After a couple of wins this past weekend, North Dakota remains in first place with an 11-2 conference record. Montana and Southern Utah are right behind with four conference losses.

The Thunderbirds will host Northern Arizona tonight at 7:05 p.m. Mountain. Catch the game on WatchBigSky.com for free.

Conference play will continue on Thursday with five games and the week will conclude with five games on Saturday. Catch all 10 games on WatchBigSky.com.

The Big Sky Conference's Watch Big Sky App was released Friday (Jan. 31), and is available for free through the Apple Store, and on Google Play for Android.

On Thursday, Northern Arizona will host Portland State at 12:05 p.m. Mountain, and Eastern Washington will travel to NAU on Saturday for a 6:35 p.m. Mountain tip off. Catch both games on NAU-TV and Fox Sports Arizona. The game on Thursday can also be seen on Fox College Sports Pacific.

Sacramento State broke its own Big Sky record in points scored in a game. The Hornets scored 111 points against Weber State. The old record of 110 was set against North Dakota.

Another Big Sky record set this past weekend was the combined point total of the two teams. Weber State had 104 points in the 111 loss to Sacramento State. The 215 record broke the 214 record set by SAC and North Dakota.

On Dec. 14th against UC Irvine, SAC set two other Big Sky records. The Hornets made 21 3-pointers and attempted 55. Both of those are records.

Southern Utah set a new Big Sky record in rebounds with 74. SUU did that on Dec. 16th against Arizona Christian.

The Thunderbirds set a new Big Sky record in field-goal percent in a single game. SUU shot .667 from the floor against SAC on Saturday (2/8).

## EWU'S WILLIAMS & SUU PARKINSON NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (February 10, 2014) - Eastern Washington's Melissa Williams and Southern Utah's Lori Parkinson have been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Co-Player of the Week for the games played the week of Feb. 3-Feb. 9.

Williams, a junior from Camash, Wash., recorded a pair of double-doubles as the Eagles swept the weekend series from the visiting Montana schools for just the seventh time in program history.

She averaged 11 points and 10.5 rebounds for the week, shooting 62.5 percent (10-16) from the field. She went for 12 points and a game-high 11 rebounds in Eastern's victory over Montana State on Thursday, helping EWU outrebound the Bobcats, 42-29, while limiting MSU to just 10 offensive boards. She connected on five of her nine shots versus Montana State and chipped in a pair of steals.

Against Montana on Saturday, Williams notched 10 points and a game-high 10 rebounds, shooting 5-of-7 from the field, including a buzzer-beating put-back to give EWU a 10-point lead at the half. She also picked up two steals and a blocked shot against the Lady Griz. Williams now has three straight games with double-digit rebounds after pulling down 10 boards in the Eagles' one-point win at Northern Colorado last week.

Parkinson, a sophomore from West Valley, Utah, scored a career-high 22 points as Southern Utah knocked off Sacramento State by a final score of 93-74 on Saturday. The forward went 10-14 from the field and 2-2 at the foul line as the Thunderbirds recorded their highest shooting mark of the season at 66.7 percent to defeat the Hornets for the second time this year.

Parkinson pulled down 11 rebounds in the contest for her fifth double-double of the season and came up with four momentum-changing blocks. She also grabbed three steals and handed out a pair of assists in the win.

Parkinson is averaging 13.8 ppg to go along with 8.1 rpg in Big Sky play while shooting over 56 percent from the floor. She has also totaled 15 blocks, 17 assists and 20 steals in Southern Utah's 11 conference games.

## LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

**Lindsey Reed, Idaho State** - Reed averaged 19.5 points and 8.5 rebounds for the weekend split against Northern Colorado and North Dakota. Reed scored 24 points in the win against Northern Colorado. She also added six rebounds and four assists while shooting 63 percent from the field. In the overtime loss to North Dakota, Reed recorded a double-double with 15 points and 11 rebounds.

**Torry Hill, Montana** - Hill averaged 16.3 points and 5.3 assists as Montana went 2-1 last week with a home win over Montana State and a road split with Portland State and Eastern Washington. Hill shot 40.5 percent in the three games, hit seven 3-pointers and went 12 for 13 (.923) from the free throw line...In Monday's 84-79 overtime win over Montana State, Hill scored 20 of her game-high and career-high 23 points in the second half and overtime while playing a career-high 43 minutes. She also added five assists...In Thursday's 65-55 win at Portland State, Hill had 11 points, 7 assists and 3 steals as the Lady Griz rallied from a 33-25 halftime deficit to win their fifth straight game...In Saturday's 71-61 loss at Eastern Washington, Hill scored a team-high 15 points while dishing out four assists.

**Madi Buck, North Dakota** - Buck helped North Dakota run its winning streak to five straight with a pair of home wins. UND defeated Weber State 68-55 Thursday before outlasting Idaho State in overtime Saturday (64-59)...Buck averaged 15 points, 7.5 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 1.0 blocks to help UND run its conference record to 11-2, two-and-a-half games in front of Montana. She scored 17 in the win over the Wildcats, including a perfect 6-for-6 effort from the charity stripe in the final 32 seconds to help seal the deal. She added six rebounds, four steals, two assists and a block in Thursday's win...The senior then scored 13 points with nine rebounds in the overtime thriller against Idaho State. She scored the first bucket of the overtime session and grabbed a defensive rebound on the ensuing Bengal possession as UND never looked back.

**Kyleigh Hiser, Northern Colorado** - Hiser entered the week having scored just 26 points through 15 games and posted back-to-back career-highs with 12 points against Idaho State and 22 in the win over Weber State for 34 points on the weekend. Coming off the bench in both games, Hiser shot a blistering .833 from the field and .500 from beyond the arc. She also went 12-for-14 (.857) at the free throw line. Against the Wildcats, Hiser scored eight of the team's final 11 points in the game and had just the second blocked shot of her career in the final minute to secure the victory. In the game against Idaho State, Hiser made all four of her free throw attempts in the first half to tie her previous career-high with six points in the first half alone, then doubled it with six more in the second half.

**Emily Easom, Portland State** - Easom led the Vikings to a weekend split against the Montana schools. Easom averaged 16.0 points per game over the two games including a career-high 27 points against Montana State. Easom went 7-for-19 from the floor (.368), 4-for-12 from distance (.333), and 14-for-16 (.875) from the free throw line on the week...Easom scored five points in Portland State's loss to Montana before posting the career-high 27 points against Montana State. Against the Bobcats, she went 6-for-13 from the floor with a trio of three-pointers. She also had a career night at the free-throw line going 12-for-13. She pulled down four rebounds and recorded a steal in the game...Easom is averaging a team-high 12.0 points per game this season while shooting .411 from the floor. She has a team-high 37 three pointers. She has scored 20-plus points four times this season.

**Alle Moreno, Sacramento State** - Moreno had an exceptional weekend at Northern Arizona and Southern Utah, averaging 18.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists, and 3.0 steals per game while shooting 53.8% and not committing a single turnover in 51 minutes played. Moreno led the Hornets to a 99-91 win at Northern Arizona with 18 points, six rebounds, three assists, and two steals. In addition to shooting 14-of-26 overall for the week, Moreno hit six 3-pointers and made two free throws in three attempts.
