ROOT SPORTS Players of the Week Sept. 2

OFFENSE - Vernon Adams, 6-0, 190, Quarterback, Eastern Washington



Adams, a 6-foot, 190-pound sophomore quarterback from Pasadena, Calif., engineered one of the biggest upsets in FCS history, leading the Eastern Washington Eagles to a 49-46 victory over No. 25 Oregon State of the Pac-12. Adams completed 23-of-30 passes for a career-high 411 yards with four touchdowns and no interceptions. He also rushed for 107 yards on 16 carries with two touchdowns, including the game-winner with 18 seconds to play.

Adams' 518 yards of total offense set the Reser Stadium record, as well as the EWU single-game record. Adams, who had to be taken to the locker-room early in the second half to be treated for dehydration with an IV, threw touchdown passes of 24, 31, 48 and 47 yards and scored on runs of 19 and 2 yards. Adams capped an 11-play, 75-yard run with a 2-yard touchdown run for the game-winner.

DEFENSE - Brad Daly, 6-1, 240, Linebacker, Montana State



Daly, a 6-1, 240-pound senior from Helena, Mont., led Montana State's defense in a 42-24 victory over FCS Independent Monmouth. Daly played just more than two quarters, recording six tackles - four for loss - with a sacks, a forced fumble, two pass breakups, and two quarterback hurries. He also threw a key block during Craigh Ashworth's 57-yard interception return for a touchdown in the second quarter. Montana State led

39-3 at the half. Monmouth had just five first downs and 140 yards of offense in the first half.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Colton Cook, 5-8, 185, Sr., Kicker, Southern Utah



Colton Cook, a 5-foot-8, 185-pound senior from Centerville, Utah, kicked three field goals, including the game-winner as time expired in Southern Utah's 22-21 upset of FBS squad South Alabama. Cook drilled a 28-yarder from the left hash as time expired to give the Thunderbirds their second win over an FBS team in three seasons. Cook got Southern Utah on the board with a 33-yard field goal in the third quarter. He drilled a 37-yarder in the third quarter to give his team a 13-7 lead. Cook also made his only extra point try to finish the game with 10 points.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

EAGLES TAKE DOWN RANKED FBS TEAM: Eastern Washington became just the fourth FCS team to beat a ranked FBS team last Saturday, shocking Oregon State 49-46 in Corvallis. Oregon State, which returned 16 starters from a 9-4 2012 team, entered the season ranked 25th in both major polls. Eastern Washington sophomore QB Vernon Adams completed 23-of-30 passes for 411 yards with four touchdowns and no interceptions. He also rushed for 107 yards and two touchdowns, including the game-winner with 18 seconds to play. It was the first win over a Pac-12 team for the Eagles, but marked the third straight season a Big Sky team has upset a Pac-12 squad. Sacramento State beat Oregon State in 2011, and Sacramento State upset Colorado in 2012. EWU scored on nine of its 10 possessions against the Beavers, and finished with 625 yards of total offense. Adams' 518 yards of total offense set a Reser Stadium record. EWU had been 0-9 against current members of the Pac-12, including a 30-27 loss at Washington in 2011, and a 24-20 loss to Washington State in 2012. This marked the second straight season EWU has beaten an FBS team. The Eagles beat Idaho 20-3 to start the 2012 season.

ANOTHER FBS WIN: Last year Big Sky Conference teams earned four wins over FBS opponents. It didn't take long for the first to come this season, as Southern Utah edged South Alabama of the Sun Belt Conference 22-21 in the first game of the season for a Big Sky team. Southern Utah led 10-0, but had to rally from a 21-13 fourth-quarter deficit. All-American kicker Colton Cook made a 28-yard field goal as time expired. Cook was 3-for-3 on field-goal attempts. It was the second FBS win for Southern Utah. The Thunderbirds beat UNLV 41-16 during the 2011 season. Aaron Cantu, making his first career start, completed 13-of-24 passes for 183 yards and a touchdown. Freshman Raysean Martin rushed 23 times for 107 yards and a touchdown in his first career start.

