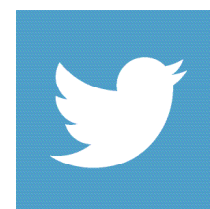

## ROOT SPORTS Players of the Week Oct. 27

### OFFENSE - CHRIS BROWN, QB, CAL POLY & AMMON OLSEN, QB, SOUTHERN UTAH



Brown, a 6-foot-2, 200-pound junior from Compton, Calif., rushed for a career-high 226 yards and two touchdowns, and threw for 107 yards and a touchdown in Cal Poly's 41-21 upset of No. 7 Montana. Brown set a Cal Poly single-game rushing record by a quarterback. He averaged 10.8 yards per carry, scoring on runs of 17 and 15 yards. He also tossed a 5-yard touchdown pass. This is Brown's first career Player of the Week honor.



Olsen, a 6-3, 190-pound junior from Draper, Utah, completed 23-of-25 passes for 320 yards with four touchdowns and no interceptions in Southern Utah's 35-17 win over North Dakota. Olsen also scored on a 4-yard TD run. He finished the game with a pass efficiency rating of 320, just shy of the league record of 322.3. Olsen threw TD passes of 4, 2, 37 and 87 yards. This is Olsen's first career Player of the Week honor.

### DEFENSE - MITCH BECKSTEAD, LB, IDAHO STATE



Beckstead, a 6-foot, 235-pound senior from Dayton, Idaho, tallied 11 tackles - two for loss - with one sack, a forced fumble and an interception as Idaho State snapped a 48-game road losing streak with a 46-12 win over Northern Colorado. Beckstead tallied seven solo tackles. His forced fumble was recovered by a teammate and returned 53 yards to the Northern Colorado 1-yard line, setting up the Bengals' final touchdown. ISU held Northern Colorado to 55 yards of offense in the first half. The 12 points were the fewest allowed by the Bengals to a Division I opponent since 2002. This is Beckstead's first career

Player of the Week honor.

### SPECIAL TEAMS - RYAN HAWKINS, K/P, No. ARIZONA



Hawkins, a 5-11, 185-pound junior from Peoria, Ariz., connected on three field goals and averaged 55.5 yards per punt in Northern Arizona's 28-27 upset of No. 2 Eastern Washington. Hawkins made field goals of 44, 26 and 42 yards. The 42-yarder pulled the Lumberjacks within 24-22 in the fourth quarter. Hawkins took over punting duties for the first time, and blasted a 70-yarder on his first attempt. He also had punts of 40, 67 and 45 yards. Six of his seven kickoffs went

for touchbacks. This is Hawkins first career Player of the Week honor.

## AROUND THE BIG SKY

**BENGALS END ROAD STREAK:** Idaho State earned its first road victory since 2006, downing Northern Colorado 46-12 in Greeley on Saturday. Idaho State entered the game riding a 48-game road losing streak. The Bengals had also lost 32 consecutive conference road games, a conference record. Idaho State's last road win previous to Saturday was a 41-13 victory over Northern Colorado on Oct. 7, 2006. The Bengals lost their final three road games in 2006, and then failed to win a road game the next seven seasons. Idaho State lost its first three road games of 2014. The victory on Saturday improved Idaho State's record to 3-1 in conference and 5-3 overall. Idaho State won a combined four games the previous two seasons. This marks the first time Idaho State has won three conference games in a season since 2005, and also the first time the program has won five overall games since 2005. Idaho State's last winning season came in 2003 when the Bengals finished 4-3 in conference play and 8-4 overall. The Bengals have now won three straight games for the first time since 2003. Idaho State has not won four consecutive games in a season since 2002. In Saturday's win over Northern Colorado, the Bengal defense didn't allow a point in the first half, and the 12 points allowed marked the fewest the Bengals have given up to a Division I team since posting a 34-0 shutout against Weber State 34-0 on Oct. 26, 2002. Idaho State currently ranks first in the nation in passing offense with an average of 359.3 yards per game, and is second in total offense at 579.9 yards per game. ISU is averaging 49.8 points per game in conference play. Idaho State has already scored 45 touchdowns this season, which ties for second-most in school history. The 1981 Idaho State Bengals, who won the FCS national title, scored 52. The Bengals' losses this season have come to FBS teams Utah and Utah State, and a two-point road loss to Eastern Washington. Utah is 6-1 and ranked 18th in both major FBS Top 25 Polls this week. Utah State is 5-3 overall. Idaho State travels to Portland State this Saturday and then returns home to face Cal Poly in a game that could have league title implications.

**LUMBERJACKS AXE EAGLES:** Northern Arizona halted Eastern Washington's 14-game conference winning streak with a thrilling 28-27 victory over the Eagles in Flagstaff on Saturday. Third-string QB Jordan Perry threw a 20-yard touchdown pass to 20-yard touchdown pass Dan Galindo with 12 seconds for the game-winning score. With under a minute to play, EWU opted to go for it on a fourth-and-3 from the NAU 23-yard line with a 27-22 lead. The pass was incomplete, giving the Lumberjacks a chance. Perry connected with Alex Holmes on a 54-yard to set up the game-winning score. EWU had won 14 straight in league play and 16 in a row over Big Sky teams dating back to a 2012 loss to Southern Utah. This marked the second consecutive season NAU notched a home win over a Top-10 team. NAU beat No. 7 Montana 34-16 in 2013.

**POLY STREAKIN:** Cal Poly notched its fourth straight victory, upsetting No. 7 Montana 41-21. The Mustangs have won five of six since opening the season with back-to-back road losses to New Mexico State and South Dakota State. Cal Poly QB Chris Brown set a school single-game rushing record, amassing 226 yards and two touchdowns. Cal Poly leads the nation in rushing offense with an average of 346.7 yards per game. The Mustangs rushed for 421 yards and five touchdowns in the win over Montana. In conference play, the Mustangs are averaging 365.2 rushing yards per game. Cal Poly is 4-1 in conference and 3-0 at home entering Saturday's showdown with Montana State.

