TOURNEY TALK

The 2013 Big Sky Conference Championship will be held March 14-16 at the site of the regular season champion. Montana and Weber State enter the last week still in the running to host the Big Sky Championship. The top seven teams from the regular season standings qualify for the tournament. With one week remaining, six teams are battling for the remaining four spots.

Montana (16-1)

Montana will finish either first or second. Only the No. 1 seed gets a bye to the semifinals this season. UM is on the road Monday at Southern Utah, and returns home to face Sacramento State and Northern Arizona. Montana and Weber State split regular-season meetings. If the teams end up tied, the tiebreaker will be determined by UM and WSU's record against teams in descending order. WSU's 2-0 record vs. Montana State could come into play, as could a loss to Southern Utah on Monday. UM's only league loss came to WSU.

Weber State (16-2)

Will finish either first or second. Weber State closes at home this week against Portland State and Eastern Washington. Montana and Weber State split regular-season meetings. WSU's league losses are to UM and MSU. If the teams end up tied, the tiebreaker will be determined by UM and WSU's record against teams in descending order. Weber State could win a tiebreaker if both UM and WSU finish 18-2, UM loses to Southern Utah, and Southern Utah finishes ahead of Montana State. The same would hold true if UM lost to either Sacramento State or Northern Arizona, and one of those teams finished ahead of Montana State.

North Dakota (11-8)

Clinched a spot in the postseason tournament. Can finish no higher than third. Will clinch the No. 3 seed with a victory, or a Southern Utah loss. Southern Utah is the only team that can finish above North Dakota.

Northern Colorado (9-10)

Northern Colorado is on the cusp of qualifying for the tournament. The Bears can finish no higher than fourth. Northern Colorado's final conference game is at home on Saturday against Southern Utah. The Bears could potentially lose tiebreakers to SUU, MSU, NAU and Sacramento State. Northern Colorado has split with MSU, NAU and SAC and is 0-1 vs. Southern Utah.

Southern Utah (8-9)

The Thunderbirds can finish as high as third or not make the tournament. SUU has a home game Monday against first-place Montana, and road games at Northern Colorado and North Dakota. Southern Utah would finish in third place with three victories. With

three losses, Southern Utah would be in danger of not making the seven-team field. Southern Utah has a 2-0 record vs. Northern Arizona, which could prove large in a tiebreaker. The Thunderbirds are 0-2 vs. Montana State, which could also loom large.

Montana State (8-10)

The Bobcats can finish no higher than fourth place and could still finish outside the top seven. Montana State has home games against Northern Arizona and Sacramento State remaining. Montana State has a win over Weber State, which could help the Bobcats in a tiebreaker. Montana State's 2-0 record vs. Southern Utah could also prove large.

Northern Arizona (8-10)

The Lumberjacks can finish as high as fourth or not make the tournament. Northern Arizona closes with road games at Montana State and Montana. Northern Arizona swept the season-series against Sacramento State, lost both games to Southern Utah, split with Northern Colorado, and is 1-0 vs. Montana State.

Sacramento State (8-10)

The Hornets can finish as high as fourth or not make the field. Sacramento State is seeking its first tournament bid since 2006. The Hornets have road games at Montana and Montana State. Sacramento State finished 1-1 vs. Southern Utah, 1-1 vs. Northern Colorado, 0-2 vs. Northern Arizona and is 0-1 vs. Montana State.

Eastern Washington (6-12)

Needs to win its two remaining games against Idaho State and Weber State, and also needs Sacramento State and Northern Arizona to lose both of its games to qualify for the tournament.

Portland State (5-13)

Has been eliminated from postseason contention.

Idaho State (4-14)

Has been eliminated from postseason contention.

BIG SKY MEN'S BASKETBALL - MARCH 4, 2013

In 2013, the Big Sky Championship expands to a seven-team tournament. The No. 1 seed and regular-season champion will host the entire event as the tournament returns to a Thursday-Saturday format. The first day of action on Thursday will feature three games, followed by two semifinals on Friday. The championship will be played on Friday, March 16, at 7 p.m. Mountain, and will be televised on ESPNU.

The Big Sky Conference has determined its champion and NCAA representative with a championship at the conclusion of the regular season every year since the 1975-76 campaign. Prior to the current format, the Big Sky conducted its championship with all eight league teams competing from 1984 through 1988. Ten different teams have won the Big Sky Conference Championship and the right to represent the league in the NCAA Tournament by winning the postseason event.

