# 2014-15 PREVIEW

The 2014-15 Big Sky Conference men's basketball season will feature changes to the championship structure, as well as the addition of a new team.

The University of Idaho returns to the Big Sky Conference, the league where the Vandals called home from 1963-1996.

Idaho, which lost in the WAC Championship game in 2014, won Big Sky Conference postseason Championships in 1981, 1982, 1989 and 1990.

The Vandals are led by coach Don Verlin, who enters his seventh season in Moscow.

The addition of Idaho brings the Big Sky to 12 men's basketball members. League squads will play 18 conference games. League teams will play seven conference members twice, and the other four members once. Teams will play nine league home games and nine conference road games.

The top eight teams will advance to the 2015 Big Sky Conference Championship, which will be hosted by the regular-season champion.

The No. 1 seed will no longer receive a bye to the semifinals. The first day of the conference tournament will feature four quarterfinal games with the No. 1 seed playing the No. 8 seed, the No. 2 seed taking on the No. 7 seed, the No. 3 seed playing the No. 6 seed, and the No. 4 seed playing the No. 5 seed. There will be no reseeding following the first round.

Both Montana school are under the direction of new coaches.

Former Montana point guard Travis DeCuire has taken over the Grizzly program. DeCuire previously served as an assistant coach at Cal. He replaced Wayne Tinkle, who is now the head coach at Oregon State.

Brian Fish, a former assistant at Oregon, is now in charge at Montana State. Fish replaced Brad Huse,

who resigned after eight seasons.

Weber State is the defending league champion. Under the direction of Randy Rahe, the Wildcats have won 106 conference games the past eight seasons, and played for the league championship five times.

Weber State lost conference MVP Davion Berry, but returns Freshman of the Year Jeremy Senglin and Defensive Player of the Year Joel Bolomboy.

Sacramento State, which advanced to the conference tournament for the first time since 2006 last season, returns all five starters.

Eastern Washington returns four starters, including junior guard Tyler Harvey, who finished eighth in the nation in scoring as a sophomore and was named First Team All-Conference.

Jack Murphy begins his third season at Northern Arizona, and the Lumberjacks figure to contend for the title. Quinton Upshur, a senior guard returns after earning First Team All-Conference honors and the Top Newcomer honor last season.

North Dakota played for the league championship last season, but must replace a trio of outstanding guards - Troy Huff, Aaron Anderson and Jamal Webb. Forward Jaron Nash is the top returning player for the Green & White.

Northern Colorado and Portland State both advanced to the semifinals in 2014. Both squads return two starters.

Idaho State enters its third season under Bill Evans. Sharp-shooting Chris Hansen returns to lead the Bengals.

Southern Utah returns all five starters as Nick Robinson hopes to lead the Thunderbirds up the standings.

**MAKE IT NINE:** Regular-season champion Weber State won its ninth Big Sky Conference Championship last Saturday, beating North Dakota 88-67 in the championship game at the Dee Events Center in Ogden. Weber State won its first postseason title since 2007. Weber State's nine conference championships ties Montana for the most in league history. Weber State also played in its 16th championship game, tying Montana for the most. Weber State edged Northern Colorado 66-63 in overtime to earn the right to face North Dakota in the championship game. UND, which joined the Big Sky on July 1, 2012, was playing in the championship game for the first time. Weber State became the fourth straight No. 1 seed to win the tournament, joining Northern Colorado (2011), Montana (2012) and Montana (2013).

**ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM:** Weber State senior Davion Berry was named the Big Sky Tournament MVP after leading the Wildcats to the championship. Berry averaged 17 points and 4.5 assists per game. He scored 15 in the semi-final win over Northern Colorado, including seven in overtime. He netted 19 in the championship, including a 3-pointer right before halftime to give the Wildcats a 10-point lead. He was joined on the all-tournament team by Weber State senior center Kyle Tresnak, Weber State senior guard Jordan Richardson, North Dakota senior guard Aaron Anderson, North Dakota senior guard/forward Troy Huff, and Northern Colorado senior forward Derrick Barden. Berry and Huff were both named to the All-Tournament team in 2013.

**TRESNAK, RICHARDSON TIE RECORD:** Weber State's Jordan Richardson and Kyle Tresnak tied the all-time conference record for tournament games played at nine. Montana's Will Cherry was the first player to play in nine Big Sky tournament games from 2010-13. Tresnak and Richardson each played in three consecutive championship games.

