TIE-BREAKER SYSTEM

1. HEAD TO HEAD COMPETITION

A. CONSIDER THE HEAD-TO-HEAD RECORD DURING THE CONFERENCE SEASON. IN DOUBLE ROUND-ROBIN PLAY, A TEAM WOULD HAVE TO SWEEP THE OPPONENT TO BREAK A TIE WITH THIS METHOD.

B. IN THE CASE OF MORE THAN TWO TIED TEAMS, CONSIDER THE CONFERENCE REGULAR-SEASON RECORD FOR HEAD-TO-HEAD COMPETITION AMONG ALL OF THE TIED TEAMS. THIS PROCESS IS USED TO BREAK TIES BETWEEN ANY OF THE TIED TEAMS WITH ANY REMAINING TIED TEAMS RETURNING TO THE PROCESS AT CRITERIA 1.A. EXAMPLE: TEAMS A, B, C, AND D HAVE IDENTICAL RECORDS FROM A DOUBLE ROUND ROBIN SEASON. IN HEAD-TO-HEAD COMPETITION, TEAM A EMERGES WITH A 4-2 RECORD AGAINST THE OTHER TIED TEAMS, TEAM B AND C HAVE A 3-3 RECORD AND TEAM D HAS A 2-4 RECORD. TEAMS A AND D CAN BE PLACED IN THE FINAL STANDINGS AT THAT POINT, WHILE TEAMS B AND C RETURN TO CRITERIA 1.A. IF B AND C HAVE SPLIT THEIR REGULAR CONFERENCE SEASON GAMES, THEY WILL MOVE TO CRITERIA 2, PERFORMANCE AGAINST OTHER TEAMS IN DESCENDING ORDER.

C. IN THE CASE OF THREE OR MORE TEAMS HAVING IDENTICAL WIN-LOSS RECORDS, THE NORMAL TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE WOULD BE USED. WHEN ONE OR MORE OF THESE TEAMS IS ELIMINATED BY USING THE TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE, THE REMAINING TEAMS INVOLVED WOULD THEN RETURN TO THE CRITERIA LISTED IN A. TO BREAK THE TIE. THIS WILL BE DONE UNTIL A TEAM IS ESTABLISHED FOR THAT PARTICULAR SEEDING POSITION.

2. PERFORMANCE AGAINST CONF. TEAMS

THIS WILL BE DETERMINED IN DESCENDING ORDER OF FINISH, BEGINNING WITH THE NO. 1 TEAM. (EXAMPLE: TEAMS B AND C REMAINED TIED AFTER HEAD-TO-HEAD CRITERIA FROM ABOVE. TEAM A HAS BEEN DECLARED THE CONFERENCE CHAMPION BASED ON THE ABOVE CRITERIA. TEAM B HAS SPLIT THE CONFERENCE SEASON GAMES WITH TEAM A, AND TEAM C HAS LOST BOTH OF THE CONFERENCE GAMES TO TEAM A. TEAM B IS NOW PLACED IN SECOND PLACE AHEAD OF TEAM C.)

3. RPI RATING

4. COIN TOSS

NOTE: IN ALL TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES, IF MORE THAN ONE TIE EXISTS, THE TIE AMONG/BETWEEN THE TEAMS LOWER IN DESCENDING ORDER WILL BE BROKEN FIRST, TO FACILITATE THE PROCESS OF BREAKING THE TIE BETWEEN/AMONG TEAMS HIGHER IN THE ORDER. (EXAMPLE: TEAMS A AND B ARE TIED FOR FIRST AND SECOND, AND TEAMS C AND D ARE TIED FOR FOURTH AND FIVE. ALL TIED TEAMS HAVE SPLIT THE REGULAR CONFERENCE SEASON WITH THEIR TIED OPPONENTS. TEAMS C AND D BOTH HAVE A 1-3 COMBINED RECORD VS. TEAMS A AND B. TEAM C HAS BEATEN TEAM A, AND D HAS BEATEN TEAM B. ASSUMING ALL PREVIOUS TIEBREAKERS ARE THE SAME, TEAMS C AND D WILL HAVE THEIR PLACING DECIDED BY THEIR RPI RANKING FIRST (CRITERIA 3), AND THE TEAMS A AND B ENTER THE TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES.).

BIG SKY HIGHLIGHTS

Coming Up: It's the final week of regular season. Starting tonight, Montana State will hosts Southern Utah at 7:05 p.m. Mountain. Conference play will continue on Thursday and Saturday.

TV Games: Two games can be seen on NAU-TV/FCS this week. On Thursday at 6:35 p.m. Mountain, Northern Arizona will host Montana. And on Saturday, Montana State will travel to NAU for a 12:05 p.m. Mountain tip off.

Watching Career Records: Kylie Kuhns broke the Big Sky record in career rebounds. She now has 1,185 in her career. She broke the record of 1,174 set from 2004-08 by Natalie Doma of Idaho State. Kuhns became the fifth player in Big Sky history to have more than 1,000 rebounds...Amy Patton is chasing a record of her own. She is chasing the career points scored. Currently she is ranked fifth in Big Sky history with 1,908 points. The record of 2,296 was also set by Natalie Doma from 2004-08. On Thursday, Megan Kritscher broke the single-season record for blocked shots. She has 102 for the season.