Big Sky Tiebreaker

1. Head-to-Head Competition

a. Consider the head-to-head record during the Conference season. In double round robin play a team would have to sweep the opponent to break a tie with this method.

b. In the case of more than two tied teams, consider the Conference regular season record for head-to-head competition among all of the tied teams. This process is used to break ties between any of the tied teams with any remaining tied teams returning to the process at criteria 1.a. (above). (Example: Teams A, B, C, and D have identical record from a double round robin season. In head-to-head competition Team A emerges with 4-2 record against the other tied teams, team B and Team C have a 3-3 record and team D has a 2-4 record. Teams A and D can be placed in the final standings at that point while teams B and C return to criteria 1.a. If B and C have split their regular Conference season games, they will move to criteria 2. Performance against other teams in descending order.)

c. In the case of three or more teams having identical win-loss records, the normal tie-breaking procedure would be used. When one or more of these teams is eliminated by using the tie-breaking procedure, the remaining teams involved would then return to the criteria listed in a., above, to break the tie. This will be done until a team is established for that particular seeding position.

2. Performance against Conference teams in descending order of finish, beginning with the No.1 team. (Example: Teams B and C remained tied after head-to-head criteria from above. Team A has been declared the Conference Champion based on the above criteria. Team B has split the Conference season games with team A and team C has lost both of the Conference games to team A. Team B is now placed in second place ahead of team C.)

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MARCH 4

TROY HUFF, JUNIOR, GUARD/FORWARD, NORTH DAKOTA

North Dakota's Troy Huff has been selected as the Big Sky Conference men's basketball Player of the Week after leading his team to a pair of road wins which helped clinch program's first berth in the Big Sky Championship.



Huff, a 6-foot-5 junior guard/forward from Milwaukee, Wisc., averaged 26 points, four rebounds and three steals per game as North Dakota earned its first ever road sweep in Big Sky play. Huff shot .529 percent from the floor and .600 percent from 3-point range.

Huff scored 18 points with four rebounds and four steals in North Dakota's 74-66 victory over Portland State on Thursday night. Huff scored 14 of his 18 points in the second half.

On Saturday, Huff scored a career-high 34 points as North Dakota beat Eastern Washington 78-74 to move to 11-8 in conference, clinching a bid in the postseason tournament. Huff scored North Dakota's first 15 points and netted 20 points in the first seven minutes. Huff finished the first half with 24 points. His 34 points are the second-most by a Big Sky player this season. Huff also had four rebounds and two steals.

This is Huff's third Player of the Week honor this season.

Gabe Rogers, G, Northern Arizona: Averaged 24.5 points per game in a win and a loss.

Derrick Barden, F, Northern Colorado: Averaged 23 points, 9 rebounds and three assists in two wins.

Aaron Moore, F, Portland State: Averaged 18 points and 9.5 rebounds per game in two losses.

THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

The final week of the 2012-13 regular season promises to be memorable. Six teams enter the final week still in the hunt for four spots in the Big Sky Championship. Montana and Weber State are battling for the regular-season title, and the right to host the conference tournament. Eleven games remain until the dust settles on Saturday night. The action begins Monday with a big game in Cedar City as league-leading Montana travels to Southern Utah (8-9). With its sights set on a second straight regular-season title, Montana then returns home to face Sacramento State and Northern Arizona...Second-place Weber State is at home against Portland State and Eastern Washington. PSU has been eliminated from postseason contention. EWU needs two road wins at ISU on Thursday and at WSU on Saturday, as well as other help to make the tournament...MSU, NAU and Sac State all enter the final week 8-10 in league. The Bobcats are at home against both teams, taking on NAU on Thursday and Sacramento State on Saturday...North Dakota (11-8) clinched a bid, and closes out at home against SUU on Saturday...Northern Colorado (9-10) plays its final regular season game on Thursday at home against Southern Utah...ISU, which has been eliminated from postseason contention is at home against EWU and PSU.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

RECORDS FOR LEAGUE WINS: With league teams playing 20 conference games for the first time this season, the conference record for league victories in a season was bound to fall. Weber State and Montana have each reached the 16-win mark in conference. The previous record was 15 set by Weber State twice and Montana once. WSU went 15-0 in 1969-70. The Wildcats went 15-1 in 2007-08, and Montana went 15-1 last season. Montana is 31-2 in regular-season conference games since last season. Weber State is 30-4.

