Watching Career Records: Kylie Kuhns ranks second in career rebounds with 1,145. She is chasing the record of 1,174 set from 2004-08 by Natalie Doma of Idaho State. Kuhns became the fifth player in Big Sky history to have more than 1,000 rebounds...Amy Patton is chasing a record of her own. She is chasing the career points scored. Currently she is ranked fifth in Big Sky history with 1,882 points. The record of 2,296 was also set by Natalie Doma from 2004-08.

Individual Single-Game Ranks: On Nov. 24, NAU's Amy Patton tied the single-game record for points scored with 41 against Bradley. She became the fourth person to tie that record...That same game, Patton had 10 steals, which ranks tied for second in single game, and she also is tied for third in field-goals attempted with 29...On Dec. 1, against Oregon State, SAC's Se'nyce Parris made nine 3-pointers, which ties for first in single-game history. She also ranks tied for seventh with 39 points scored. And on Nov. 24, PSU's Angela Misa had 21 rebounds against Butler, which ranks tied for sixth in a single game.

Team Single-Game Ranks: On Dec. 8, Southern Utah scored 15 3-pointers against San Jose State. That ranks tied for fourth in a single-game...Northern Colorado ranks four times in a single-game as they defeated Johnson & Wales on Dec. 30. NC ranks tied for first in rebounds with 71, tied for fourth in 3-point field-goals made with 15, eighth in 3-point field-goals attempted with 36, and tied for ninth with 102 points scored.

UM'S DE BOER AND NC'S STRANGE NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (February 18, 2013) - Montana's Kenzie De Boer and Northern Colorado's D'shara Strange have been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Co-Players of the Week for the games played the week of Feb. 11-17.

De Boer, a senior from Lynden, Wash., averaged 21.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals as Montana swept Weber State and Idaho State at home last week to remain atop the Big Sky Conference standings. De Boer shot 55.6 percent from the field, went 4-for-6 from 3-point range and 9-for-11 from the line in the two wins.

In Thursday's 90-43 victory over Weber State, De Boer finished with 19 points and five rebounds in just 20 minutes of work. She went 6 for 11 from the field and 6-for-7 from the line. She scored 11 first-half points to spark Montana to a 48-23 halftime lead.

In Saturday's 61-49 win over Idaho State, De Boer had her fifth 20-plus-point scoring game this season with 24 points, five rebounds and four steals. She went 9-for-16 from the field, including a perfect 3-for-3 from 3-point range. She scored 12 points in the opening seven minutes against ISU to give the Lady Griz a lead they would never give up. She had 16 at the half to put Montana up 28-19 at the break, and she scored the second half's first five points to give her 21 points to Idaho State's 19 two minutes into the second half.

Strange, a junior from Fort Carson, Colo., broke the Northern Colorado career record for steals just 68 games into her career, doing so at Northern Arizona on Thursday. She now has 215 after four on the week, bettering the previous mark of 213 by Courtney Stoermer (2007-11). Strange also had a double-double in the first half against NAU on Thursday with 12 points and 10 rebounds. She ended that game with 21 points and 14 boards as well as 11-for-12 from the free throw line. In the win at Sacramento State, Strange had 13 points and nine rebounds and didn't turn the ball over in the second half.

For the week, she averaged 17.0 points, 11.5 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game, while shooting .875 from the free throw line (14-of-16).

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Laura Hughes, Eastern Washington - Hughes led EWU to an important road win at Southern Utah, tallying a near double-double against the aggressive Thunderbirds. Hughes finished with a career-high-tying 20 points, and had a team-high eight rebounds in just 18 minutes on the floor. She made 7-of-12 field goals, while contributing five offensive rebounds and three defensive to help EWU rally from a nine-point deficit in the second half to win the game 78-70 for the team's 10th Big Sky victory of the season...Hughes ranks among the top five in the Big Sky Conference in field goal percentage, averaging 50.7 percent from the field in her junior campaign. She is one of only six players in the entire league shooting better than 50 percent this season.

Kaela Oakes, Idaho State - Kaela scored 32 points this weekend including 22 against league leading Montana. She had 10 in ISU's win over Montana State.

Amy Patton, Northern Arizona - Patton averaged 15.0 points and 8.0 rebounds per game while shooting 45.2% last week as NAU defeated North Dakota and lost to Northern Colorado. She also added four steals, two assists, and a block while playing 39.5 minutes per game. Patton posted her seventh double-double of the season with 16 points, 10 rebounds, two assists, three steals and a block while shooting 8-of-15 from the field in NAU's 64-60 overtime win over North Dakota. On Thursday she totaled team highs of 14 points and six rebounds with a steal against Northern Colorado.

Courtney VanBrocklin, Portland State - VanBrocklin scored a team-high 20 points for the Vikings in their 83-60 loss at Southern Utah last Thursday. VanBrocklin scored her 20 points on 7-for-15 shooting from the floor. She also went 2-fo-3 from three-point range and 4-for-6 from the free-throw line. She added five assists and four rebounds. It was the second consecutive game that VanBrocklin put up 20 points for the Vikings. She now has seven 20-point games on the season and 13 for her career.

Kylie Kuhns, Sacramento State - Kuhns averaged 19.5 points, 10 rebounds and five assists while shooting 70.4 percent from the field as the Hornets split a pair of games over the weekend against North Dakota and Northern Colorado. In an 80-62 win over North Dakota on Thursday night, Kuhns tallied 20 points on 10-of-15 shooting and posted eight rebounds plus six assists and three steals. On Saturday in an 81-73 loss to Northern Colorado, Kuhns scored 19 points on 9-of-12 shooting with a game-high 12 rebounds and four assists. It was her 11th double-double of the season and 47th of her career.

Andrea Jones, Southern Utah - Jones started the week 6-for-6 from behind the arc before missing her last two attempts for a three-point field goal percentage of .778 over a two game stretch. In Southern Utah's 83-60 win over Portland State she scored 14 points while going 3-3 from the outside and 5-5 from the field overall. The junior guard led the T-Birds in scoring on the week with an average of 17.0 ppg while shooting .786 overall and .714 at the foul line. Jones also grabbed seven rebounds, handed out four assists, grabbed two steals and blocked a shot. She currently lead SUU with 73 assists and 39 steals on the season.
