Player of the Week - February 17, 2014

Tyler Harvey, G, Eastern Washington



Eastern Washington's Tyler Harvey has been selected as the Big Sky Conference men's basketball Player of the Week for games played between February 10th and February 15th.

Harvey, a 6-foot-4, 180-pound sophomore guard from Torrance, Calif., averaged 26.5 points, 4.5 rebounds, 1.5 assists and one block per game as the Eagles picked up home victories over Sacramento State and Northern Arizona. Harvey shot .563 percent from the field, .571 percent from 3-point range, and .833 percent from the free-throw line.

The Big Sky's scoring leader scored 16 points with two rebounds, two assists and two blocks in the Eagles' 85-72 win over Sacramento State on Thursday, Feb. 13. Harvey made 5-of-10 from the floor, 3-of-5 from 3-point range, and 3-of-4 from the free-throw line.

In Saturday's 84-65 win over Northern Arizona, Harvey poured in 37 points with seven rebounds and an assist. Harvey went 9-of-16 from 3-point range, just one shy of the team single-game record he tied earlier this season. Harvey was 13-of-22 from the floor, and 2-of-2 from the free-throw line.

Chris Hansen, G, Idaho State: Scored 22 points with seven rebounds in a win.

Kareem Jamar, G/F, Montana: Averaged 19.5 points and seven rebounds in two losses.

Marcus Colbert, G, Montana State: Averged 15 points and four assists in a split.

Troy Huff, G/F, North Dakota: Averaged 17.5 points, 8 rebounds in a win and a loss.

Kris Yanku, G, Northern Arizona: Averaged 19.5 points and 5 rebounds per game in a win and a loss.

Derrick Barden, F, Northern Colorado: Averaged 15.5 points and 9.5 rebounds per game in two wins.

THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

League-leading Weber State faces a challenging week that could all but end the race for the regular-season title, or make the race very exciting in the final two weeks. The Wildcats, who lead Northern Colorado by three games, face three difficult road tests. Weber State begins the trip Monday night against rival Idaho State in Pocatello. On Thursday, Montana welcomes Weber State to Missoula. Weber State has lost its last four to Montana in Missoula, and lost last year to Montana State in Bozeman...Second-place Northern Colorado is at Northern Arizona on Thursday. The Lumberjacks are tied for third place. The Bears, who are 1-5 in conference road games, are at Sacramento State on Saturday...North Dakota also makes the Sacramento State/Northern Arizona swing, playing the Hornets on Thursday and Lumberjacks on Saturday...Idaho State is at Montana State on Thursday and Montana on Saturday, after playing host to Weber State on Monday...Southern Utah plays host to Portland State on Thursday and Eastern Washington on Saturday.

Around the Big Sky

TOURNEY TALK: Three weeks remain in the regular season, and it figures to be a highly-competitive three weeks as 10 teams are still in the running for the seven postseason spots. The regular-season champion will play host to the 2014 Big Sky Championship March 13-15. The championship game will be played on Saturday at 6 p.m. Mountain and it will be televised on ESPNU. Weber State has five of its remaining conference games on the road, including three this week. The Wildcats hold a three-game lead over second-place Northern Colorado. Weber State has road games at Idaho State, Montana and Montana State this week. Weber State was swept on the Montana road trip last year. Northern Colorado (9-5) plays four of its final six conference games on the road. North Dakota and Northern Arizona are both 8-6. UND has three at home and three on the road, while NAU has four at home and just two on the road. Montana, Montana State, Eastern Washington and Sacramento State are all tied at 7-7. Idaho State is 6-7. Just two games separates second place from ninth place in the loss column. Southern Utah is the only team that has been eliminated from postseason contention. Weber State is seeking its first regular-season title since 2009-10. Northern Colorado last won a regular-season title in 2010-11.

