-23) from the field,.500 (3-6) from beyond the arc, and .769 (10-13) from the line...She started the week with a 19-point, 5-rebound performance in a win against Northern Arizona. She played all 40 minutes against the Lumberjacks with four assists and three steals...VanBrocklin then recorded her sixth 20-point game of the season with 20 points in 25 minutes against Sacramento State.

Hailey Mandelko, Southern Utah - Mandelko led SUU led Southern Utah with an average of 12 points a game in its two outings last week. The sophomore guard put up 18 points on 4-8 shooting from behind the arc to lead SUU past Weber State on Thursday. For the week Mandelko shot 40 percent from three while also dishing out four assists and grabbing a steal and three rebounds.
