OFFENSE - Jordan Johnson, QB, Montana



Johnson, a 6-foot-1, 200-pound junior from Eugene, Ore., set a Big Sky Conference single-game pass efficiency record in Montana's 55-17 non-conference win over North Dakota. Johnson completed 15-of-19 passes for a career-high 354 yards with five touchdowns and no interceptions for an efficiency rating of 322.3. Johnson averaged 23.6 yards per reception. Johnson guided the Grizzlies to touchdowns on all eight drives he played. He threw TD passes of 70, 52, 35, 6 and 51 yards. Johnson also rushed for 21 yards to finish with 375 yards of total offense. Montana finished with 609 yards of offense.

DEFENSE - Lucky Dozier, S, Northern Arizona



Dozier, a 5-8, 185-pound senior from Sacramento, Calif., returned an interception 78 yards for a touchdown in the fourth quarter of Northern Arizona's 21-10 non-conference victory over UC Davis. NAU trailed UC Davis 10-7 with the Aggies driving and under 10 minutes to play. Dozier intercepted a Jimmy Laughrea pass on third down and returned it to put the Lumberjacks ahead for good. Dozier also had four tackles. NAU's defense scored two touchdowns, and held UC Davis to 12 first downs and 245 yards of total offense.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Brendon Garica, K, Idaho State



Garcia, a 5-11, 150-pound senior from Danville, Calif., won Special Teams honors for the second straight week. Garcia drilled field goals of 30, 47 and 50 yards in Idaho State's 29-3 victory over Western State. Garcia also made three extra points to finish with 12 points. Garcia is 7-of-7 on field-goal attempts this season. He leads the nation in field goals per game at 3.5.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

MR. EFFICIENT: Montana junior quarterback Jordan Johnson set the Big Sky single-game record for passing efficiency. Johnson completed 15-of-19 passes for a career-high 354 yards with five touchdowns and no interceptions in a 55-17 win at North Dakota. Johnson had a rating of 322.3. The previous record was 310.4 by Eastern Washington's Mark Tenneson in a 1992 game against Sonoma State. Tenneson completed 10-of-14 passes for 265 yards and four touchdowns. Johnson opened the game with an incompleion, but found the mark on his next nine passes. He led Montana to touchdowns on all eight drives he played. Johnson averaged 23.6 yards per completion and 18.6 yards per attempt. Montana amassed 609 yards of total offense. After two games, Johnson leads the nation in pass efficiency at 257.0. He has completed 34 of 42 passes for 605 yards with seven touchdowns and no interceptions. Three of the top five QBs in efficiency in the FCS are from the Big Sky. EWU's Vernon Adams is third at 192.1 Portland State's Kieran McDonagh is fifth at 181.9.

CARTER TIES TD MARK: Sacramento State wide receiver DeAndre Carter tied the Big Sky single-game record with five touchdown receptions in the Hornets' 63-56 overtime win over Southern Oregon. Carter tied the mark previously set by Northern Arizona's Rod Marshall in a 1995 game against Abilene Christian. Carter had 12 catches for 122 yards. He caught TD passes of 12, 7, 22, 6 and 14 yards. His fourth TD of the game came with just one second left in regulation. His fifth, a 14-yarder, tied the game. The 12 receptions for the third-most in single-game Sacramento State history. He broke the previous school record of four TD receptions set by tight end Chris Kelly in a 1999 loss to Montana. Carter was named the Sports Network Co-Offensive Player of the Week. Sacramento State QB Garrett Safron threw seven TD passes on Saturday, breaking the single-game school record of six set by Ryan Leadingham. Sacramento State ran 101 offensive plays, tying the school record.

SOUERS TIES READ: Northern Arizona coach Jerome Souers won his 85th career game on Saturday, leading the Lumberjacks to a 21-10 non-conference win over UC Davis. Souers is now tied for second all-time in league history in career victories. Read won 85 games for Montana from 1986-95. The all-time leader is Nevada's Chris Ault with 111 wins. Souers was a long-time assistant under Read. Souers has an overall record of 85-86. He is the longest-tenured head coach in Northern Arizona football history, and is tied for the longest-tenured head coach with Idaho State's Mike Kramer. Kramer has won 82 games at Eastern Washington, Montana State and Idaho State. Souers can move into sole possession of second place with a win on Saturday against South Dakota.