FCS SHINES: Eastern Washington and Southern Utah were two of eight FCS teams to notch victories over FBS teams, making it one of the most successful weekends by FCS squads. Two-time defending national champion North Dakota State upset Kansas State of the Big 12 24-21, Northern Iowa beat Iowa State 28-20, Towson upset UConn 33-18, McNeese State drilled South Florida 53-21, Eastern Illinois beat San Diego State 40-19, and Samford beat Georgia State 31-23. Last season, there were 10 victories by FCS teams over FBS teams.

JOHNSON BUSTS A LONG ONE: Montana State junior running back Shawn Johnson scored on a 90-yard run in the first quarter of the No. 2 Bobcats' 42-24 win over Monmouth. It marked the first 90-yard scoring run in the Big Sky since the 2009 season when Eastern Washington's Taiwan Jones scored on a 96-yard run against Idaho State. The longest scoring run in 2012 was 78 yards by Northern Arizona's Austin Shanks. The longest run during the 2011 season was 82 yards by Northern Arizona's Giovannie Dixon, and the longest scoring run in 2010 was by Northern Arizona's Zach Bauman. Johnson finished the game with a career-high 109 yards on five carries. It was his first career 100-yard rushing game.

FIREWORKS IN GRAND FORKS: North Dakota opened its second season in the Big Sky by topping Valparaiso of the FCS Pioneer League 69-10. The 69 points scored were the most ever in a season opener by UND, and the most since a 69-0 win over Morningside in 1972. North Dakota scored six rushing touchdowns - three by Jake Miller and three by Adam Shaugabay. All-American Greg Hardin scored on a 75-yard catch on the first offensive play, and also had a 90-yard kick return for a touchdown. Sophomore Kenny Golladay took his first career punt return 64 yards for a touchdown. Freshman Ryan Bartels completed 10-of-12 passes for 212 yards in his first career start.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

QUICK OUT OF THE GATE: Weber State scored its first offensive touchdown on its sixth offensive play in a 50-40 win over Stephen F. Austin on Saturday. The Wildcats wound up with 23 first-quarter points. In 2012, Weber State scored a grand total of 29 first-quarter points. Weber State failed to score a first-quarter point in its first five games, and didn't score a first-quarter touchdown until the 10th game. Weber State scored three first-quarter touchdowns in all of 2012. The Wildcats had three against Stephen F. Austin - one on offense, one by the defense, and one on special teams.

BAUMAN ON VERGE OF TOP 10: Northern Arizona senior RB Zack Bauman rushed for 71 yards in a 35-0 loss to Arizona. Bauman upped his career total to 3,747 yards, 11th on the Big Sky's all-time list. He is just one yard behind Idaho's Sherriden May, who rushed for 3,748 yards from 1991-94. Bauman needs 48 yards to become Northern Arizona's all-time leading rusher. Marcus King rushed for 3,794 yards from 1998-2001 for the Lumberjacks. Charles Roberts of Sacramento State (1997-2000) is the all-time leader with 6,553.

ADAMS EARNS NATIONAL HONORS: Eastern Washington sophomore quarterback earned a plethora of national honors after leading the Eagles to the upset of Oregon State. Adams became the first Big Sky player to be named the CBS Sports National Offensive Player of the Week, an honor normally reserved for FBS players. Adams was also named the National Player of the Week by The Sports Network, College Sporting News, College Sports Madness and the College Football Performance Awards.

HAPPY RETURNS: Montana, Weber State and Southern Utah all welcomed back explosive players to the lineup last week. Montana junior QB Jordan Johnson returned after sitting out last season to lead the Grizzlies to a 30-6 victory over No. 12 Appalachian State. Johnson completed his first 12 passes and finished the night 19-of-23 for 251 yards with two touchdowns and no interceptions. Weber State welcomed back junior Bo Bolen, who sat out the last two seasons while serving and LDS Mission. Bolen amassed 215 all-purpose yards and three touchdowns in a 50-40 win over Stephen F. Austin. Bolen returned a kickoff 100 yards for a touchdown. Bolen became the sixth Weber State player to return a kick 100 yards for a touchdown. He scored on runs of 19 and 1 yards. SUU linebacker Matt Holley, who returned from an LDS mission, had a career-high 13 tackles - three for loss in the win over South Alabama. On USA's final drive he had a tackle for a 4-yard loss on second down and a QB hurry on third, forcing the Jaguars to punt and setting up SUU's winning drive.

