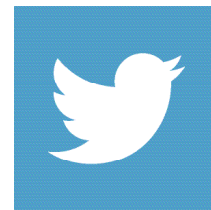

Mikh McKinney, G, Sacramento State



Sacramento State's Mikh McKinney has been selected as the Big Sky Conference men's basketball Player of the Week.

McKinney, a 6-foot-1 senior guard from Union City, Calif., averaged 26.5 points, 6.5 steals, 5.5 assists and 4.0 rebounds per game, helping the Hornets to a 1-1 record. McKinney shot .600 percent from the field and made all nine of his free throws. He also played 37.5 minutes per game.

In an 80-75 loss to Portland on Sunday, McKinney scored 32 points with eight assists, seven steals and seven rebounds. He made 13-of-21 shots from the floor and five free throws. He set career-highs for points and steals in a game. Late in the contest, he became the 13th player in school history to score his 1000th career point.

In a 73-59 win over Cal State Fullerton on Thursday, McKinney scored 21 points with six steals, three assists and a rebound. McKinney made 8-of-14 shots from the floor, and was 4-of-4 from the free-throw line.

This is McKinney's third career Player of the Week honor.

EWU's game vs. Cal will air live on the Pac-12 Network..Northern Arizona also has a busy week of traveling, taking on Saint Mary's in California on Tuesday, before flying across the country to take on Norfolk State on Friday and Hampton on Sunday...Northern Colorado will attempt to move back above .500 as it travels to Nebraska-Omaha on Wednesday, before returning home on Saturday to face Jacksonville State...Idaho State competes in Utah State's tournament in Logan, facing South Dakota State on Thursday, Utah State on Friday and Cal State Bakersfield on Saturday...Portland State returns to action on Thursday at San Francisco of the West Coast Conference...Idaho's only game of the week is Thursday at home against Walla Walla...Montana State continues a three-game road trip, facing South Dakota on Thursday and Portland on Saturday...For just the second time this season, North Dakota plays a home game. The Green & White play host to Dickinson State on Friday...Southern Utah is on the road Friday to face Loyola-Chicago...Weber State plays host to Utah Valley on Saturday night at the Dee Events Center...Montana's lone game is Sunday at home against South Dakota...Sacramento State travels to Seattle on Sunday.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

SO CLOSE IN SEATTLE: Eastern Washington fell just short of becoming the first Big Sky team to upset a Top 25 squad on Sunday, falling 81-77 at No. 17 Washington. Eastern Washington led 42-31 at the half, and led for nearly 35 minutes in the game. Both of Eastern Washington's losses this season have come on the road to Top 25 teams. EWU fell at SMU by nine points earlier this season. Junior Tyler Harvey scored a team-high 21 points, while Drew Brandon netted 16 points with nine rebounds. The last time a Big Sky team beat a ranked opponent came on Dec. 23, 2008 when Portland State beat Gonzaga 77-70.

MCKINNEY REACHES 1,000: Sacramento State senior guard Mikh McKinney became the second Hornet this season and the 13th in school history to surpass 1,000 career points. McKinney hit the milestone with 5:36 to play in the Hornets' 80-75 loss to Portland on Sunday. McKinney has scored 1,003 points in 67 career games. McKinney is averaging 15 points a game in his career. Earlier this season, senior guard Dylan Garrity reached the milestone. Garrity currently has 1,057 career points. McKinney played one of his best career games Sunday night, scoring a career-high 32 points to go along with a career-high seven steals, eight assists and seven rebounds. McKinney's seven steals were the most by a Big Sky player this season and tied for the seventh-most by a Division I player this season.

HARVEY NETS 1,000th POINT: Eastern Washington junior Tyler Harvey scored his 100th career point in the Eagles' 81-76 road win over San Francisco on Thursday. Harvey scored 19 points to hike his career point total to 1,010. He became the 17th player in school history to reach the mark. Harvey reached the milestone in his 61st career game. Harvey added 21 points in a loss to Washington, giving him 1,031 points in his career. Harvey is averaging 16.6 points per game in his career. Eastern Washington junior Venky Jois is on the verge of joining Harvey in the 1,000-point club. Jois enters the week with 961 career points. Harvey has scored in double figures in 21 consecutive games dating back to last season.

RPI REPORT: The Big Sky Conference is ranked 23rd among Division I conferences in this week's RPI Report provided by Collegiate Basketball News. The Big Sky is just behind the Metro Atlantic and just ahead of the Atlantic Sun. Eastern Washington leads the Big Sky with an RPI of 39. The Eagles improved 15 spots from last week. EWU's losses have come to Washington, which has an RPI of 17, and SMU (63). Montana is second among Big Sky teams at 150, followed by Portland State (191) and North Dakota (196). Montana's schedule strength is 25th in the nation this week's. The average RPI of UM's opponents is 55. EWU's schedule strength is 112.
