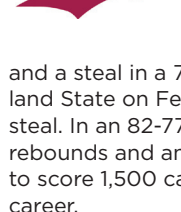
## Player of the Week - February 10, 2014

### Kareem Jamar, G/F, Montana & Joel Bolomboy, F, Weber State

Montana's Kareem Jamar and Weber State's Joel Bolomboy have been selected as co-Big Sky Conference men's basketball players of the Week for Games Played Feb. 3-8.



Jamar, a 6-foot-5, senior guard/forward from Venice, Calif., averaged 20.7 points, 7.7 rebounds, and two assists per game as the Grizzlies beat Montana State, Portland State and Eastern Washington last week.



Jamar made 24-of-32 free throws and was 6-of-13 from 3-point range in the three wins. Jamar scored 20 points with 10 rebounds, a block, and a steal in a 70-66 road win over Montana State on Feb. 3. In an 82-76 win over Portland State on Feb. 6, he netted 19 points with seven rebounds, five assists, a block and a steal. In an 82-77 win over Eastern Washington on Feb. 8, Jamar scored 23 points with six rebounds and an assists. In that game, Jamar became the 32nd player in Big Sky history to score 1,500 career points. Jamar has been named Player of the Week seven times in his career.



Bolomboy, a 6-9 sophomore forward from Fort Worth, Texas, averaged 16 points, 11.5 rebounds, 1.5 assists, one block, and one steal per game as the first-place Wildcats notched home wins over North Dakota and Northern Colorado. Bolomboy shot .643 percent from the field, and made all 14 of his free-throw attempts. He entered the week, making .643 percent of his free throws this season.

Bolomboy scored a career-high 20 points with 10 rebounds, two assists, a block and a steal in an 84-72 win over North Dakota on Feb. 6. Bolomboy was 6-of-10 from the floor, and 8-of-8 from the free-throw line. Bolomboy recorded 12 points and 13 rebounds, along with one assist, a block and a steal, in a 79-65 win over second-place Northern Colorado on Feb. 8. It marked Bolomboy's seventh double-double of the season, and his seventh straight game with at least 10 rebounds. This is Bolomboy's first career Player of the Week honor.

## THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

Nine of the 11 teams in the league are within two games of each other with four weeks remaining in the regular season...Weber State has opened up a three-game lead, but plays six of its final eight on the road. The Wildcats are at Southern Utah on Thursday...Northern Colorado looks to end a four-game losing streak as it returns home to face Montana on Thursday and Montana State on Saturday. Both games will air live on Altitude Sports & Entertainment. The Bears are 11-0 at home this season...Sacramento State, winners of three straight, closes out a four-game homestand on Monday against Southern Utah. The Hornets are at EWU on Thursday and at PSU on Saturday...NAU, which has moved into a tie for second place at 7-5, is at PSU on Thursday and EWU on Saturday...UND, also 7-5 and tied for second, is at home Thursday against Montana State and Saturday vs. Montana. Thursday's MSU game will be televised live on Fox College Sports and Midco Sports Network...SUU plays its third game of the week on Saturday against Idaho State in Cedar City.

## Around the Big Sky

**WEBER TIES HOME STREAK RECORD:** Weber State beat North Dakota and Northern Colorado at home last week to extend its streak of consecutive home conference regular-season wins to 26. Weber State tied the all-time Big Sky record, which was set by Montana last season. UM's streak ended earlier this season against Northern Arizona. Montana won 31 straight over Big Sky teams at Dahlberg Arena with postseason games included. Weber State has won 27 in a row over Big Sky teams with postseason games included. Weber State has not lost a regular-season conference home game since falling to Eastern Washington 75-59 on March 2, 2011. Weber State is 62-4 in regular-season home conference games under Randy Rahe. Dating back to the 2008-09 season, WSU has won 48 of its last 49 conference regular-season home games. WSU has two regular-season home conference games remaining, on Feb. 27 vs. Sacramento State and on March 1 vs. Northern Arizona.