FIVE RANKED: Five Big Sky teams are once again ranked in both major FCS top 25 polls. Eastern Washington moved to No. 2 in both polls, behind two-time defending national champion North Dakota State. Montana State is third in both polls. Cal Poly is ranked 10th by the coaches and 12th by the Sports Network. Montana moved to 13th in the Sports Network Poll and to 18th in the Coaches' Poll. Northern Arizona fell to 22nd in the Sports Network and 24th in the Coaches' Poll. Only the CAA with six ranked teams has more ranked than the Big Sky.

EXTRA POINTS: Portland State had 672 yards of total offense in its win over Eastern Oregon, the 10th-most in school history. PSU had 405 rushing yards, which ranked fourth all-time in school history...A Bobcat Stadium crowd of 21,007 watched Montana State's win over Monmouth...Montana beat Appalachian State in front of a Washington-Grizzly Stadium record crowd of 26,293...Northern Colorado won its fourth straight game dating back to last season with a 31-10 win over NAIA Langston. Junior WR Dimitri Stimpfhill caught five passes for a career-high 219 yards. He caught TD passes of 60 and 80 yards in the third quarter...Cal Poly junior slotback Kristaan Ivory rushed for 185 yards and three touchdowns in the Mustangs' win over San Diego. He scored on an 81-yard run on Cal Poly's first offensive play of the season, and later added scoring runs of 2 and 61 yards...The Big Sky went 5-1 on the opening weekend against other FCS teams. The only loss was a 10-7 setback by UC Davis to South Dakota of the Missouri Valley Conference...ISU coach Mike Kramer can move into sole possession of fourth place on the Big Sky's all-time victories list with a win on Saturday. He is currently tied for third with 80 wins. Northern Arizona's Jerome Souers is third on the list with 84.

Series History: First Meeting

The Coaches: Sacramento State coach Marshall Sperbeck is 30-38 in his seventh season with the Hornets. Todd Graham is 8-5 in his second season with ASU. Graham is 57-34 in his eighth season as a head coach. He was previously at Rice, Tulsa and Pittsburgh.

Notes: Sacramento State has knocked off Pac-12 teams each of the past two seasons, beating Oregon State in 2011 and Colorado in 2012...The Sun Devils finished the 2012 season ranked No. 14 in the country in scoring offense (38.3 ppg), scoring 40 or more points seven times. This is the first game of the season for the Sun Devils...Sacramento State opened with a 24-0 loss at San Jose State...It was the first time the Hornets had been shutout since a 58-0 loss to New Mexico in 2007...Sac State QB Garrett Safron ranks seventh in school history with 293 career completions. He ranks eighth in attempts with 480...ASU junior QB Taylor Kelly completed 67.1 percent of his passes for 3,039 yards with 29 touchdowns and nine interceptions last season.

Series History: Utah leads 3-0.

Last Meeting: Utah beat Weber State 37-21 in 2008 in Salt Lake City. Cameron Higgins threw for 303 yards and three touchdowns in the loss.

The Coaches: Jody Sears is 3-9 in his second season with Weber State. Utah's Kyle Whittingham is 73-32 in his ninth season. He was an assistant coach at Idaho State in the Big Sky from 1988-93.

Notes: Utah is 35-0 all-time against Big Sky schools...Sears was an assistant at Washington State in 2011 when Whittingham and the Utes beat the Cougars 30-27 in OT...The teams first met in 1978. Utah won 30-7. In 1984, Utah won 51-7...Utah opened with a 30-26 win over Utah State...Utah QB Travis Wilson threw for 302 yards and two touchdowns with no interceptions in the win over the Aggies...Utah's Co-Offensive Coordinator is Dennis Erickson, a former head coach at Idaho in the Big Sky...WSU scored 23 first-quarter points last week.
