Player of the Week - January 6, 2014

Andre Hatchett, G, Idaho State



Idaho State's Andre Hatchett has been selected as the Big Sky Conference men's basketball Player of the Week after leading the Bengals to a pair of conference victories.

Hatchett, a 6-foot-4, senior guard from Tucson, Ariz., averaged 25.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, and three assists per game as the Bengals notched home victories over Portland State and Eastern Washington to start conference play 2-0 for the

first time since the 2007-08 season. Hatchett shot .667 percent from the floor, and .731 percent from the free-throw line in the two games.

Hatchett scored a career-high 24 points with seven rebounds, four assists, a block and a steal in the Bengals' 87-76 win over Portland State on Thursday night. He made 7-of-11 shots from the floor, and was 10-of-14 from the free-throw line.

He set a new career-high in points with 27 on Saturday night in an 83-72 victory over Eastern Washington. Hatchett was 9-of-13 from the floor, and 9-of-12 from the free-throw line. He also had four rebounds and two assists.

This is Hatchett's first career Player of the Week Honor.

THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

Three of the four teams that started the conference season with two victories face the challenges of road life this week...Weber State (2-0) faces stiff road tests at Northern Colorado and at North Dakota. Northern Colorado is also 2-0 in league, and at 8-3 has the league's top record. The Weber State-Northern Colorado game on Thursday will be televised live on Altitude. WSU is at North Dakota on Saturday...Idaho State (2-0) also makes the UND-NC road trip, facing North Dakota on Thursday and Northern Colorado on Saturday...Montana State (2-0) travels to Portland State on Thursday and Eastern Washington on Saturday in a game that will be televised live on SWX...Northern Arizona (1-1) returns home for the first time since Dec. 14 to face Sacramento State on Thursday. The Lumberjacks are at Southern Utah on Monday...Montana (1-1) is at Eastern Washington on Thursday at Portland State on Saturday...Sacramento State (0-2) guns for its first conference win at Southern Utah (0-2) on Saturday.

Around the Big Sky

NAU ENDS MONTANA'S STREAK: Northern Arizona halted Montana's record streak of Big Sky Conference home victories last Thursday night, beating the Grizzlies 73-65 at Dahlberg Arena. Montana had won 26 straight regular-season conference games, a conference record. UM had not lost a conference home game since falling 73-67 to Montana State on Feb. 27, 2010. Montana had won 31 in a row over Big Sky teams at home including postseason games. The 31-game winning streak started with a 81-60 win over Northern Arizona in a first-round game of the 2010 Big Sky Championship on March 6, 2010. During the streak, Montana won two Big Sky Championships at Dalhberg Arena (2010). The win on Thursday was Northern Arizona's first in Missoula since beating UM 80-76 during the 2007-08 season. Northern Arizona was nearly flawless in the second half of the win over Montana, hitting 17-of-22 shots from the field (.733) percent. NAU was 4-of-4 from 3-point range and 6-of-8 from the free-throw line in the final 20 minutes. The dagger came from Quinton Upshur, who drained a 3-point-er with 1:02 to play after UM had cut an 11-point deficit to 66-65. Montana went 15-1 in conference play in 2011-12, and 19-1 last season. The Grizzlies rebounded with an 82-70 home win over Sacramento State on Saturday.

WEBER EXTENDS STREAK: Weber State opened conference play with home wins over Eastern Washington and Portland State last week. The Wildcats have now won 20 straight regular-season conference games at the Dee Events Center dating back to a 79-59 loss to Eastern Washington on March 2, 2011. Including the postseason, WSU has won 21 straight over Big Sky teams at the Dee Events Center. Under Randy Rahe, Weber State is 56-4 at home in regular-season conference games.

SOLID STARTS: Like Weber State, Idaho State, Montana State and Northern Colorado are all 2-0 after the first full week of conference play. Idaho State is off to a 2-0 conference start for the first time since the 2007-08 season. The Bengals went 5-15 in conference last season. Montana State and Northern Colorado are both off to 2-0 league starts for the first time since 2010-11. In 2010-11, Northern Colorado went on to win the Big Sky Championship. ISU and MSU both hit the road for conference play this week. ISU was 1-9 in conference road games last season, while MSU was 3-7. Northern Colorado has home conference games against Weber State and Idaho State this week. The Bears are 7-0 at the Butler-Hancock Sports Pavilion this season, the only Big Sky team without a home loss. Northern Colorado has won eight straight and 10 of its last 11 at home dating back to last season.

RAHE SIXTH: Weber State's Randy Rahe now ranks sixth on the Big Sky's all-time win list with 155. Rahe surpassed former Montana coach Mike Montgomery (154) with the Wildcats' win over Portland State on Saturday. He is four behind former WSU and Idaho coach Joe Cravens. Rahe is tied with former WSU coach Neil McCarthy for fourth in all-time conference wins with 94. Former Northern Arizona coach Mike Adras is third with 99 conference wins. Former Boise State coach Bobby Dyke is second with 102.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

RPI REPORT: The Big Sky saw a substantial decline in RPIs with the start of conference play. The Big Sky dropped four spots in the conference rankings to 28th. Despite a win, Northern Colorado dropped 32 spots to 198. Montana fell 94 spots to 207. EWU dropped 80 spots to 227. NAU, WSU and ISU were the only schools to improve this week. NAU improved eight spots, WSU nine, and ISU six.

NCAA LEADERS: EWU's Tyler Harvey ranks sixth in the nation in 3-point field goals made per game at 3.69. North Dakota's Troy Huff is ninth in scoring (22.1 points per game) and 12th in steals (2.67 per game)...North Dakota ranks ninth in turnover margin at 5.3. UND is 12th in steals per game (9.3). Montana is 12th in fewest turnovers per game (9.7).
