BIG SKY HIGHLIGHTS

After a couple of weeks of conference action, North Dakota remains the only team undefeated in league play with a 5-0 record. Sacramento State fell at home Saturday for the first time this season and lost its first conference game of the season. SAC fell to Southern Utah 79-97. The Thunderbirds shot 67.4 percent from the floor to the Hornets 37.5 percent. The 79 points for SAC was its lowest point total this season.

Conference play will continue tonight (Monday) at 6:35 p.m. Mountain when Northern Arizona hosts Southern Utah. That game can be seen on NAU-TV and WatchBigSky.com. All five games on Thursday and Saturday can also be seen on WatchBigSky.com for free.

Sacramento State set a new Big Sky record in Team Single Game Records with 21 3-pointers made. SAC did that on Dec. 14th against UC Irvine. They attempted 55 3-pointers against UC Irvine, which is also a Big Sky record.

Southern Utah set a new Big Sky record in rebounds with 74. SUU did that on Dec. 16th against Arizona Christian.

UM COLE NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (January 13, 2014) - Montana's Kellie Cole has been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week for the games played the week of Jan. 6-12.

Cole, a junior from Bozeman, Mont., averaged 22.5 points on .667 shooting and 6.0 rebounds per game to lead Montana to home wins last week over Eastern Washington and Portland State. Cole went 6 for 7 (.857) from 3-point range, 7 for 8 (.875) from the free throw line and added five steals and three assists.

In Thursday's 81-64 victory over Eastern Washington in a matchup of the teams picked first and second in the Big Sky Conference preseason coaches' poll, Cole had 22 points, seven rebounds and four assists. She went 7 for 13 from the field, 3 for 4 from 3-point range and 5 for 6 from the line.

In Saturday's 94-58 win over Portland State, Cole had 23 points and five rebounds. Cole hit her first seven shots of the game and had 18 points at the half as Montana took a 48-30 lead into the break. She went 9 for 11 for the game and hit all three of her attempts from 3-point range and both of her free throws.

Cole has scored 21 or more points in all four of Montana's Big Sky games and is 11 for 13 (.846) from 3-point range during league play.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Lexie Nelson, Eastern Washington - Nelson extended her double-figure scoring streak to 12 consecutive games this past weekend, reaching double digits against both Montana and Montana State. She had a team-high 11 points against the Griz, knocking down a pair of three-pointers and all three of her free throw attempts. She again led the way on Saturday versus the Bobcats, pouring in 19 points and finishing 9-of-10 from the charity stripe. She added a team-best four assists to go along with a pair of steals.

Ashley Brumwell, Montana State - Brumwell averaged 22.0 points, 9.5 rebounds and added two assists, two blocks and two steals as Montana State won a pair of league games against Portland State and Eastern Washington. Against EWU, she notched a career-high 26 points, while adding a game-high ten rebounds. In MSU's win over Portland State, she tallied 18 points and nine rebounds. For the weekend, Brumwell shot 55 percent from the field, 60 percent from 3-point range and 88 percent from the line.

Madi Buck, North Dakota - Buck recorded back-to-back double-double performances and flirted with a triple-double to lead North Dakota to a pair of road wins. The senior helped UND earn its 10th win in its last 12 games and remain perfect in Big Sky Conference play (5-0)...In a gritty 48-47 win Thursday at Idaho State, Buck scored 11 points but contributed in a host of different areas, recording 12 rebounds, a career-best seven steals and three blocked shots in the win...On Saturday, she poured in 22 points and had 11 rebounds to go along with four blocks and three steals in UND's 83-72 win at Weber State...For the week, Buck averaged 15.5 points, 11.5 rebounds, 3.5 blocks and five steals. She sits at 954 career points heading into next week's action.

Molly Duehn, Northern Colorado - Duehn, who entered the week averaging 4.7 points and 3.4 rebounds, scored a career-best 18 points at Weber State, sinking a season-best three-pointers and shooting 60% (6-of-10) from the floor. She followed up that stellar performance with 12 points and four rebounds in the team's win at Idaho State. Against the Bengals, Duehn scored five points in the Bears run to open the game with a 16-4 lead. It is the first time in the senior's career she's scored in double figures in back-to-back games. She averaged 15.0 points and 3.0 rebounds for the week, all while shooting .550 from the floor, .400 from the three-point line and .800 from the free throw line.

Emily Easom, Portland State - Easom led the Vikings with 16.0 points per game over the Vikings last two games. She shot .556 (10-for-18) from the floor and .500 (6-for-12) from three-point range. Easom went 6-for-7 from the free-throw line. She added five rebounds, three assists and a pair of steals on the weekend...Easom opened the weekend with 11 points in the Vikings loss at Montana State. She went 3-for-6 in the game, all from three-point range. Easom then added a season-high 21 points going 7-for-12 with three more three-pointers at Montana...Easom is averaging 11.8 points per game for the Vikings during Big Sky Conference action and 10.2 ppg overall on the season. She leads the team with 23 three-pointers.

Fantasia Hilliard, Sacramento State - Hilliard averaged 13.5 points, 5.0 assists, and 4.0 rebounds for the week as Sacramento State defeated Northern Arizona and fell to Southern Utah. She tallied 14 points, four assists, three rebounds, and two steals against Northern Arizona while shooting 5-of-12 from the field and hitting a 3-pointer. On Saturday vs Southern Utah Hilliard led the team with 13 points, six assists, five rebounds, and one steal while shooting 3-of-6 from the field and 2-of-3 from 3-point range. She shot 44.4% from the field and 3-of-7 (42.9%) from 3-point range for the week. In Big Sky play she is leading the Hornets with 16.3 points and 6.8 assists per game while shooting 51.2%.

Carli Moreland, Southern Utah - Moreland scored 14 points on 6-8 shooting to lead Southern Utah to 97-79 road win at Sacramento State, which entered the game at the top of the Big Sky standings. The senior forward finished just shy of a double-double after grabbing nine rebounds as the Thunderbirds handed the Hornets their first conference loss of the season. She also recorded two steals and two blocks in the contest. Moreland leads SUU this season with averages of 11.6 ppg and 7.8 rpg.
