The final football Saturday in October also features the lightest schedule of the regular season. Just five conference games are on the docket as three teams take the week off...No. 2 Eastern Washington travels to Northern Arizona in a game that will be televised live on ROOT SPORTS. It is the first meeting between the Eagles and Lumberjacks since 2011. Coverage on ROOT SPORTS and DIRECTV's Audience Network begins at 12:30 p.m. Pacific...No. 7 Montana travels to Cal Poly to face the Mustangs, who have won three straight. UM is 15-2 all-time against Cal Poly...Idaho State will try to pick up its first road win since 2006 when it travels to Northern Colorado. The Bears are 2-1 at home this season...North Dakota returns to action following a bye week, traveling to Southern Utah...Portland State is at Weber State as the Wildcats seek their first win...UC Davis, Sacramento State and Montana State all have the week off.

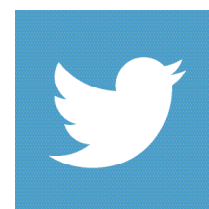

ROOT SPORTS Players of the Week Oct. 20

OFFENSE - Justin Arias, QB, Idaho State



Arias, a 6-foot, 213-pound senior from Agoura Hills, Calif., completed 30-of-50 passes for a career-high 465 yards with four touchdowns and no interceptions in the Bengals' 56-28 victory over Southern Utah. Arias threw scoring strikes of 7, 17, 29 and 43 yards as the Bengals earned their second conference win and fourth overall victory. It marked the first time since 2007 that ISU has won more than one conference game in a season, and the first time since 2005 the Bengals have won four games in a season. Arias leads the nation in touchdown passes with 25. He's thrown for at least 400 yards in four consecutive games, and thrown for at least 300 in six straight games. This is Arias' second Player of the Week honor this season.

DEFENSE - Mario Jenkins, LB, Idaho State



Jenkins, a 6-1, 225-pound freshman from Nampa, Idaho, registered 14 tackles - four for loss - with two interceptions, 1.5 sacks, and one QB hurry in Idaho State's 56-28 win over Southern Utah. Ten of Jenkins' 14 tackles resulted in gains of fewer than four yards. His first interception set up an Idaho State touchdown. Jenkins, a candidate for the Jerry Rice Award, ranks sixth in the league with an average of 10.1 tackles per game. Jenkins is the first Idaho State defensive player to win Player of the Week honors since 2009.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Zackary Johnson, DE, EWU



Johnson, a 6-4, 250-pound senior from Stanwood, Wash., blocked a punt in the third quarter of Eastern Washington's 26-18 victory over Northern Colorado. The block was recovered by Samson Ebukam at the Northern Colorado 25-yard line. Six plays later, Eastern Washington scored a touchdown to take a 20-3 lead. It marked the third straight game EWU has blocked a punt. The Eagles are now tied for the FCS lead in blocked punts. Johnson also had four tackles and a sack from his defensive end position. This is his first career Player of the Week honor.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

BENGALS HAVE BITE: Idaho State picked up its second league victory of the season and its fourth overall win with a 56-28 home win over Southern Utah on Saturday. Idaho State has now won multiple conference games in a season for the first time since 2007. From 2008-2013, Idaho State compiled a 4-44 record in Big Sky Conference games. Idaho State is now 4-3, marking the most wins for the program since winning five in 2005. Head coach Mike Kramer, who is in his fourth season of the program, was rewarded with a three-year contract extension last week. Idaho State is 4-0 at Holt Arena this season. The Bengals' three losses this season have come to FBS teams Utah and Utah State, and a two-point loss to No. 2 Eastern Washington. Idaho State leads the Big Sky and ranks second in the nation in total offense with an average of 569.7 yards per game. The Bengals lead the nation in passing average per game at 367.3 yards per game. Through three conference games, the Bengals are averaging 51 points per game. ISU senior QB Justin Arias leads the nation in passing yards with 2,485 and passing touchdowns (25), is third in total offense (356.9 yards per game). Arias is third - behind MSU's Dakota Prukop and EWU's Vernon Adams Jr. - in points responsible for with 154. Senior running back Xavier Finney leads the Big Sky with 911 rushing yards and 11 rushing touchdowns. Idaho State has allowed just nine sacks in six games. Idaho State has attempted 318 passes. In 2011, Idaho State allowed 66 sacks in 11 games. Idaho State's defense has also shown improvement. Two years ago, the Bengals set a Big Sky record by allowing 592 points in 11 games, an average of 53.8 per game. In eight conference games in 2012, ISU allowed 465 points, an average of 58.1 per game. ISU is currently allowing 36 points in all games and conference games. Idaho State has one major monkey on its back - a 48-game road losing streak that dates back to a 2006 win at Northern Colorado. ISU has lost a Big Sky record 28 league road games dating back to the 2006 win over Northern Colorado. The Bengals are at Northern Colorado on Saturday. The Bears are 2-1 at home this season, including an upset of Northern Arizona.

