Player of the Week - February 24, 2014

Mikh McKinney, Jr., G, Sacramento State



Sacramento State's Mikh McKinney has been selected as the Big Sky Conference men's basketball Player of the Week.

McKinney, a 6-foot-1 junior guard from Union City, Calif., averaged 24 points, 7.5 rebounds, six assists, and 1.5 steals per game as the Hornets earned home victories over North Dakota and Northern Colorado. McKinney shot .484 percent from the field, and .842 percent from

the free-throw line. He also committed just three turnovers in 74 minutes of action.

In a 71-65 victory over North Dakota on Thursday, Feb. 20, McKinney scored a team-high 19 points with six assists, four rebounds, and a steal. McKinney was 7-of-13 from the floor and 5-of-7 from the free-throw line.

On Saturday in a 79-58 win over second-place Northern Colorado, McKinney was just four assists shy of the first triple-double in school history. McKinney scored a team-high 29 points with 11 rebounds, six assists, two steals and a block. He made 11-of-12 free throws, and was 2-of-4 from 3-point range.

Sacramento State has won seven of its last eight conference games. During that run, McKinney is averaging 22.5 points, six assists, and 5.5 rebounds per game. This is McKinney's second Player of the Week honor this season.

THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

League-leading Weber State returns home this week with a chance to clinch at least a share of the regular-season title. The Wildcats battle the red-hot Sacramento State Hornets on Thursday night, and then play host to Northern Arizona on Saturday...Second-place Northern Colorado is also home this week. The Bears take on Eastern Washington on Thursday and Portland State on Saturday. Northern Colorado is hoping to avenge road losses to both teams... PSU and EWU both play three games this week. The rivals meet in Cheney on Monday night...North Dakota, which is tied for third place, welcomes Portland State to Grand Forks on Thursday and Eastern Washington on Saturday... Idaho State, which is in desperate need of a home sweep to keep its tournament hopes alive, takes on NAU on Thursday and Sacramento State on Saturday...Montana State plays its final home regular season game Thursday against Southern Utah. The Thunderbirds are at Montana on Saturday.

Around the Big Sky

TITLE TALK: Weber State enters the final two weeks of the regular season with a two-game lead over Northern Colorado. Both the Wildcats and Bears have two home and two road games remaining. Both teams are 8-0 in conference home games. The Wildcats can clinch at least a share of the regular-season title with a win and a Northern Colorado loss, or with two wins. With two wins and a Northern Colorado loss, the Wildcats would clinch the outright title, and the right to host the conference tournament. Since Weber State and Northern Colorado split regular-season meetings, if the two teams tie at the end of the regular-season, the tournament host would be decided by record against other Big Sky teams starting with the third place team. Weber State battles Sacramento State on Thursday night at the Dee Events Center. The Wildcats have won 26 straight regular-season home conference games, which is tied for the all-time record with Montana. Including postseason games, Montana won 31 straight at home over Big Sky teams. Weber State has currently won 27 in a row over Big Sky teams with the postseason included. Northern Colorado has won 14 straight home games dating back to last season. The Bears' streak is tied for the 10th longest active streak in the nation. Weber State is seeking its first regular-season Big Sky Championship since the 2009-10 season. Northern Colorado won its only Big Sky Championship in 2010-11. The top seven teams qualify for the Big Sky Championship. Just three games separates second place from 10th place in the loss column.

HORNET RISING: Sacramento State is on the verge of qualifying for the Big Sky Championship for the first time since 2006. The Hornets are tied for third place at 9-7, and have won seven of their last eight conference games, and seven straight conference home games. The seven-game home winning streak matches the Hornets' longest home winning streak since joining Division I in 1991. The seven-game home win streak against Big Sky teams is the longest since joining the league in 1996-1997. Sacramento State is 10-2 at home this season. The 10 wins matches the most for the Hornets since 1991. Sacramento State's nine conference wins are the most since joining the Big Sky. The Hornets won eight conference games in 2004-05 and in 2012-13. Sacramento State is currently 13-12 overall, and has a chance to finish above .500 for the first time since becoming a Division I program.

