MSU HOMMES & NAU FROST NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (January 20, 2014) - Montana State's Jasmine Hommes and Northern Arizona's Amanda Frost have been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Players of the Week for the games played the week of Jan. 13-19.

Hommes, a sophomore from Lynden, Wash., played a big role as Montana State went on the road and won two games over the weekend, including a 76-65 win over North Dakota, snapping UND's seven-game home streak and handing them their first Big Sky loss of the season.

For the weekend, Hommes averaged 18 points and eight rebounds per game, while shooting an impressive 59 percent from the field. She also added four assists, a steal, a blocked shot and hit four-of-four from the line. Against Northern Colorado, Hommes recorded 18 points, sixteen coming in the second half alone to help the Bobcats rally from a halftime deficit.

In MSU's upset of North Dakota, Hommes posted her first double-double with 18 points and ten rebounds. She recorded 14 second-half points against UND as the Bobcats overcame another three-point halftime disadvantage. In the second half of both games over the weekend, Hommes shot an outstanding 82 percent (14-17) from the floor.

Frost, a senior from Riverside, Calif., exploded this week, helping NAU to a 2-1 record with wins over Southern Utah and Portland State. Frost averaged 30.3 points, 3.7 rebounds, 5 assists and 1.7 steals per game in the three contests while shooting .483 from the field. She also connected on 50 percent of her three-pointers, knocking 10 triples for the week and shooting 88.5 percent from the free throw line.

Frost began the week pouring in a career-high 34 points as the Lumberjacks rallied back from an 18-point halftime deficit to defeat Southern Utah, 82-77, on Monday. Frost scored 25 of her 34 points during the second half comeback and shot 11-for-19 for the game and hitting 4-of-7 from 3-point range, setting a new career-high for field goals made.

After scoring 29 points in NAU's loss at Eastern Washington on Thursday, which included a 10-for-11 performance at the free-throw line, Frost finished the week with 28 points in the Lumberjacks' 88-67 victory at Portland State, their first in Portland since 2006. Frost shot 10-of-18 from the field while coming up one assist shy of her first career double-double. Her nine assists was a career-high and she added five rebounds. For the week, she played 118 of 120 possible minutes and hit at least three three-pointers in every game.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Laura Hughes, Eastern Washington - Hughes played a pivotal role in Eastern Washington's victories over Northern Arizona and Sacramento State last weekend, averaging 19.5 points and 8.5 rebounds while shooting 70.8 percent (17-24) from the field. She came off the bench in both games, scoring a total of 39 points in just 30 total minutes of action as the Eagles moved up to third place in the Big Sky standings. She scored 20 points on 9-of-12 shooting against NAU on Thursday, adding a game-high nine boards, five of which came on the offensive end. She did all of her damage against the Lumberjacks in just 14 minutes. She was equally effective versus Sacramento State on Saturday, tallying a team-high 19 points on 8-of-12 shooting, knocking down all three of her free throw attempts. She grabbed eight boards against the Hornets, including four offensive rebounds.

Kellie Cole, Montana - Cole averaged 12.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists as Montana dropped a pair of road games at North Dakota and Northern Colorado last week. Cole had 13 points in Thursday's 62-57 loss at North Dakota and 11 points, 5 rebounds and 5 assists in Saturday's 57-54 loss at Northern Colorado...Cole went 4 for 7 from 3-point range in the two games and is now 17 for 23 (.739) from the arc in Montana's last seven games.

Mia Loyd, North Dakota - Loyd collected her sixth double-double of the season and narrowly missed out on a seventh as UND split home games with Montana and Montana State this week. Loyd poured-in 20 points and added a dozen rebounds in the 64-59 win over Montana Thursday. She followed with 14 points and nine rebounds in the loss to the Bobcats Saturday...Loyd continues to lead the Big Sky Conference in rebounding at more than 10 per game. She is averaging a double-double with 14.5 points and 10.1 rebounds per contest... North Dakota remains a half-game in front of the pack in the Big Sky Conference at 6-1 in league play.

Stephanie Lee, Northern Colorado - For the third time this season, junior center Stephanie Lee scored over 10 points at the free throw line, making 16-of-18 attempts against the league's hottest team in Montana State. Lee totaled 24 points in the game and averaged 19.5 for the weekend after adding 15 in a win over Montana. The Casper, Wyoming native also averaged 4.5 rebounds, 2.0 steals, 2.0 blocked shots and 1.5 assists in the weekend split. She shot .407 from the field and .850 from the free throw line.

Emily Easom, Portland State - Easom posted 19.5 points per game as the Vikings split a pair of Big Sky Conference games last week. Easom shot .630 from the floor going 17-for-27 and .417 from three-point range going 5-for-12. She also added five rebounds and eight assists while averaging 33 minutes per game...Easom began the week with a career-high 26 points as the Vikings defeated Sacramento State, 83-80. Easom went 12-for-15 from the floor with a pair of three-pointers. Her 12 field goals set a new career best. She added four assists and two rebounds in the game. Easom then posted 13 points in the Vikings loss to Northern Arizona. She recorded three more three-pointers, three rebounds and four assists in the loss...Easom is averaging 11.4 points per contest this year while shooting .426 from the floor. During conference play her numbers increase to 14.0 points per game and a .500 shooting percentage.

Andrea Jones, Southern Utah - Jones averaged 11.0 ppg and 6.7 apg over the Thunderbirds three-game stretch last week. The senior guard handed out nine assists against Northern Arizona then followed up with eight more as SUU took down rival Weber State. Jones leads Southern Utah with a total of 70 assists on the season and is the T-Birds top 3-point shooter with a mark of 34.7 percent.