NAU'S RUSH KING PASSES KING: Northern Arizona's Zach Bauman became the school's all-time leading rusher on Saturday night, picking up 56 yards. Bauman surpassed Marcus King, who rushed for 3,794 career yards from 1998-2001. Bauman now ranks 9th all-time in Big Sky history with 3,803 yards. Bauman broke the record with a 4-yard run at the end of the first half. Bauman needs 214 yards to move into eighth place. Bauman is just 682 yards to move into fourth place.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

SOLID STARTING DEBUT: Montana State sophomore Jake Bleskin completed 26 of 35 passes for 305 yards and two touchdowns in his first career start, leading the Bobcats to a 26-0 win over Division II Colorado Mesa. In his first four drives, MSU scored a field goal and two touchdowns. Ten of his passes were caught by his brother Tanner, a senior wide receiver. Bleskin became just the third Bobcat QB to throw for 300 yards in his first start.

BENGALS 2-0: Idaho State, which finished 1-10 last season, is 2-0 for the first time since 1999. Idaho State beat Western State 29-3 last week in Pocatello. The Bengals face a very stiff challenge on Saturday, traveling to Washington of the Pac-12 Conference. Washington is ranked 17th in this week's AP poll. Idaho State currently leads the Big Sky in total defense and scoring defense. Idaho State has 10 sacks in two games this season after amassing just seven all of last season. The Bengals were last in both categories in the league last season. Idaho State has not started a season 3-0 since 1995.

IN THE TOP 25: Five Big Sky Conference teams are once again ranked in both major FCS polls this week. Eastern Washington is second in the Sports Network, followed closely by Montana State. Montana State moved to No. 2 in the Coaches' Poll, while Eastern Washington fell to fourth. North Dakota State is first in both polls. Montana improved to ninth in the Sports Network Poll and to 11th in the Coaches' Poll. Cal Poly dropped to 18th in the Sports Network and 19th in the Coaches' Poll. Northern Arizona is tied for 22nd in the Coaches' Poll, and 25th in the Sports Network Poll.

VIKING OFFENSE ON A ROLL: Portland State has amassed at least 600 yards of offense in all three games this season. The Vikings rank second in the nation with an average of 61.5.7 yards of offense per game. PSU is fourth in the nation in rushing offense (295 yards per game) and eighth in passing (320.7 yards per game). The Vikings are also seventh in scoring offense (43.3 points per game). Portland State wide receiver Kasey Closs had 10 catches for 205 yards and a touchdown in last week's 43-6 win over Humboldt State. Closs became the first Viking since Tremayne Kirkland in 2008 to have 200 receiving yards in a game. The only negative for the Viking offense has been fumbles. PSU has lost nine fumbles in three games after losing just eight last season.

SAGARIN RATINGS: The Big Sky is once again ranked third in this week's Sagarin ratings among FCS conferences behind the Missouri Valley and CAA. Montana is ranked 79th overall and third among FCS teams. Eastern Washington is 83rd overall and fifth among FCS teams. Montana State is 96th overall and ninth among FCS teams. Northern Arizona (22) and Cal Poly (24) are also in the top 25 of FCS teams.

Extra points: Montana State has not turned the ball over in three games. nell and Western Illinois are the only other teams in FCS without a turnover... Portland State's defense had eight sacks and 18 tackles for loss in its win over Humboldt State. PSU leads the nation with an average of 11.7 tackles for loss per game...Sacramento State's Ezekiel Graham rushed for 166 yards and finished with 256 all-purpose yards in the win over Western Oregon...UC Davis held NAU to just 191 yards of total offense. It was the first time the Aggies held an opponent under 200 yards since limiting Montana State to 194 in 2006... UND WR Kenny Golloday has back-to-back 100 yard receiving games for the first time in his career...MSU DE Brad Daly tallied four sacks in the Bobcats' win over Colorado Mesa. The 26-0 win over Colorado Mesa was MSU's first shutout since 2006...EWU LB Ronnie Hamlin had 14 tackles against Toledo, marking the 10th game he's finished in double-figure tackles...Through two games Montana has converted an FCS-best 72 percent of its third downs. UM was 9-of-10 on third downs against North Dakota...Southern Utah is third in the nation in time of possession, averaging 35 minutes and 42 seconds per game.