**JAMAR CAPS CAREER** Montana senior Kareem Jamar capped his sensational career in Montana's loss to Portland State in the first round with 20 points, eight rebounds and four assists. Jamar led UM to back-to-back Big Sky titles in 2012 and 2013. He was the league MVP in 2012-13, won two tournament MVP awards, and was named First Team All-Conference three straight seasons. Jamar finished his career with 1,673 points, which ranks 13th in league history. He tallied 407 assists, which ranks 20th in league history. His 162 career 3-pointers rank 35th in league history.

**UNRUH 10th IN THREES:** Northern Colorado senior Tate Unruh moved into sole possession of 10th place on the Big Sky's all-time 3-pointers made list with 238. Unruh made three 3-pointers in a first-round win over Northern Arizona. Unruh will play at least one more game in the CIT. Sacramento State's Loren Leath (2005-09) is ninth on the list with 240. Weber State's John Hamilton (2000-04) is eighth with 241.

**SIX NAMED TO NABC ALL-DISTRICT TEAM:** Weber State's Davion Berry, North Dakota's Tory Huff, and Kareem Jamar were named to the District 6 First Team. Players from the Big Sky and WAC were eligible. Sacramento State's Mikh McKinney, Northern Colorado's Derrick Barden, and Eastern Washington's Tyler Harvey were named to the Second Team.

**PROTECTING HOME COURT:** Home teams ended up winning 76 of the 110 conference games this season, a winning percentage of .691. Last year, home teams won .646 percent of the conference games. In 2011-12, home teams won just .492 percent of the conference games.

# 2013-14 SEASON IN REVIEW

## WSU's Rahe Named Coach of the Year

Weber State's Randy Rahe was selected by his peers as the 2013-14 Big Sky Conference men's basketball Coach of the Year.

Rahe became the first coach in Big Sky history to claim the honor four times. Rahe previously won the honor following the 2006-07, 2008-09, and 2009-10 seasons.

"This award is an honor and it's very humbling," Rahe said. "I really believe the coaches in the league can coach against anyone. I have tremendous respect for every coach in this league and the jobs they do."

Rahe guided Weber State to the Big Sky Conference regular-season title with a 14-6 record. The Wildcats took the No. 1 seed into the Big Sky Conference Championship, and beat Northern Colorado in overtime in a semifinal and topped North Dakota 88-67 in the championship game. It was Weber State's ninth Big Sky Championship, tied for most in league history.

Weber State finished 19-12 after losing to No. 1 seed Arizona in the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

The Wildcats opened the 2013-14 season as the preseason favorite, but battled some early-season struggles as it adjusted to a bevy of young talent. True freshmen Jeremy Sengelin and Richaud Gittens, redshirt freshman Kyndahl Hill, and true sophomore Joel Bolomboy all were major cogs in the Wildcats' success.

Weber State started conference play with a 3-5 overall record, including just one Division I victory and no road wins. The Wildcats won eight of their first nine, and 11 of their first 13 conference games to surge to the top of the standings.

"I feel like our team did improve as much as any team I've had," Rahe said. "We were pretty darn

young."

Weber State senior Davion Berry was named regular-season MVP. Senglin was named the Freshman of the Year. Bolomboy was tabbed as the Defensive Player of the Year. Berry was named First Team All-Conference, while senior center Kyle Tresnak was selected to the Second Team.

Weber State leads the Big Sky Conference in scoring defense, scoring margin, field-goal percentage defense, 3-point field-goal percentage, 3-point field-goal percentage defense, rebounding margin, and ranks second in free-throw percentage, field-goal percentage, and blocked shots.

During the season, Rahe moved into second place on the Big Sky's all-time list for conference victories with 106. Rahe also ranks fifth on the all-time victories list with 169. Rahe is one of just three coaches in league history with 100 conference wins. Weber State has won at least 10 conference games in all eight of Rahe's seasons.

Rahe has guided Weber State to four regular-season conference titles, and two postseason titles. The Wildcats have advanced to at least the conference semifinals in all eight of his seasons. His teams

have played in national postseason tournaments seven times, with two NCAA appearances, two NIT appearances, two CIT bids, and one CBI invitation. The Wildcats finished second in the 2012-13 CIT.

"From my standpoint this is a team award," Rahe said. "I have a great coaching staff that does a tremendous job for me, and I have really good players who buy into the system. They make me look a lot better than what I am."

Rahe was assisted by associate head coach Eric Duft, Phil Beckner and Kellen McCoy. Garrett Lever is the director of basketball operations.
