Damon Heuir, G, Southern Utah

Southern Utah's Damon Heuir has been selected as the Big Sky Conference men's basketball Player of the Week.



Heuir, a 6-foot-2 senior guard from Townsville, Queensland, Australia, averaged 27.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and four assists per game as he led the Thunderbirds to victories over Sacramento State and Northern Arizona.

Heuir scored 28 points with seven rebounds, seven assists and a steal in Southern Utah's 79-67 win over Sacramento State on Thursday night. He scored 19 of his 28 in the second half as his team overcame a 13-point halftime deficit. Heuir made 13-of-14 shots from the free-throw line, and was 3-of-7 from 3-point range.

Heuir came back Saturday and scored 27 points in a 78-67 win over Northern Arizona, the Thunderbirds' fourth straight victory. Heuir made 3-of-6 from 3-point range and was 6-of-8 from the free-throw line. He also had four rebounds, an assist and a steal. He scored 18 points in the first half as Southern Utah opened up a 40-32 lead.

Heuir now leads the Big Sky Conference in scoring with an average of 16.8 points per game. He has scored in double figures in 10 straight games. This is his second Player of the Week honor this season.

THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

League-leading Montana looks to make conference history this week. The Grizzlies, riding a 12-game winning streak, can tie the all-time record for consecutive conference wins on Thursday night when it plays host to Northern Colorado. The game will be televised live on Altitude Sports & Entertainment. If Montana wins Thursday, the Griz can break the record Saturday night at home against North Dakota...Second-place Weber State returns home after a four-game road trip on Saturday to face Southern Utah...The Thunderbirds have won four straight and look to make it five on Thursday when they travel to Idaho State...Montana State, which is tied for third with SUU, plays host to UND on Thursday and UNDon Saturday...Sacramento State (5-6) plays three times this week at home. The Hornets battle Northern Arizona on Monday, EWU on Thursday, and PSU on Saturday...NAU heads home on Thursday to face PSU and takes on EWU Saturday.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

GRIZZLIES STAY PERFECT: Wayne Tinkle's Montana Grizzlies improved to 12-0 in conference with road wins over Portland State and Eastern Washington last weekend. The Grizzlies' have the second-longest active win streak in the nation behind Akron, which has won 13 straight games. Montana is currently riding a host of streaks and could break the Big Sky all-time record for consecutive regular-season conference wins this week. Montana enters Thursday's game against Northern Colorado, which will be televised live on Altitude Sports & Entertainment, having won 23 in a row. The record of 24 is held by Weber State and was accomplished in 1967-68 and 1969-70. If Montana beats Northern Colorado, the Griz will try to break the record on Saturday at home against UND. UM won a school-record 14 in a row last season, and can match that with two wins this week. Below is a streaks and milestones UM is currently riding.

✓ 12-0 conference record. UM is one of 13 schools at the Division I level without a conference loss. No team has won more conference games without a loss than Montana. Belmont (10-0) of the Ohio Valley and Louisiana Tech (10-0) of the WAC are the only other teams with at least 10 conference wins and no league losses. Miami, Fla., Florida, Memphis, Southern Mississippi, Harvard, Princeton, Akron, Norfolk State, North Carolina Central, and Gonzaga are also perfect in league play.

✓ Montana has won 11 consecutive road conference games, dating back to a 80-64 loss at Weber State on Jan. 14, 2012. The conference record is 13 set by Weber State from 1967-68 till 1969-70.

✓ UM has won 23 straight regular-season conference games dating back to the Weber State loss. Including wins over EWU and WSU at the Big Sky Championship in 2012, UM has won 25 in a row over Big Sky teams. Weber State holds the record for most consecutive regular-season conference wins with 24.

✓ The Grizzlies have won 22 straight regular-season home conference games dating back to a 73-67 loss to Montana State on Feb. 27, 2010. Idaho holds the Big Sky record with 23 consecutive regular-season home conference wins from 1980-81 to 1982-83. UM can tie and break that record with two wins this week. Including three postseason home wins, Montana has won 25 in row over Big Sky teams at Dahlberg Arena.

✓ Montana is also in position to become the first team to clinch a spot in the postseason tournament. The Grizzlies will clinch with one more win.

BRACKETBUSTERS PAIRINGS ANNOUNCED: Montana was selected as one of the 26 teams in the 2013 Ramada Worldwide BracketBusters television package. The Grizzlies will travel to Davidson on Saturday, Feb. 23rd. It will air live on ESPN at 1 p.m. MST. AROUND THE BIG SKY

TEN AGAIN FOR WEBER: The Weber State Wildcats won their 10th conference game on Saturday, marking the seventh straight season WSU has reached the 10-win plateau in conference. It marks the first time in league history that feat has been accomplished. WSU reached the mark six straight seasons from 1967-68 through 1972-73. Idaho did it from 1987-88 through 1992-93. Under Randy Rahe, Weber State has won 84 conference games during the run. WSU plays six of its final eight conference games at home. Under Rahe, WSU is 48-4 in regular-season conference home games and has won 12 straight. UM has won at least 10 league games in each of the past five seasons.

RPI REPORT: Montana continues to lead the Big Sky teams in the RPI. UM improved seven spots this week to 118. Weber State improved nine spots to 136. NAU is third at 248, and Sacramento State is fourth at 260. The Big Sky jumped up one spot among Division I conferences to 28th.

GAMES ADDED TO ALTITUDE: Two games have been added to the Altitude Sports & Entertainment lineup. Montana will take on Northern Colorado on Thursday from Missoula at 7 p.m. On March 7, the Northern Arizona-Montana State game from Bozeman will air at 8 p.m. Lyon Production will produce both games.

Tip-ins: UM's Will Cherry enters the week with 246 steals. He needs one more to tie NAU's Tom DeBerry for third place on the Big Sky's all-time list...UND's Troy Huff recorded his third double-double of the season with 21 points and 11 rebounds in a win over Idaho State...EWU freshman Venky Jois scored eight points with 14 rebounds, seven assists and three blocks in a 72-68 win over MSU. He missed the UM game on Saturday with an ankle injury...UM and WSU have combined for 12 conference road wins. The other nine teams have combined for nine...PSU has lost six in a row for the first time since 2006...Northern Colorado's Tate Unruh saw his streak of games made with a 3-pointer halted at 27. Unruh made a 3-pointer in the first 19 games this season and the final eight of last. He went 0-for-3 against Weber State on Saturday...NAU's Stallon Saldivar had a career-high 12 rebounds in a loss to Southern Utah...WSU's Scott Bamforth made his 200th career 3-pointer on Saturday, becoming the 15th player in league history to reach the mark. Bamforth ranks 14th on the all-time list, one ahead of NAU senior Gabe Rogers...Bamforth's current career free-throw percentage of .880 ranks third in Big Sky history...Montana is ranked 14th in this week's CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll. The Grizzlies earned 333 votes. Weber State received 23 votes.
