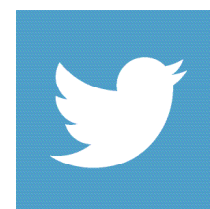

ROOT SPORTS Players of the Week Oct. 13

OFFENSE - Dakota Prukop, QB, Montana State



Prukop, a 6-foot-2, 195-pound sophomore from Austin, Texas, compiled 509 yards of total offense and accounted for six touchdowns in Montana State's 77-37 win over UC Davis. Prukop completed 17-of-22 passes for 361 yards with four touchdowns and no interceptions. He had an efficiency rating of 275.1. He also carried the ball 14 times for 148 yards with a pair of touchdowns. Montana State finished with a school-record 737 yards of total offense and the 77 points were the most scored by the Bobcats against a Division I opponent. Prukop has now thrown for more than 300 yards and rushed for more than 100 in two straight games.

DEFENSE - Dayo Idowu, LB, North Dakota



Idowu, a 6-2, 210-pound junior from Woodbury, Minn., tied his career-high with eight tackles and intercepted a pass in North Dakota's 24-16 win over Portland State. Idowu's biggest tackle of the game came when he stopped Portland State's Nate Tago on the 2-yard line with the Vikings facing a fourth-and-goal from the 4-yard line on the game's final play. His third-quarter interception which he returned 11 yards set up a touchdown that gave his team a 17-13 lead. This is Idowu's first career Player of the Week honor.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Alex Tillman, Ret., North Dakota



Tillman, a 5-10, 190-pound senior from Houston, Texas, set a school record with a 95-yard punt return for a touchdown in North Dakota's 24-16 win over Portland State. Tillman's fourth quarter return gave his team a 24-16 lead. The 95-yard punt return was 1-yard shy of the Big Sky record. Tillman finished with 106 punt return yards. He also had six tackles and a pass breakup from his cornerback position. Earlier this season, Tillman was named the Defensive Player of the Week.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

SCHOOL RECORDS FOR OFFENSE: Idaho State and Montana State both set school records for total offense in victories last Saturday. Idaho State rolled up 770 yards of offense in a 66-14 win over Division II Simon Fraser. The 770 yards are the most by an FCS team this season. The 66 points were the most scored by a Bengal team since beating Colorado College 77-8 in 1960. Quarterback Justin Arias completed 30-of-31 passes for 404 yards with five touchdowns. His five TD passes tied the Holt Arena record with six other quarterbacks. Idaho State finished with 315 rushing yards and 455 passing yards. Montana State amassed a school record 737 yards of total offense in a 77-37 conference win over UC Davis. The 77 points marked the most points ever scored by the Bobcats against a Division I opponent and the second-most in school history. It also marked the first time the Bobcats ever surpassed 700 yards of total offense in a game. The 737 yards of offense are the second-most by an FCS team this season, trailing only the 770 put up by Idaho State on Saturday. MSU scored touchdowns on 10 of its 12 drives. The Bobcats punted once and gave away the ball on downs late in the contest. MSU also scored a defensive touchdown. The Bobcats threw for 406 yards and rushed for 331. The 114 combined points were the most ever in a Bobcat game. UC Davis gained 610 yards of total offense in the loss. The teams combined for 1,347 yards of offense and 114 points, marking the third time this year a conference game has featured more than 100 combined points. The Big Sky and FCS record for total offense by one team in a game is 876 by Weber State in 1985 against Idaho State.

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN: Montana State sophomore Dakota Prukop may not want to leave California. In back-to-back road games against Sacramento State and UC Davis, Prukop amassed 997 yards of total offense and accounted for 14 touchdowns. In both games, he threw for more than 300 yards and rushed for more than 100 yards. From 2001-2013, that feat had only been accomplished three times by Big Sky quarterbacks. Sacramento State's Garrett Safron did it last week against Montana State, and Prukop has done it in back-to-back games. Against UC Davis last Saturday, Prukop completed 17-of-22 passes for 361 yards with four touchdowns and no interceptions. He rushed 14 times for 148 yards with two touchdowns. He averaged 21.2 yards per completion and 10.6 yards per rush. He finished the game with a pass efficiency rating of 275.1. Montana State returns to California on November 1 to play Cal Poly.

ALL-PURPOSE PLAYER: Cal Poly quarterback Chris Brown became the first player in the Mustangs' Division I history to rush for a touchdown, throw for a touchdown and catch a touchdown in a game. Brown accomplished the trifecta in Cal Poly's 30-24 win over Weber State. Brown scored on a 1-yard run in the second quarter, threw an 11-yard TD pass to Kori Garcia in the second quarter, and caught a 23-yard touchdown pass from Garcia in the third quarter. Brown rushed 27 times for 90 yards, completed 8-of-15 passes for 198 yards, and caught one pass. Brown has eight rushing touchdowns this season, tied for the second-most in the league. He ranks third in rushing yards per game at 100.5. His reception on Saturday was the first of his career.