GRIZZLIES REACH 20 WINS: Montana won its 20th game of the season with a 71-68 victory over Montana State on Saturday. The Grizzlies have won at least 20 games in four straight seasons, a feat accomplished just once before in school history. Montana won at least 20 from 1982-1986. Since the Big Sky began in 1963-64, UM has amassed 17 20-win seasons. In the last four seasons, Montana has compiled and 88-34 record.

NORTH DAKOTA CLINCHES BID: North Dakota, which joined the Big Sky on July 1, 2012, clinched a postseason bid on Saturday with a 78-74 road win over Eastern Washington. North Dakota beat PSU on Thursday, meaning the Green & White earned its first ever road sweep in Big Sky play. North Dakota became the first league newcomer to make the tournament in its first season since Cal State Northridge in 1997. The 11 league victories are the most ever by a league newcomer. Northridge held the previous mark with eight wins in 1996-97. Southern Utah, which also joined the league on July 1, has won eight conference games. PSU won six its first season in 1996-97. Boise State and Gonzaga won five conference games in 1970-71. Nevada won five in 1979-80.

SALDIVAR NEARS 500: Northern Arizona senior Stallon Saldivar enters the final weekend of the regular season with 499 career assists. Saldivar returned from an ankle injury to dish out 10 assists in two games last week. Saldivar can become just the eighth player in league history to dish out 500 assists. Saldivar will likely finish his career sixth on the Big Sky's all-time list. Steve Conner (Boise State, 1974-78) is currently sixth with 502 assists. Sacramento State's DeShawn Freeman (2002-06) is seventh with 501. Montana State's Scott Hatler (1992-96) is fifth with 601.

GABE GETTING IT DONE: Northern Arizona senior Gabe Rogers is closing out his collegiate career in strong fashion. In his last 12 games, Rogers is averaging 23.2 points per game, and has scored at least 22 points in 10 of those games. He's made 47 3-pointers in the 12-game run. Rogers enters the final weekend of the regular season - and potentially the final games of his career- with 236 career 3-pointers, which ranks eighth in league history. He's just 10 3-pointers away from moving into the top five. Rogers has 1,369 career points. Rogers has made 84 3-pointers this season, which is tied for 13th in league single-season history.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

BEST IN FEBRUARY: Weber State has compiled a 32-4 record in February over the past five seasons. WSU's winning percentage of .889 is the best of any team in February over the past five seasons. Oakland of the Summit League was 31-5 (.886) the last five years in February, while Gonzaga was 37-5 (.881). Duke was fourth at .833 (35-7) and Belmont, Kansas and Memphis were tied for fifth at 33-7 (.825).

RPI UPDATE: Weber State, winners of nine straight games, has improved its RPI to 90 entering the final week of the regular season. The Wildcats are 10 spots ahead of Montana. The Big Sky is ranked 28th among Division I conferences.

Tip-ins: Road teams won eight of the 10 conference games last week. Home teams are now 62-37 in conference play. PSU is the only team without a conference road win. The Vikings are 0-8 on the road in league and 0-12 overall on the road...SUU's Jackson Stevenett has scored in double figures in 21 straight games, including 10 with at least 20...SUU has a single-season school record 139 blocks this season...EWU has 172 blocked shots. The Eagles need seven to tie the single-season Big Sky record of 179 set by Idaho state in 2005-06...Sacramento State's Jordan Salley, who entered Saturday's game with 18 points and 17 rebounds all season, scored 16 points with 10 rebounds in the Hornets' one-point win over Idaho State...MSU's Flavien Davis scored a career-high 30 points in a 71-68 loss to Montana...WSU's Scott Bamforth ranks 10th in Big Sky history with 222 career 3-pointers...Sacramento State's John Dickson became the 24th player in league history to amass 100 career blocked shots...UND coach Brian Jones won his 100th career game on Saturday...Weber State continues to lead the nation in 3-point field-goal percentage at 43.1 percent. WSU is second in field-goal percentage at 51 percent. The Wildcats are seventh in scoring margin (14.5)...Montana is ninth in the nation in 3-point field-goal percentage (39.7) and ninth in free-throw shooting percentage (76.2)...EWU is ninth in the nation in blocked shots per game (5.9)...SUU's Jackson Stevenett is sixth in the nation in free-throw percentage (89.2), WSU's Scott Bamforth is 10th (89.0)...WSU's nine-game winning streak is tied for the ninth longest active streak in the nation...Montana has won 24 consecutive regular-season conference home games and 27 in a row overall against Big Sky teams at home...Montana is 13th in this week's College Insider. Com Mid-Major Top 25. Weber State is 15th...EWU's Martin Seiferth had 35 rebounds in two games last week.