Clinched Spots In Postseason Tournament: Five teams have clinched a spot in the Big Sky Conference Tournament March 14-16.

Breaking A Record: This past week, Weber State broke the Big Sky record for consecutive losses. WSU had 19 last season added on to the 27 this season. Sacramento State held the record of 44 set from 2000-03.

Individual Single-Game Ranks: On Nov. 24, NAU's Amy Patton tied the single-game record for points scored with 41 against Bradley. She became the fourth person to tie that record...That same game, Patton had 10 steals, which ranks tied for second in single game, and she also is tied for third in field-goals attempted with 29...On Dec. 1, against Oregon State, SAC's Se'nyce Parris made nine 3-pointers, which ties for first in single-game history. She also ranks tied for seventh with 39 points scored. And on Nov. 24, PSU's Angela Misa had 21 rebounds against Butler, which ranks tied for sixth in a single game.

Team Single-Game Ranks: On Dec. 8, Southern Utah scored 15 3-pointers against San Jose State. That ranks tied for fourth in a single-game...Northern Colorado ranks four times in a single-game as they defeated Johnson & Wales on Dec. 30. NC ranks tied for first in rebounds with 71, tied for fourth in 3-point field-goals made with 15, eighth in 3-point field-goals attempted with 36, and tied for ninth with 102 points scored.

NC STRANGE NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (March 4, 2013) - Northern Colorado's D'shara Strange has been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week for the games played the week of Feb. 25-March 3.

Strange, a junior from Fort Carson, Colo., led the Bears to a pair of important home wins, hitting the game-winning shot with 2.1 seconds remaining against Eastern Washington on Thursday and scoring the first 15 points of the game against Portland State on Saturday.

The two wins keep the Bears within striking distance of the Big Sky regular season title.

For the week, Strange averaged 24.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game. She shot .513 from the field and .800 from the free-throw line. She scored 21 in the win over the Eagles and had a season-high 28 in the win over Portland State, including 24 in the first half (she played just eight minutes in second half).

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Kylie Huerta, Eastern Washington - Huerta had an impressive weekend for the Eagles, averaging 11.5 points on 50 percent shooting, while also tallying 14 total assists with just two turnovers. She went 5-of-7 from beyond the arc and also had five steals...In Eastern's 67-58 win over North Dakota, Huerta contributed in every aspect of the game, finishing with nine points, eight assists, three season and three rebounds. She had just one turnover in 36 minutes of work, upholding her ranking as No. 1 in the conference in assist-to-turnover ratio...In a narrow one-point loss to second-place Northern Colorado, Huerta had 14 points on an impressive 6-of-8 effort from the floor. She converted both of her attempts from distance, and had six assists, two steals, two rebounds, with again, just one single turnover.

Kaela Oakes, Idaho State - Oakes averaged 16.5 points per game last weekend and shot 60 percent (6-10) from the 3-point line. In ISU's 67-46 win over NAU, she scored a team high 18 points. She went 4-6 from the arc, had two assists and five steals. Against Sacramento State, she had 15 points and shot 2-4 from 3-point range. She also three rebounds, one assist and one steal. ISU has won three straight and defeated their last three opponents by a combined 72 points.

Jordan Sullivan, Montana - Sullivan averaged 9.0 points on 46.7 percent shooting and 6.5 rebounds as Montana remained atop the Big Sky Conference standings with two victories last week... Sullivan had 6 points, 7 rebounds and a pair of steals in Thursday's 70-54 home win over Southern Utah and 12 points, 6 rebounds and 4 assists in Saturday's 58-55 victory at Montana State. Ther 12 points matched her season high, her four assists were a season high.

Amanda Frost, Northern Arizona - Frost averaged 11.5 points per game while shooting 8-of-16 (50%) from the field and 6-of-6 (100%) from the free-throw line as NAU lost at Idaho State and defeated Weber State. She totaled 23 points in the two games while adding a team-best five assists, eight rebounds, four steals, and a block. Frost was the only Lumberjack to score in double-figures at Idaho State, finishing with 11 points, two rebounds, two steals, and a block against the Bengals. She then added 12 points of 6-of-10 shooting at Weber State with six rebounds, five assists, and two steals to lead NAU to a 65-49 win.

Kylie Kuhns, Sacramento State - Kuhns became the Big Sky's all-time rebounds leader and averaged 21.5 points, 13.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists while shooting 72 percent from the field in a pair of games over the weekend. Kuhns posted the third 20-20 game of her career with 21 points and 20 rebounds (10 offensive, 10 defensive) in a record-setting win at Weber State before tallying a game-high 22 points to go with seven rebounds in a loss at Idaho State. In the win against Weber State, Kuhns eclipsed Natalie Doma's Big Sky career record of 1,174 rebounds. Kuhns now has 1,185 rebounds in four stellar seasons, which is 10.1 per game over 117 career contests. Kuhns grabbed 12 offensive rebounds over the weekend, more than the rest of the Hornets combined (11).

Carli Moreland, Southern Utah - Moreland led Southern Utah with 12 points as the T-Birds dropped a 70-54 contest at Montana in their lone outing of the week. The junior forward went 5-7 from floor and 2-3 at the foul line while collecting seven rebounds and handing out two assists in the game. For the season Moreland leads SUU with an average of 6.5 rpg and ranks fourth on the team in scoring with 8.4 ppg while shooting 52 percent from the field.
