Player of the Week - January 20, 2014

Quinton Upshur, G, Northern Arizona



The Big Sky Conference has selected Northern Arizona's Quinton Upshur as the men's basketball Player of the Week for games played between January 13th and 18th.

Upshur, a 6-foot-5 junior guard from Norfolk, Va., averaged 16 points, 3.7 rebounds and one steal per game as the Lumberjacks won three games

last week to hike their conference record to 5-1. He shot .696 percent from the field, .444 percent from 3-point range, and .923 percent from the free-throw line.

He opened the week by scoring 10 points with three rebounds, one assist and a steal in 21 minutes of action in Northern Arizona's 70-36 win over Southern Utah on Monday, Jan. 13. Upshur made 4-of-6 from the field.

On Thursday in an 84-65 win over Eastern Washington, Upshur scored a career-high 26 points, hitting 7-of-1 shots from the floor, and 11-of-12 from the free-throw line. He also pulled down six rebounds with two steals and an assist in 30 minutes.

On Saturday in a 77-56 win over Portland State, he netted 12 points and two rebounds in 23 minutes. He made 5-of-7 from the floor, and was 2-of-4 from 3-point range. This is his first career Big Sky Player of the Week honor.

THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

Weber State begins a busy week on Monday night by welcoming Idaho State to the Dee Events Center. WSU plays three games at home this week, and enters the triple-header 4-1 in conference. ISU brings a 3-2 conference mark to Ogden. Weber State battles Montana State (4-2) on Thursday and two-time defending champion Montana on Saturday...The marquee matchup is Thursday night in Greeley as the 5-1 Northern Colorado Bears play host to the surprising 5-1 Northern Arizona Lumberjacks. Northern Colorado is 9-0 at home this season...ISU also has a busy week, taking on Montana on Thursday and Montana State on Saturday...North Dakota returns home to face Sacramento State on Thursday and Northern Arizona on Saturday...Southern Utah hits the road to face Eastern Washington on Thursday and Portland State on Saturday. Southern Utah is the only team yet to experience a win in conference play...All of this week's games are on www.watchbigsky.com

Around the Big Sky

JACKS ON THE ATTACK: Northern Arizona picked up a road win at Southern Utah last Monday night, and then followed with home wins over Eastern Washington to improve to 5-1 in conference. The Lumberjacks are tied for first place at 5-1 with Northern Colorado. Jack Murphy's Lumberjacks were picked seventh by the media and ninth by the coaches in the preseason polls. This is the first time since 2007-08 that NAU has started 5-1 in conference play. That year, NAU finished 13-3 in conference and lost in the championship game to Portland State. NAU is the only team in the league to have more than one conference road win. NAU heads to Northern Colorado riding a four-game winning streak, the program's first four-game winning streak since the 2010-11 season. In conference play, NAU is allowing a league-low 59.2 points per game, outscoring opponents by 15 points, allowing opponents to shoot just .384 percent, and shooting a league-best .524 from 3-point range.

UNRUH ON VERGE OF MILESTONES: Northern Colorado senior guard Tate Unruh enters the week on the verge of two major milestones. Unruh needs 24 points to reach 1,000 for his career, and two 3-pointers to reach 200 in his career. Unruh's 198 career 3-pointers rank 16th in league history. He is on the verge of becoming the third active player to score 1,000 points while playing in the Big Sky Conference. Unruh averages 12.6 points and 2.2 3-pointers per game. Unruh is on the verge of becoming the 16th player in league history to make 200-career 3-pointers. Portland State's Brian Towne ranks 15th on the list with 206 career 3-pointers.

SETTING UP CAMP: Weber State senior Davion Berry tied a school-record 18 free throws in the Wildcats' 65-59 win over Southern Utah. Berry attempted a school-record 23 free throws. Berry's 18 made free throws and 23 attempts were two shy of the single-game Big Sky records. Montana's Ron Moore made 20 free throws on Jan. 12, 1966 vs. Gonzaga. Boise State's Tanoka Beard made 20 on Jan. 29, 1992 vs. George Mason. Beard attempted 25 in that game. Berry made eight free throws in the final 30 seconds, and seven in the last 20. As a team, Weber State made 28-of-38 free throws in the second half. WSU made just four second-half field goals.

TREY STREAK ENDS: Sacramento State's streak of 561 games with at least one made 3-pointer came to an end on Thursday night, as the Hornets went 0-14 from long distance in a 68-64 overtime loss to Portland State. The streak dated back to Nov. 28, 1993. Sacramento State started a new streak by making 6-of-15 from beyond the arc in a 75-64 win over Eastern Washington on Thursday.

VIKS SNAP ROAD STREAK: Portland State snapped the nation's longest active road losing streak at 20 with a 68-64 overtime win over Sacramento State on Thursday. It was the Vikings' first road win since beating the Hornets on Feb. 23, 2012. Eastern Washington and Southern Utah are both 0-9 on the road this season. EWU has lost 10 straight road games. Southern Utah has lost 14 in a row on the road.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

RPI REPORT: Northern Colorado is the Big Sky's top team in this week's RPI report. The Bears moved up four spots from last week to 162. Weber State is 204, Eastern Washington in 229, and Northern Arizona is at 232, a jump of 17 spots from last week. The Big Sky is 27th among Division I conferences. Kansas is the No. 1 team followed by Villanova and Arizona. The Big 12 is the top conference, followed by the Big Ten and Pac-12.

NCAA STATS: EWU's Tyler Harvey ranks eighth in the nation in 3-point field goals per game at 3.53. Harvey is 26th in 3-point field-goal percentage and 25th in scoring...UND's Troy Huff is 20th in scoring and 20th in steals per game...NAU's Max Jacobsen is 16th in field-goal percentage...Northern Colorado is seventh in the nation in 3-point field-goal percentage at .496 percent...North Dakota is 14 in steals per game (9.1). Montana is 15th in turnovers per game (10.1).

BEARS 15th: Northern Colorado dropped one spot to 15th in this week's CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25. Montana State received one vote in the poll. Wichita State is No. 1, followed by Harvard and Gonzaga.

Tip-ins: Montana outrebounded North Dakota 29-24 last Thursday night, marking the first time the Grizzlies won the rebounding battle this season...Idaho State outrebounded Southern Utah 46-27 in a 60-45 win last Thursday...North Dakota won its first road game of the season, downing Montana State 72-69 on Saturday. UND had lost seven straight road games dating back to last season...Weber State's Kyle Tresnak scored his 1,000th career point in Weber State's 65-59 win over Southern Utah. Tresnak enters Monday's game with exactly 1,000 career points...With six wins, Idaho State has matched its win total from last season...Home teams are 24-6 in conference games...UND's Jamal Webb scored his 1,000th career point last week, giving the squad three players with at least 1,000 career points. Troy Huff and Aaron Anderson have also surpassed the mark...Weber State has won 21 straight regular-season conference home games, and 22 in a row overall against Big Sky teams at the Dee Events Center.
