EAGLES TO WATCH



ALLIE SCHUMACHER
 Sophomore
 6-1 • Outside Hitter
 Puyallup, Wash.

- Schumacher had a stellar freshman campaign in 2012 for the Eagles, finishing second on the team with an average of 2.63 kills per set.
- Schumacher exploded for 35 kills on 68 swings to go along with 11 digs in Eastern's first win of the season, a five-set victory over Northern Arizona. Schumacher totaled 10 outings of at least 40 kills and racked up five double-doubles.
- Schumacher upped her play in Big Sky matches, averaging 2.87 kills per set while hitting .182 (193-90-559). She tallied 11 service aces in league play and contributed 133 digs and 23 total blocks.

- Fermantez paced Eastern with 88 total blocks as a sophomore in 2012, averaging 0.91 blocks per set. She was also the third-best hitter on the squad, putting away 225 kills for an average of 2.32 kills per set.
- Fermantez went for double-figure kills in eight matches, routinely hitting above .250 while averaging more than five attacks per set. She notched a career-best 18 kills on 35 swings against North Dakota (Nov. 10).
- The Eagles' most reliable middle blocker, Fermantez tallied 13 solo blocks and assisted on 75 blocks, recording at least one block in all but four matches in which she played. She had at least five total blocks in seven matches, four of which came against Big Sky foes.

EAGLE TEAM NOTES

•Wade Benson, head coach of the Eagles from 2000-06, returns to Eastern to once again lead the program heading into the 2013 season. In his seven years at EWU, Benson compiled an impressive record of 154-55 (.737), the best winning percentage of any coach in school history. Benson led the Eagles to six consecutive 20-win seasons, three Big Sky regular-season titles and one Big Sky Tournament title in 2001. EWU played in the Big Sky Tournament championship match in each of his seven years at the helm, and Eastern's win over Oregon State in the 2001 NCAA Championship marked the first time a Big Sky program advanced past the tournament's opening round.

•Eastern returns four starters and nine letter winners from last year's squad that won five of its final nine Big Sky matches. EWU welcomes back 63 percent of its kills and six players who averaged at least one kill per set, headlined by sophomore Allie Schumacher (200 k, 2.63 k/s) and junior Talia Fermantez (225 k, 2.32 k/s). Senior Lindsay Niemeier looks poised for a strong 2013 campaign after suffering a season-ending injury in Eastern's first game last year. She led EWU with 639 assists in 2011, averaging 5.71 assists per set.

HEAD COACH WADE BENSON

- Wade Benson returns to Eastern's sideline in 2013 after serving as EWU's head coach from 2000-06. He won three Big Sky titles during his first tenure, taking the Eagles to the second round of the NCAA

Championship in 2001. Under his tutelage, EWU won at least 20 games in six of his seven seasons, highlighted by a 29-2 campaign in 2002.

• Benson was most recently the head coach at Auburn, leading the Tigers to 21 wins and the second round of the NCAA Championship in 2010. The Tigers finished third in the SEC in 2010 after winning just one league game in 2008.

• Benson has twice won Big Sky Coach of the Year honors, earning the award in 2002 and again in 2006. He led the Eagles to a 29-2 record

and a Big Sky regular-season title in 2002. The Eagles' 2006 squad finished with 20 wins and advanced to the championship match of the Big Sky Tournament.

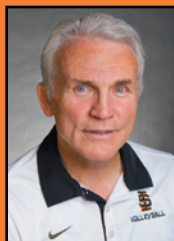
BENGAL TEAM NOTES

• The Bengals 10-0 home record was their second undefeated home season in program history. The first came in 1987 when head coach Jim Churniss led the Bengals to a 15-0 home record.

• With 23 total wins, the 2012 team is tied for third-most wins in a season in program history. The winningest season was recorded in 1987 when Jim Cherniss led ISU to a 31-5 finish.

• The Bengals return their libero and four starters including Big Sky MVP Lori Mendenhall-Lee and Big Sky All-Conference Honorable Mention Tressa Lyman. They lose Breanne Van Every and Jaclyn Hone-Hawkins, both second-team Big Sky All-Conference.

• Weindel was named the ninth head coach in Montana State University volleyball history on Feb. 7, 2012. and three NCAA appearances. In addition, the program notched a 95-39 overall mark and a 50-13 slate in MAC play during that same period.
