On Thursday, five games will be played starting at 7:05 p.m. Central and on Saturday games will begin at 2:05 p.m. Central.

TV Games: Northern Arizona will host Southern Utah tonight (Monday) at 6:35 p.m. That game can be seen on NAU-TV/FCS. On Thursday, Montana State will travel to North Dakota. That game will tip off at 7:05 p.m. and can be seen on Fox College Sports & MidCo Sports Network & on Saturday, North Dakota will host Montana at 2:05 p.m. on that same station as Thursday.

Watching Career Records: Kylie Kuhns ranks second in career rebounds with 1,045. She is chasing the record of 1,174 set from 2004-08 by Natalie Doma of Idaho State. Kuhns became the fifth player in Big Sky history to have more than 1,000 rebounds...Amy Patton is chasing a record of her own. She is chasing the career points scored. Currently she is ranked sixth in Big Sky history with 1,806 points. The record of 2,296 was also set by Natalie Doma from 2004-08.

Individual Single-Game Ranks: On Nov. 24, NAU's Amy Patton tied the single-game record for points scored with 41 against Bradley. She became the fourth person to tie that record...That same game, Patton had 10 steals, which ranks tied for second in single game, and she also is tied for third in field-goals attempted with 29...On Dec. 1, against Oregon State, SAC's Se'nyce Parris made nine 3-pointers, which ties for first in single-game history. She also ranks tied for seventh with 39 points scored. And on Nov. 24, PSU's Angela Misa had 21 rebounds against Butler, which ranks tied for sixth in a single game.

Team Single-Game Ranks: On Dec. 8, Southern Utah scored 15 3-pointers against San Jose State. That ranks tied for fourth in a single-game...Northern Colorado ranks four times in a single-game as they defeated Johnson & Wales on Dec. 30. NC ranks tied for first in rebounds with 71, tied for fourth in 3-point field-goals made with 15, eighth in 3-point field-goals attempted with 36, and tied for ninth with 102 points scored.

UM'S BAKER, SAC'S HILLIARD NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (February 4, 2013) - Montana's Katie Baker and Sacramento State's Fantasia Hilliard have been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Co-Players of the Week for the games played the week of Jan. 28-Feb. 3.

Baker, a senior from Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, averaged 18.5 points on 51.9-percent shooting and 7.5 rebounds to lead Montana to a pair of home wins last week over Portland State and Eastern Washington. Baker also added three blocks and five steals and went 8 for 9 from the line in the two victories that vaulted Montana to the top of the Big Sky Conference standings.

Baker had 15 points, nine rebounds and four steals in Thursday's 72-61 win over the Vikings as Montana overcame an eight-point second-half deficit. Baker had 22 points on 10-of-15 shooting in Saturday's 76-51 victory over the Eagles. Baker's shooting helped Montana shoot a season-best 48.4 percent.

Hilliard, a sophomore from Sacramento, Calif., averaged 17.5 points, 8.0 assists, 6.5 rebounds and 6.0 steals in a pair of Sacramento State wins over the weekend against Northern Arizona and Southern Utah.

Her best performance was a near quadruple-double on Saturday against the Thunderbirds. Hilliard posted a career-high 24 points with 10 assists, eight rebounds and eight steals. In Thursday's win over Northern Arizona, Hilliard posted 11 points, six assists, five rebounds and four steals. Hilliard is averaging a team-best 13.3 points per game in conference games and leads the league in assists per game.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Kylie Huerta, Eastern Washington - Huerta had two solid outings during Eastern's road trip to the Montanas, averaging 9.0 points, 6.5 assists and a team-leading 5.5 rebounds, as EWU beat Montana State, 68-59, before falling at league-leading Montana, 76-51. Against the Bobcats, who were ranked No. 1 in the conference at the time, Huerta flirted with a triple-double, as the 5-1 point guard had nine points, a game-high eight rebounds and seven assists, as well as two steals. She made 4-of-4 at the free throw line, all of which came in the final of the game to preserve her team's narrow lead. Against the Lady Griz, Huerta had nine points and six assists with zero turnovers in 35 minutes on the floor. She also contributed three rebounds and two steals. Huerta ranks No. 1 in the conference in assist-to-turnover ratio, and is among the top 40 in the nation.

Ashleigh Vella, Idaho State - Vella led Idaho State against Northern Colorado and North Dakota. She put up 18 points against NC and 21 against UND for a total of 39 points over the weekend. She leads ISU, averaging 12.8 points per contest. She also tallied 15 rebounds this week with seven against the Bears and eight versus UND. She currently leads the league in 3-point field goal percentage after shooting 3-7 this week.

Amy Patton, Northern Arizona - Patton totaled 14 points and a career-high 18 rebounds against Sacramento State in NAU's only game of the week. She also added three assists and three steals with only two turnovers in 38 minutes played. Her 18 rebounds tied for the ninth most in a game in program history while she totaled her team-leading sixth double-double of the year.

Stephanie Lee, Northern Colorado - Lee entered the road trip averaging 5.5 points and 2.1 rebounds for the season, but came off the bench against Idaho State and Weber State to average 13.5 points and 6.0 rebounds in the Bears' first back-to-back road wins of the year. On Thursday in the Bears' first-ever win at Idaho State, Lee scored 13 points and brought down eight boards. She also had the team's only two blocked shots of the game as well as the team's only three-pointer of the weekend. In the win over Weber State, Lee scored 14 points on 7-of-12 shooting from the field. With the Bears trailing 39-37 the Bears went on a 22-4 run to put away the Wildcats and Lee had eight points during the run, securing the team's fourth-straight win of the year.

Courtney VanBrocklin, Portland State - VanBrocklin led the Vikings to a split of the Montana Schools this weekend averaging 16.5 points and 4.5 assists per game while playing all but six minutes on the weekend. She shot 39.1 percent from the floor, 42.9 percent from 3-point range, and 85.7 percent (12-14) from the free-throw line...VanBrocklin started the weekend with a 17-point, six rebound, five assist performance in a loss at Montana. She went 6-for-11 from the floor with a pair of 3-pointers in 36 minutes...VanBrocklin then led the Vikings with 16 points in an upset win at Montana State, 75-72, The Bobcats almost came back to tie or win the game late, but VanBrocklin hit four straight free throws for the Vikings to secure the win. She went 9-for-10 from the line in the game.

Carli Moreland, Southern Utah - Moreland led the Thunderbirds with 17 points and 10 rebounds in Southern Utah's only outing last week. Moreland went 8-9 from the field and grabbed six offensive boards. She also made an assist, a block and a steal in the game. So far this season Moreland in averaging 9.4 points, 5.5 rebounds, 1.4 blocks and shooting 53.7 percent from the field in conference play, all of which rank among the top 25 marks in the Big Sky.