STILL PERFECT AT HOME: Northern Colorado moved to 13-0 at Butler-Hancock Sports Pavilion this season with wins over Montana and Montana State last week. The Bears have won 14 straight games dating back to last season. B.J. Hill's team in the only Big Sky squad yet to lose at home this season. Northern Colorado's 14-game homecourt winning streak is tied for the 12th longest active streak in the nation. Stephen F. Austin and Duke are tied for the longest active streak in the nation with 30 consecutive home wins. Weber State has won 11 straight at home, tied for the 17th longest active streak in the nation.

HARVEY MOVING UP: Eastern Washington sophomore Tyler Harvey made nine 3-pointers in a win over Northern Arizona on Saturday to hike his season total to 94. Harvey has moved into a tie for eighth place on the Big Sky single-season list for 3-pointers made. Harvey is tied with Damian Lillard, who made 94 3-pointers for Weber State in 2011-12, and Northern Arizona's Ross Land, who made 94 in 1999-2000. Harvey is on pace to become on the fifth player in league history to make 100 3-pointers in a season. Northern Arizona's Stephen Sir holds the single-season record with 124 during the 2006-07 season. Cory Schwab of NAU made 105 during the 2000-01 season. Eastern Washington's Shannon Taylor made 103 in 1998-99, and Weber State's Scott Bamforth made 103 last season. Montana's David Bell made 98 3-pointers during the 2001-02 and 2002-03 season. Gabe Rogers of Northern Arizona is seventh on the list with 95 last season. Harvey has made 94-of-206 3-pointers this season, hitting .456 percent. Harvey is averaging 3.76 3-pointers per game, which ranks fourth in the nation, and is on pace to be the third-best mark in league single-season history. Harvey has made 21 more 3-point field goals and 2-point field-goals this season. Harvey ranks ninth in the nation in 3-point field-goal percentage and is fifth in total 3-pointers made.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

JAMAR ON VERGE OF TOP 20:

Montana's Kareem Jamar hiked his career scoring total to 1,558 points with games of 21 and 18 in losses last week. Jamar ranks 24th on the Big Sky's all-time scoring list. Jamar should move into the top 20 this week, as he needs just 28 points surpasses Weber State's Willie Sojourner (1,563), Northern Colorado's Devon Beitzel (1,568), Idaho's Ken Luckett (1,571) and Idaho's Brian Kellerman (1,585).

TWO MORE JOIN THE 100 CLUB:

Eastern Washington's Venky Jois and Martin Seiferth each recorded their 100th career blocks last week. Jois and Seiferth became the 26th and 27th players in league history to amass 100 career blocks. Weber State's Kyle Tresnak recorded his 100th earlier this season. Both Jois and Seiferth will enter the next game with 101 career blocks. Both players are tied for first in school history. Paul Butorac, who played at EWU from 2003-07, held the previous record with 99.

RPI UPDATE: Weber State remained the top Big Sky teams in RPI at 158, a drop of one from last week. Northern Colorado improved 23 spots to 166. Montana is at 196. The Big Sky moved up one spot to 26th among Division I Conferences.

NCAA LEADERS: WSU's Jole Bolomboy is now fifth in the nation in rebounds per game with an average of 11.1...UND's Troy Huff is 13th in steals per game (2.42)...UND is eighth in steals per game (9.0)...Northern Colorado is seventh in field-goal percentage (.496).

Tip-ins: Northern Colorado's Tate Unruh has made 216 career 3-pointers and ranks 12th in Big Sky history. He needs two to tie Montana's Kevin Criswell for 11th place. Northern Colorado's Devon Beitzel is 10th on the list with 235...Sacramento State junior Dylan Garrity enters the week with 420 career assists, which ranks 16th in Big Sky history. He needs one more to tie EWU's Ronn McMahon (1987-90) for 15th...Sacramento State's win at Portland State last Saturday was the program's second in Portland since joining the Big Sky in 1996... Home teams are 55-21 in conference games...WSU's Joel Bolomboy's streak of seven straight games with at least 10 rebounds ended against SUU when he had nine.