**CONFERENCE TRAFFIC JAM:** Nine of the Big Sky's 11 teams currently have conference records of 7-5, 6-6, 5-6 or 5-7, meaning just two games separates second place from 10th place with four weeks left in the conference regular season. Two-time defending champion Montana has won four straight to move into a tie for second place with Northern Colorado, Northern Arizona, and North Dakota. Northern Colorado lost four straight on the road, but returns home where it is 11-0 this season. League-leader Weber State plays six of its final eight conference games on the road. Home teams are currently 49-16 in conference games. The top seven teams advance to the Big Sky Championship.

**JAMAR NETS 1,500TH POINT:** Montana's Kareem Jamar scored his 1,500th career point in last Saturday's 82-77 victory over Eastern Washington. Jamar hiked his career total to 1,519 points, moving up to sixth on the school's all-time scoring list. He surpassed head coach Wayne Tinkle, who scored 1,500 points at UM from 1986-89. Jamar became the 32nd player in Big Sky history to score 1,500 points. Kamar now ranks 29th on the all-time scoring list. The reigning Big Sky MVP also has 378 career assists, which puts him 24th on the Big Sky's all-time list. Jamar is the active league leader in rebounds with 612.

**GARRITY SURPASSES 400 ASSISTS:** Sacramento State junior Dylan Garrity dished out a season-high 10 assists in Sacramento State's win over Northern Arizona last Saturday. Garrity enters Monday's game against Southern Utah with 408 career assists. Garrity is the 19th player in league history to dish out at least 400 assists. Garrity is currently tied for 18th place on the Big Sky's all-time list with former Eastern Washington player Deon Williams (1997-2000).

**RAHE TIED FOR SECOND:** Weber State head coach Randy Rahe has moved into a tie for second place on the all-time list for conference wins. Rahe has won 102 regular-season conference games in his eight years, tying him for second place on the all-time list with former Boise State coach Bobby Dye, who coached for 12 years. ## AROUND THE BIG SKY

**SOLARIN PULLS DOWN 20 REBOUNDS:** Idaho State junior Jeffery Solarin pulled down 20 rebounds in a loss to North Dakota on Saturday. Solarin's 20 rebounds were the most by a Big Sky player this season. The game ranked 12th in ISU history, are were the most by a Bengal since 1975. Solarin had 12 offensive rebounds and eight on the defensive end. Solarin also scored 23 points in the loss.

**RPI UPDATE:** Weber State has taken the top spot among Big Sky teams in the RPI. Weber State improved 31 spots from last week to 157. Northern Colorado is now second at 189. Montana improved 31 spots to 193. North Dakota is fourth at 234. The Big Sky remained 27th among Division I conferences.

**NCAA LEADERS:** Weber State's Joel Bolomboy ranks sixth in the nation in rebounds per game at 11.2...EWU's Tyler Harvey is sixth in the nation in 3-point field goals per game (3.57) and 13th in 3-point FG percentage (.443) and 13th in points per game (21.2)... Northern Colorado is 14th in the nation in field-goal percentage (.488)... North Dakota is 14th in steals per game (8.7). Montana is 16th in turnovers per game (10.1).

**Tip-ins:** EWU's Martin Seiferth and Venky Jois are on the verge of becoming the 26th and 27th players in league history to block 100 career shots. Seiferth and Jois are currently tied with Paul Butorac for the all-time school record in blocked shots with 99..Weber State's Joel Bolomboy has pulled down at least 10 rebounds in seven straight games and 12 of his last 13...Both of Northern Colorado's games this week will be televised live on Altitude Sports & Entertainment. NC plays host to Montana on Thursday and Montana State on Saturday... Northern Colorado's Tate Unruh is tied for 13th all-time in league history in 3-pointers made with 211...EWU's Tyler Harvey has made 82 3-pointers this season, which is already tied for 20th in league single-season history... Sacramento State's Mikh McKinney is averaging 28 points, five assists and four rebounds over his last three games...Northern Colorado's 12-game home winning streak is the 18th longest active streak in the country.