FIRST START, NO JITTERS: Southern Utah sophomore Jordan West and UC Davis sophomore Ben Scott started for the first time in their careers on Saturday. West, subbing for injured All-American Vernon Adams, Jr., guided the No. 2 Eagles to a 42-30 road win over Southern Utah. West completed 20-of-27 passes for 288 yards with three touchdowns and one interception. Scott, who replaced former starter London Lacy, completed 27-of-46 passes for 379 yards with four touchdowns and one interception in a 77-37 loss to Montana State. Scott guided UC Davis' offense to 610 total yards.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

FINDING WAYS TO SCORE: North Dakota has scored either a defensive or special teams touchdown in four consecutive games. Alex Tillman kept the streak alive when he returned a punt 95 yards for a touchdown in the fourth quarter of UND's 24-16 win over Portland State. Tillman returned an interception 92 yards for a touchdown in a 13-3 win over Stony Brook. Will Ratelle recovered a fumble and returned it 21 yards for a touchdown in a loss to Montana State. Chris Brown returned an interception 14 yards for a touchdown against Montana. With three wins, North Dakota has matched its win total from the entire 2013 season.

KRAMER ALONE IN THIRD: Idaho State coach Mike Kramer notched his 86th career win while coaching in the Big Sky last week to move into sole possession of third place on the Big Sky's all-time victories list. He entered Saturday's game against Simon Fraser tied with former Montana coach Don Read with 85 wins. Nevada's Chris Ault won 111 games while coaching in the Big Sky. Current Northern Arizona coach Jerome Souers is second with 96 victories. Kramer compiled a 37-32 record from 1994-1999 as the head coach at Eastern Washington. Kramer went 40-43 from 2000-06 as the head coach at Montana State. Kramer has a record of 9-31 in his fourth season at Idaho State. Kramer guided Eastern Washington and Montana State to Big Sky championships. Idaho State is 3-3 this season. The Bengals have not won more than three games in a season since finishing 5-6 in 2005. ISU has not had a winning season since 2003.

TWO ON RICE WATCH LIST: Weber State linebacker Emmett Tela and Idaho State linebacker Mario Jenkins were named to the initial Jerry Rice Award Watch List last week. The Jerry Rice Award is presented to the nation's top freshman by The Sports Network. Eastern Washington wide receiver Cooper Kupp won the Rice last season. Tela, a true freshman from Provo, Utah, ranks fourth in the Big Sky with an average of 11.3 tackles per game. He tallied 15 in last week's loss to Cal Poly. Jenkins, a redshirt freshman, from Nampa, Idaho, ranks eighth in the league with an average of 9.5 tackles per game. Jenkins tallied seven tackles, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery last Saturday.

LUMBERJACKS, VIKINGS ON ROOT SPORTS: Northern Arizona and Portland State will play live on ROOT SPORTS this Saturday. Coverage begins at 4 p.m. Pacific. Tom Glasgow, Jason Stiles and Brad Adam will call the game. The game will feature ROOT SPORTS' new segment called #WHEREIROOT. Fans can send pictures using Facebook, Twitter or Instagram showing ROOT SPORTS where they are watching/rooting from using the hashtag WHEREIROOT. Some pictures will be showcased on the broadcast. Portland State is 1-0 on ROOT SPORTS this season. Northern Arizona is making its debut on ROOT SPORTS for 2014. Northern Arizona is 2-0 the past two seasons on ROOT SPORTS.

THREE SKY TEAMS IN THE TOP 10: Montana State cracked the top 10 in the Sports Network Top 25 this week, giving the Big Sky three teams in the top 10. Eastern Washington is ranked second behind North Dakota State. Montana remained seventh, and Montana State jumped from 11th to ninth. The Big Sky is the only conference with three teams ranked in the top 10. The Missouri Valley and CAA each have two ranked in the top 10. It's the first time since last November that three Big Sky teams have been ranked in the top 10. In the FCS Coaches' Poll, Eastern Washington is second, Montana is sixth, and Montana State is 11th. Northern Arizona and Cal Poly received votes in The Sports Network Poll. Cal Poly received votes in the Coaches' poll.

Extra points: Road teams went 4-1 last week in conference games. Home teams are now 10-7 in conference games...Weber State's Blake O'Neill booted a 74-yard punt against Cal Poly. It was the longest punt in the Big Sky this season...Northern Colorado QB Sean Rubalcaba returned to the lineup after missing two games with an injury. He completed 25-of-35 passes for 301 yards with three touchdowns and no interceptions in a loss to Sacramento State...Sacramento State QB Garrett Safron has 1,709 career rushing yards. The Big Sky career record by a QB is 1,964 by Portland State's Conner Kavanaugh...Idaho State's sophomore Jakori Ford rushed three times for 144 yards and two touchdowns against Simon Fraser, an average of 48 yards per carry...Ellis Onic had a 100-yard kick return for a touchdown for Northern Colorado against Sacramento State...Weber State's Bo Bolen had a 94-yard kick return for a touchdown against Cal Poly.