**A RUN OF 200-YARD RUSHERS:** No Big Sky player rushed for 200 yards over the first seven weeks of the season. In the past two weeks, four players have gone over the 200-yard mark. Portland State freshman Steven Long was the first with 253 yards in a 21-17 loss to Northern Arizona on Oct. 18. Idaho State's Xavier Finney rushed for a career-high 236 yards and a touchdown in the Bengals' win over Northern Colorado last Saturday. Cal Poly quarterback Chris Brown rushed for a career-high 226 yards and two touchdowns in an upset of Montana. Eastern Washington senior Quincy Forte returned after missing four games with a shoulder injury to rush for a career-high 219 yards and a touchdown in a loss to Eastern Washington. Brown was named the Co-Offensive Player of the Week by The Sports Network. Brown has 856 rushing yards this season and is on pace to break the single season rushing record by a quarterback in the Big Sky. Portland State's Connor Kavanagh set the mark with 1,060 in 2011.

## AROUND THE BIG SKY

**WALSH TIES READ:** Cal Poly football coach Tim Walsh moved into a tie for fourth place on the Big Sky's all-time victories list with former Montana coach Don Read. Walsh has 85 victories while coaching in the Big Sky. Walsh compiled a 65-48 record while coaching Portland State from 1996-2006 in the Big Sky. He is 20-12 at Cal Poly since the Mustangs joined the league in 2012. Chris Ault of Nevada is first with 111 wins, followed by NAU's Jerome Souers (98) and Idaho State's Mike Kramer (88).

**IDAHO STATE'S X-MAN:** Idaho State's Xavier Finney rushed for a career-high 236 yards in the Bengals' win over Northern Colorado. Finney hiked his season total to 1,147 yards. He leads the Big Sky and ranks fourth in the nation with an average of 143.7 rushing yards per game. No Idaho State rusher has ever led the Big Sky in rushing yards per game. Finney became the first Idaho State back to eclipse 1,000 yards since Josh Barnett ran for 1,022 in 2007. The Idaho State single-season rushing record is 1,192 yards set by Alfredo Anderson in 1995. Finney needs just 46 yards to move past Anderson. Finney has surpassed 100 rushing yards in six straight games and seven times this season.

**HAMLIN FOURTH IN TACKLES:** Eastern Washington senior linebacker Ronnie Hamlin tallied nine tackles in a loss to Northern Arizona to hike his career total to 428. Hamlin enters Saturday's game against North Dakota fourth on the Big Sky's all-time tackles list. He's four away from tying former Eastern Washington great J.C. Sherritt, and just six away from tying former Idaho State linebacker A.J. Storms (434) for second place. Former Montana State safety Kane Ioane is the all-time leader with 471. Tackles became an official NCAA statistic in 2000.

**BOLEN ON VERGE OF KICK RETURN RECORDS:** Weber State senior Bo Bolen needs two kick returns to tie the Big Sky all-time career record, and needs 118 yards to tie the all-time kick return yardage record. Bolen enters Saturday's game against Northern Arizona with 101 career kick returns for 2,526 yards. Idaho State's JD Ponciano returned 103 kicks from 2007-09. Weber State's Bryant Eteuati amassed 2,644 kick return yards from 2005-08.

**SUU'S OLSEN NEAR PERFECT:** Southern Utah junior quarterback Ammon Olsen completed 23-of-25 passes for 320 yards with four touchdowns and no interceptions in the Thunderbirds' 35-17 win over North Dakota. Olsen finished with a passer rating of 320, falling just short of the league record of 322.3 set last season by Montana's Jordan Johnson. In conference play, Olsen is averaging 337.6 passing yards per game with 15 touchdowns and four interceptions.

**FORMER MSU COACH, PLAYER PASSES:** Cliff Hysell, who coached Montana State from 1992-1999, died at the age of 72 on Sunday in Bozeman. Hysell played for the Bobcats in 1964 and 1965. He served as an assistant coach at Montana State from 1972-81. Hysell won 41 games as Montana State's head coach, third-most in school history.

**HORNETS, GRIZZLIES ON ROOT SPORTS:** Saturday's Sacramento State-Montana Big Sky Conference game from Washington-Grizzly Stadium. Coverage begins at Noon, Mountain on ROOT SPORTS and DIRECTV's Audience Network. Tom Glasgow, Jason Stiles and Jen Mueller will call the game. Montana is 4-0 at home this season. Sacramento State is seeking its first victory in Missoula.

**IN THE RANKINGS:** Eastern Washington dropped from second to sixth in The Sports Network Poll following its loss to Northern Arizona. Montana State moved up two spots from 10th to eighth. Montana dropped from seventh to 12. Northern Arizona received 245 votes, good enough for 27th. Cal Poly was right behind NAU with 203 votes. Idaho State also received 16 votes. In the Coaches' Poll, EWU dropped to 7th, Montana State improved to 9th, and UM fell to 11th. Cal Poly was 26th with 30 points. NAU and ISU also received votes.

**Extra points:** North Dakota announced starting QB Joe Mollberg is out for the rest of the season with an Achilles' injury...Home teams won three of the five conference games last week. Home teams are now 17-11 in conference games... Cal Poly linebacker Nick Dzubnar and Sacramento State linebacker Darnell Sankey were added to the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List last week. Dzubnar leads the nation with an average of 13.6 tackles per game...Since allowing 470 rushing yards in a loss to Cal Poly, Portland State has allowed 321 rushing yards in the last four games, including holding opponents under 80 yards three times.
