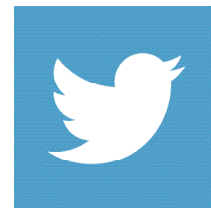

Tim Huskisson, F, Northern Colorado



The Big Sky Conference has selected Northern Colorado's Tim Huskisson as the men's basketball Player of the Week.

Huskisson, a 6-foot-5, senior from Willard, Mo., averaged 21.5 points, three rebounds, two assists, and 1.5 steals per game as the Bears went 1-1.

Huskisson scored a career-high 24 points with four rebounds, three assists and three steals as

Northern Colorado rallied for a 69-60 win over Jacksonville State at home on Sunday, Dec. 20. Huskisson was 8-of-10 from the floor, 2-of-5 from the 3-point line, and 6-of-8 from the free-throw line.

On Wednesday, Huskisson scored 19 points with two rebounds, and an assist in a 92-82 road loss to Nebraska-Omaha. He was 7-of-11 from the field, 3-of-5 from the 3-point line, and 2-of-3 from the free-throw line.

For the week, Huskisson shot .714 percent from the floor, .556 percent from 3-point range, and .7272 from the free-throw line.

This is Huskisson's second career Player of the Week honor.

This week's action will serve as the final tune-ups before conference play begins next week...Southern Utah will play three times this week at the Las Vegas Classic. The Thunderbirds play Arkansas Pine Bluff on Monday, and either South Carolina State or Abilene Christian on Tuesday, followed by UNLV on Saturday...Idaho travels to Northern Kentucky on Monday in the second meeting between the schools this season...Weber State is at Oklahoma on Monday, and then plays host to Bristol University on Saturday...Northern Colorado plays host to UC Davis on Monday...North Dakota travels to Marquette on Monday...Eastern Washington and Portland State are at home Monday night against non-Division I teams. PSU takes on Walla Walla, while Eastern Washington meets Lewis-Clark State...Montana State plays host to Wyoming on Tuesday night in the second meeting this month between the border rivals...Idaho State treks to Utah Valley on Tuesday night...On Saturday, Sacramento State will be at Utah Valley...On Sunday, Northern Arizona plays at home against San Diego Christian...Conference play starts next Thursday with six games.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

RARE WIN IN MORAGA: Northern Arizona upset Saint Mary's 73-71 last Monday night on Moraga, Calif., ending a 13-game losing streak by Big Sky teams on the Gaels' home floor. Senior Quinton Upshur scored 26 points, including the game-winning basket with two seconds remaining. Kris Yanku tied the game with a jumper with eight seconds left. Upshur stole the ball on the inbound pass and scored the game-winner. A Big Sky team hadn't won at Saint Mary's since 1994 when Montana beat the Gaels 66-56 on Dec. 8, 1994. It marked the first win by a Big Sky team over Saint Mary's since the Grizzlies beat the Gaels on Nov. 30, 2003 in Missoula. Under Jack Murphy, Northern Arizona has now picked up three historic road victories. Last season, Northern Arizona ended Montana's record string of home wins over Big Sky teams. Later last year, Northern Arizona accomplished the same feat against Weber State.

HANSEN SCORES 1,000: Idaho State senior forward/guard Chris Hansen scored his 1000th career point in the Bengals' 59-50 loss to Cal State Bakersfield on Saturday night at the World Vision Classic in Logan, Utah. Hansen became the 20th player in ISU men's basketball history to reach the milestone. Hansen has scored 1,003 career points in 70 games. Hansen became the fifth Big Sky player to reach the mark this season. Eastern Washington junior Venky Jois is just three points away from reaching 1,000.

BIG SKY IN THE RPI: The Big Sky Conference improved one spot in this week's RPI, and now ranks 22nd among Division I conferences. The Southland Conference is 21st. Despite losses to Cal and Sam Houston State, Eastern Washington improved two spots in the RPI to 37th. EWU is just behind Dayton and just ahead of Georgia Tech. North Dakota is second with an RPI of 177, followed by Idaho at 181 and Portland State at 192. Montana has a schedule strength of 40, followed by Eastern Washington at 52 and Idaho at 65. Kentucky is No. 1 in the RPI followed by Kansas, VCU, Virginia and Wichita State.

HARVEY IN THE TOP 25: Eastern Washington junior Tyler Harvey made 11 3-pointers last week and has moved into the top 25 on the Big Sky's all-time list with 183 career treys. Harvey is tied with Idaho State's Austin Kilpatrick (2006-10) for 23rd place. He is just eight 3-pointers away from moving past Montana's Jeremy Lake (1991-95) into 20th place. Harvey leads the nation in 3-point field goals per game (4.25) and is first in total 3-pointers made with 51. Harvey is second in the nation in 3-pointers attempted with 109. Harvey is also 24th in 3-point field-goal percentage at .468. Harvey has made 183-of-414 3-point attempts in his career, an average of .442 percent. Harvey leads the Big Sky and ranks eighth in the nation in scoring with an average of 21.8 points per game.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

VERLIN TOPS AT IDAHO: Idaho seventh-year coach Don Verlin became the school's all-time leader in victories when his team beat Walla Walla 86-39 last week. Verlin has amassed 102 victories with the Vandals, who returned to the Big Sky on July 1, 2014. Verlin surpassed two coaches who won 101 games at Idaho. David MacMillan did it from 1920-1927, and Charles Finley won 101 from 1947-54.

IN THE NCAA STATS: Weber State 17-of-18 free throws in a win over Utah Valley, and moved into first place in the nation in free-throw percentage at .790...Idaho leads the nation in 3-point shooting at .432 percent. The Vandals made 11-of-23 from downtown in a win over Walla Walla...Northern Colorado is sixth in fewest turnovers per game at 10.0...Eastern Washington is ninth in 3-point field goals per game at 9.6... Idaho's Mike Scott is second in the nation in assist/turnover ratio at 4.75... Sacramento State's Mikh McKinney is third in steals with an average of 3.22 per game...Southern Utah freshman James McGee is third in 3-point field-goals percentage (.563)...EWU's Tyler Harvey is first in 3-point field goals per game (4.25) and eighth in scoring (21.8 ppg).

Tip-ins: Sacramento State's Mikh McKinney recorded his 100th career steal in the Hornets' loss to Seattle on Sunday...Weber State's Joel Bolomboy needs 19 rebounds to become the 30th player in league history to record 700 rebounds...Montana played without three starters in a 57-62 loss to South Dakota...ISU's Jeffrey Solarin scored 22 points with 10 rebounds in an overtime loss to South Dakota State...Northern Colorado's Dominique Lee scored 19 points with 10 rebounds in a win over Jacksonville State. Lee is averaging 15.3 points and 12 rebounds per game in his last three games... Montana State's Danny Robison scored a career-high 24 points with seven rebounds in a loss to Portland...