BEAT GOES ON FOR EAGLES: Despite missing several major weapons on offense such as quarterback Vernon Adams Jr., running back Quincy Forte and wide receiver Cory Mitchell, Eastern Washington earned its 14th straight conference win and 16th straight win over a Big Sky team with a 26-18 home win over Northern Colorado last Saturday. The Big Sky record for consecutive conference wins is 25 by Montana from 1999-2002. EWU improved to 28-4 on the red turf at Roos Field, which was installed in 2010. The Eagles have won 14 straight regular season home games. Since losing at Southern Utah on Oct 27, 2012, the Eagles have beaten 10 of the other 12 league teams at least once. The Eagles have not played Sacramento State or Northern Arizona during the span. Eastern Washington travels to Northern Arizona on Saturday. Since the start of the 2010 season, EWU is 31-5 in conference with three of the losses coming during the 2011 season. Montana State is 30-6 in conference games since the start of the 2010 season

LITTLE MAN, BIG GAME: Portland State redshirt freshman running back Steven Long rushed 16 times for 253 yards for an average of 15.8 yards per carry and one touchdown in the Vikings' 21-17 loss to Northern Arizona. The 5-foot-7, 180-pounder entered the game with 118 rushing yards. Long had a TD run of 62 yards, and non-scoring runs of 66 and 61 yards. Long's 253 yards were the ninth-most in PSU single-game history, the most by a Big Sky back this season, and the most by a freshman in the FCS this season. Long also had three catches for 44 yards to finish with 297 all-purpose yards.

NAU, EWU ON ROOT: Saturday's Northern Arizona-Eastern Washington game from the Walkup Skydome in Flagstaff will air live on ROOT SPORTS and DIRECTV's Audience Network. Coverage begins at 12:30 p.m. Pacific. Tom Glasgow, Jason Stiles and Brad Adam will call the game. Northern Arizona is 2-0 at the Skydome this season and have won seven straight regular season home games. Northern Arizona moved to 3-0 all-time on ROOT SPORTS with its 21-17 win over Portland State last week. Eastern Washington is 1-0 on ROOT SPORTS this season and 7-0 since Big Sky games starting airing on ROOT SPORTS in 2012. Fans are reminded about ROOT SPORT'S new social media campaign #WHEREiROOT. AROUND THE BIG SKY

RECORD-BREAKING BIRD: Southern Utah junior quarterback Ammon Olsen set a number of school records in last Saturday's loss to Idaho State. Olsen completed 38-of-65 passes for 528 yards with three touchdowns and two interceptions. Olsen set single-game school records for passing yards, passing attempts, total plays and total yards of offense. Olsen amassed 530 yards of total offense. The 528 passing yards are the second-most in the FCS this season. Fordham's Michael Nebrich threw for 566. The 65 attempts are the third-most in an FCS game this season.

OH, CANADA: For the second straight season, Montana senior running back Jordan Canada enjoyed a stellar day against UC Davis. In Saturday's 42-28 win, Canada rushed 15 times for 151 yards and three touchdowns. In the second half, Canada had six carries for 11 yards at halftime. In the second half, he scored on runs of 74, 24 and 21 yards. In a 2013 win at UC Davis, Canada rushed 24 times for 126 yards and two touchdowns.

THREE TEAMS IN TOP 10: For the second straight week, three Big Sky teams are ranked in the top 10 in The Sports Network Top 25. Eastern Washington remained second behind North Dakota State. Montana remained seventh. Montana State, despite a win over Weber State, dropped from ninth to 10th. In the Coaches' Poll, EWU remained second, Montana is sixth for the second straight week, and Montana State remained 11th for the second straight week. Northern Arizona, Cal Poly and Idaho State all received votes in both polls.

TOPS IN ATTENDANCE: Montana continues to lead the FCS in average attendance. The Grizzlies drew 25,766 to last week's win over UC Davis. Montana is averaging 25,509 fans per game. James Madison is second with an average of 22,761. Montana State is third in average attendance at 19,099. Four Big Sky teams are averaging more than 100 percent of the stadium capacity. Eastern Washington is third in the nation, averaging 118.45 percent of stadium capacity with an average attendance of 10,187. Eastern Washington has sold out its remaining home games. Montana State is fifth at 107.44. Northern Arizona is seventh at 105.25, and Montana is 10th at 101.16 percent.

HORNET HISTORY: Sacramento State senior wide receiver DeAndre Carter caught two touchdown passes in a 56-27 loss to Cal Poly to become the school's all-time leader. Carter has 29 career touchdown passes. He set a school single-season record with 14 last season, and is tied for the FCS lead with 11 so far this year. Senior quarterback Garrett Safron became the school's all-time leading passer. Safron threw for 306 yards in the loss to bring his career total to 8,448, surpassing the previous record of 8,376 set by Ryan Leadingham. Safron also surpassed 10,000 career yards of total offense. Safron has 10,191 yards of total offense, which is second among active FCS players. Only Eastern Washington's Vernon Adams Jr, who has 10,263 has more.

Extra Points: Home teams won four of the six conference games last Saturday. Home teams are now 14-9 in conference games...Eastern Washington has blocked a punt in three straight games...Cal Poly linebacker Nick Dzubnar tied his career high with 19 tackles in the win over Sacramento State. Dzubnar leads the nation with an average of 14.6 tackles per game...Northern Arizona's Marcus Alford returned an interception 67 yards for a touchdown in a 21-17 win over Portland State. Alford now has two career interception returns for touchdowns, a kick return for a touchdown, and a blocked punt returned for a touchdown...MSU's Shawn Johnson needs 55 all-purpose yards to become the school's all-time leader. Johnson had 187 against Weber State to hike his career total to 4,125...UC Davis WR Ramon Vargas had eight catches for 129 yards and two touchdowns in a loss to UM. In the last two weeks, Vargas has 16 catches for 260 yards and three touchdowns...SUU DE James Cowser has 18.5 tackles for loss. The single-season league record is 28 set by Idaho State's Jared Allen in 2003...Five different Cal Poly players rushed for touchdowns in the Mustangs' win over Sacramento State. Joe Protheroe scored two - the first two of his collegiate career...Cal Poly leads the nation in rushing offense at 337.1 yards per game...ISU QB Justin Arias was named the Co-National Offensive Player of the Week by The Sports Network. Bengal LB Mario Jenkins was named the National Co-Freshman of the Week by TSN.
