# BIG SKY HIGHLIGHTS

**Coming Up:** Games this week will begin on Thursday. Starting at 7:05 p.m. Mountain, Montana will host Southern Utah, Northern Colorado and Eastern Washington will tip off in Greeley, Colo., Sacramento State will travel to Weber State and Idaho State will hosts Northern Arizona. On Saturday, five games will be played.

**TV Games:** On Saturday, Montana State will host Montana at 2:05 p.m. Mountain. That game will be televised on Max Media.

**Watching Career Records:** Kylie Kuhns ranks second in career rebounds with 1,158. She is chasing the record of 1,174 set from 2004-08 by Natalie Doma of Idaho State. Kuhns became the fifth player in Big Sky history to have more than 1,000 rebounds...Amy Patton is chasing a record of her own. She is chasing the career points scored. Currently she is ranked fifth in Big Sky history with 1,889 points. The record of 2,296 was also set by Natalie Doma from 2004-08.

**Clinched Spots In Postseason Tournament:** Four teams have clinched a spot in the Big Sky Conference Tournament March 14-16.

**Breaking A Record:** Weber State has tied the Big Sky record for consecutive losses. They had 19 last season added on to the 25 this season. Sacramento State holds the record of 44 set from 2000-03. The Wildcats will host the Hornets on Thursday and will either break that record or stay tied.

**Individual Single-Game Ranks:** On Nov. 24, NAU's Amy Patton tied the single-game record for points scored with 41 against Bradley. She became the fourth person to tie that record...That same game, Patton had 10 steals, which ranks tied for second in single game, and she also is tied for third in field-goals attempted with 29...On Dec. 1, against Oregon State, SAC's Se'nyce Parris made nine 3-pointers, which ties for first in single-game history. She also ranks tied for seventh with 39 points scored. And on Nov. 24, PSU's Angela Misa had 21 rebounds against Butler, which ranks tied for sixth in a single game.

**Team Single-Game Ranks:** On Dec. 8, Southern Utah scored 15 3-pointers against San Jose State. That ranks tied for fourth in a single-game...Northern Colorado ranks four times in a single-game as they defeated Johnson & Wales on Dec. 30. NC ranks tied for first in rebounds with 71, tied for fourth in 3-point field-goals made with 15, eighth in 3-point field-goals attempted with 36, and tied for ninth with 102 points scored.

## SUU MANDELKO NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (February 25, 2013) - Southern Utah's Hailey Mandelko has been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week for the games played the week of Feb. 18-24.

Mandelko, a sophomore from Lexington, Neb., scored 21 points, including 12-15 at the foul line, to lead Southern Utah to an important road win at Northern Colorado in the Thunderbirds' only outing last week.

The Bears came into the game undefeated at home on the season and tied atop the Big Sky standings, but SUU pulled ahead late in the first half and never looked back as it picked up a 73-57 win to go up a game on Northern Arizona in the race for the final spot in the upcoming conference tournament.

Mandelko also recorded three rebounds, three assists and three steals in the victory. The guard is leading the T-Birds this season with an average of 12.1 points a game while shooting over 37 percent from beyond the arc.

# LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

**Hayley Hodgins, Eastern Washington** - Hodgins scored a career-high 24 points on 7-of-8 shooting from the floor to lead EWU to a 83-51 rout of Portland State on Thursday. With the win, EWU clinched a bid to the 2013 Big Sky Conference tournament, while earning the first regular-season sweep of PSU since 2004-05, and securing the coveted "Dam Cup" for Eastern Washington University (a friendly rivalry series between EWU and PSU)...Hodgins did not miss a single field goal until 58 seconds remained in the first half, as she went 7-of-7 to start the game, including three 3-pointers. She had 20 of those career-high 24 points all in the first half. Hodgins also tallied a career-high four assists in the game. In just 26 minutes on the floor, she was 7-of-8 from the field and 7-of-8 from the free throw line.

**Ashleigh Vella, Idaho State** - In ISU's 68-37 win over Weber State Thursday, senior forward Ashleigh Vella neared a double-double with 14 points and nine rebounds. Vella went 6-9 from the field and 1-2 from 3-point range. She also recorded three assists, two blocks and a steal in 28 minutes of play.

**Katie Houdek, North Dakota** - Houdek returned from mid-season knee surgery to lead UND to a home split against Northern Colorado and Portland State. The junior made all four of her shots from the floor in her first game back and added a pair of rebounds and a steal in 14 minutes of action against UNC. She then made just her fourth start of the season Saturday, going 5-of-8 from the floor along with 3 rebounds and 2 blocks in 17 minutes in the win over Portland State.

**Erikka Banks, Northern Arizona** - Banks recorded her first career double-double with career-highs of 25 points, 14 rebounds, and seven steals vs. Sacramento State in NAU's only game of the week. She shot 7-of-14 from the field and 11-of-14 from the free-throw line with 10 of her 14 rebounds coming on the offensive glass. She also one assist and one block in just 28 minutes played off the bench.

**D'shara Strange, Northern Colorado** - Strange averaged 17.5 points per game and shot 38.5 percent from the floor in a split this week. Against North Dakota on Thursday, Strange recorded 11 points, three assists, three steals and eight rebounds. In Saturday's loss to Southern Utah, Strange had 24 points and eight boards. She shot 47.8 percent from the floor and added five assists.

**Kylie Kuhns, Sacramento State** - Kuhns posted her 48th career double-double and 12th of the season in Sacramento State's 78-68 victory at Northern Arizona, which secured the Hornets a spot in the Big Sky Tournament. Kuhns scored 14 points to go with 13 rebounds. The senior is now just 17 boards away from breaking the Big Sky Conference record for career rebounds.
