Player of the Week - January 27, 2014

Davion Berry, G/F, Weber State



Weber State senior Davion Berry has been selected as the Big Sky Conference men's basketball Player of the Week for games played between Jan. 20-25.

Berry, a 6-foot-4 guard/forward from Oakland, Calif., averaged 24.3 points, five assists, 4.3 rebounds, and two steals per game, leading the Wildcats to three home victories. Berry shot .553 percent from the floor, .478 percent from 3-point range, and .833 percent from the

free-throw line.

Berry started the week with 23 points, six assists, five rebounds and a steal in a 65-59 win over Idaho State on Monday, Jan. 20. He made 4-of-8 from 3-point range, and was 7-of-8 from the free-throw line.

Berry scored 24 points with seven assists, three rebounds, two steals and a block in Weber State's 86-57 win over Montana State on Thursday, Jan. 23. Berry was 10-of-10 from the free-throw line, 6-of-8 from the floor, including a 3-of-5 effort from 3-point range.

Berry capped the week with 26 points, five rebounds, two assists, and three steals in the Wildcats' 68-63 win over Montana on Saturday, Jan. 25. Berry was 9-of-17 from the field, 4-of-10 from 3-point range, and 3-of-6 from the free-throw line.

Berry has scored at least 23 points in four straight games. This is Berry's first Player of the Week honor this season, and the third of his career.

THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

Week five of the conference schedule features the top two teams - Northern Colorado and Weber State- hitting the road. Northern Colorado, which sits at 7-1, takes on Portland State on Thursday night and is at Eastern Washington on Saturday...Weber State, also 7-1, is at Northern Arizona on Thursday and at Sacramento State on Saturday....EWU and PSU both play three games this week. The teams square off Monday night at 7 p.m. Pacific at the Stott Center in Portland. EWU is at home Thursday against North Dakota, before taking on Northern Colorado...PSU plays host to North Dakota on Saturday...Idaho State also makes the Sacramento State-Northern Arizona road trip, facing the Hornets on Thursday, and Northern Arizona on Saturday. Montana and Montana State both play at Southern Utah. The Grizzlies take on the Thunderbirds on Thursday, while the Bobcats are in Cedar City on Saturday.

Around the Big Sky

NC, WSU TWO UP: Nearing the midway point of the conference schedule, Northern Colorado and Weber State are tied for the league lead with 7-1 records. The two are two games up on North Dakota and Northern Arizona, both 5-3. Northern Colorado's 7-1 start marks the second time since joining the league in 2006 that the Bears have been 7-1 after eight games. Northern Colorado was 7-1 in 2010-11, the year the Bears won the regular-season and postseason titles. Northern Colorado is 11-0 at home this season, and has won 12 straight at home dating back to last season. The home win streak is tied for 17th longest active streak in the nation. Weber State was 8-0 each of the past two years in conference after eight games. Both Northern Colorado and Weber State have played six of their eight conference games at home, and will now play eight of their final 12 on the road. Through 43 conference games, home teams are 34-9. WSU, NC, NAU and EWU have yet to lose a home conference game. Weber State has won 24 regular-season home conference games in a row, and 25 straight over Big Sky teams at the Dee Events Center. EWU, ISU, and SUU have yet to win a conference road game. NAU is the only team in the league with multiple road conference wins.

RAHE TIES ADRAS: Weber State's Randy Rahe earned three conference victories last week, hiking his career total to 99 conference wins. Rahe is now tied for third place all-time in league history with former Northern Arizona coach Mike Adras. Rahe, in his eighth season, has an overall conference record of 99-25. His conference winning percentage of .798 also ranks third all-time behind WSU's Phil Johnson (.886) and Idaho's Kermit Davis (.813). Former Montana State coach Mick Durham holds the all-time record for conference wins with 123. Former Boise State coach Bobby Dye is second with 102. Rahe now has 160 total wins at Weber State, which has moved him into fifth place in league history for overall wins. Last week, Rahe past former Idaho and Weber State coach Joe Cravens (159). Adras is fourth on the list with 187.

HARVEY SETS FREE-THROW MARK: Eastern Washington sophomore Tyler Harvey became the first player in Big Sky history to go 20-of-20 from the free-throw line in the Eagles' 90-83 win over Southern Utah last Thursday. The previous best 100-percent free-throw game was a 17-of-17 effort by Portland State's Deonte Huff on Feb. 2, 2008 against Montana State. Harvey became the third player in league history to make 20 free throws in a game. Montana's Ron Moore made 20 on Jan. 12, 1966 against Gonzaga. Boise State's Tanoka Beard made 20 on Jan. 19, 1992 against George Mason. Harvey scored a career-high 36 points in the win. Harvey is the only player in the league to have reached double figures in all of his team's games this season. He's scored at least 10 points in 22 straight games dating back to last season.

UNRUH HITS 200th 3-POINTER: Northern Colorado senior Tate Unruh became the 16th player in league history to make 200 career 3-pointers. Unruh hit five in the Bears' win over Northern Arizona last Thursday to up his career total to 203. Since Northern Colorado joined the Big Sky in 2006, Devon Beitzel (235) is the only other Bear to make 200 3-pointers. Unruh just missed on another milestone last week, scoring 22 points to bring his career total to 998. He'll likely score his 1,000th career point on Thursday against Portland State.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

RPI REPORT: Northern Colorado jumped 19 spots in the RPI this past week, checking in at 143. Weber State improved 21 spots to 183. Montana improved 22 spots to 224. The Big Sky remained 27th among Division I conferences. Kansas is the top overall team, followed by Arizona and Wisconsin. The Big 12 is the top RPI conference, followed by the Big Ten and the Pac-12.

NCAA LEADERS: Weber State's Joel Bolomboy has moved up to eighth in the nation in rebounds per game with an average of 10.7. The sophomore had rebounding games of 16, 12, and 19 last week. He's had at least 10 rebounds in eight of his last nine games...EWU's Tyler Harvey ranks ninth in the nation in 3-point field goals per game (3.44) and is 17th in points per game (21.2), and 17th in free-throw percentage (.888)...NAU's Max Jacobsen is 16th in field-goal percentage (.599)...Northern Colorado ranks eighth in the nation in field-goal percentage (.499). The Bears are 15th in 3-point FG percentage (.402)...UND is 11th in turnover margin (4.4) and 14th in steals per game (8.9).

BEARS 13TH: Following victories over Northern Arizona and Sacramento State, Northern Colorado jumped two spots in the CollegelInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25. Northern Colorado is ranked 13th, and is the only Big Sky team ranked or receiving votes. Wichita State is No. 1, followed by Gonzaga and Toledo.

Tip-ins: North Dakota senior Troy Huff moved into fifth place on UND's all-time scoring list, passing the legendary Phil Jackson. Huff, who has scored 838 points while playing in the Big Sky, has 1,712 career points. Huff had 20 points and a career-high 14 rebounds in a win over Sac State... Sacramento State's Dylan Garrity is tied for 21st on the Big Sky's all-time assist list with 390. He needs two to tie former Boise State and NBA star Chris Childs for 20th...Weber State senior Kyle Tresnak has become the 25th player in league history to record 100 career blocks...Portland State has won three of its last four...Southern Utah's 16-game losing streak is the longest active streak in the nation... NC's Derrick Barden recorded his fifth double-double of the season with 14 points and 13 rebounds in a win over Sac State.