JAMAR CRACKS TOP 20: Montana senior Kareem Jamar has moved into 20th place on the Big Sky's all-time scoring list. Jamar enters this week with 1,595 career points. Former Boise State and NBA star Chris Childs is 19th on the scoring list with 1,602 career points. Former Weber State star Jermaine Boyette is 18th with 1,613. Montana's Andrew Strait is 17th with 1,617.

TINKLE PASSES MONTGOMERY: Montana coach Wayne Tinkle earned his 155th career win with the Grizzlies on Saturday with a 62-61 victory over Idaho State. Tinkle is now second all-time at Montana in victories, and sixth all-time in Big Sky history. Only Jiggs Dahlberg, who won 235 games at Montana in 16 years, has more victories in school history. Tinkle also earned his 94th career Big Sky victory, moving him into a tie for fifth place all-time with former Weber State coach Neil McCarthy.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

RICHARDSON SETS BIG SKY RECORD:

Weber State senior Jordan Richardson played in his 124th and 125th career games last weekend in Montana. Richardson now holds the all-time conference record for most games played. The previous record was 123 by Weber State's Darin Mahoney, who played from 2008-12. Richardson has never missed a game in his career. WSU senior Kyle Tresnak has played in 124 career games, and is second on the all-time list.

RPI UPDATE: The Big Sky improved one spot to 25th in the conference RPI. Northern Colorado has the top RPI for a Big Sky team at 166. Weber State is at 167. Montana improved 14 spots to 182. Kansas has the top overall RPI.

NCAA LEADERS: Eastern Washington's Tyler Harvey is fifth in the nation in 3-point field goals per game (3.65), seventh in 3-point field-goal percentage (.455) and 11th in points per game (21.8)...Weber State's Joel Bolomboy is fifth in the nation in rebounds per game with an average of 11.1...UND's Troy Huff is 13th in steals per game (2.38)...Northern Colorado is 12th in field-goal percentage (.492). North Dakota is 11th in steals per game (8.7)...Montana is 14th in turnovers per game (10.0).

Tip-ins: Northern Colorado's Tate Unruh is 11th on the Big Sky's all-time list for 3-pointers made with 222. Former teammate Devon Beitzel is 10th with 235...Sacramento State's Dylan Garrity is now tied for 13th in league history in assists with 428. Montana State's Craig Finberg also had 428 from 1975-79. Garrity needs just seven assists to move into a tie for 10th place... Home teams are now 61-26 in conference games, a winning percentage of .701...Both of Idaho State's home games this week are in Reed Gym because of the Big Sky Indoor Track and Field Championship being held at Holt Arena...Weber State's Davion Berry scored his 1,00th career point Saturday vs. Montana State. The senior transfer needed just 61 games to reach the mark...North Dakota senior Troy Huff needs 13 points to reach 1,000 in his Big Sky career. Huff, who played two seasons in the Great West, is closing in on 1,900 career points.

Big Sky Tiebreaker

1. Head-to-Head Competition

a. Consider the head-to-head record during the Conference season. In double round robin play a team would have to sweep the opponent to break a tie with this method.

b. In the case of more than two tied teams, consider the Conference regular season record for head-to-head competition among all of the tied teams. This process is used to break ties between any of the tied teams with any remaining tied teams returning to the process at criteria 1.a. (above). (Example: Teams A, B, C, and D have identical record from a double round robin season. In head-to-head competition Team A emerges with 4-2 record against the other tied teams, team B and Team C have a 3-3 record and team D has a 2-4 record. Teams A and D can be placed in the final standings at that point while teams B and C return to criteria 1.a. If B and C have split their regular Conference season games, they will move to criteria 2. Performance against other teams in descending order.)

c. In the case of three or more teams having identical win-loss records, the normal tie-breaking procedure would be used. When one or more of these teams is eliminated by using the tie-breaking procedure, the remaining teams involved would then return to the criteria listed in a., above, to break the tie. This will be done until a team is established for that particular seeding position.

2. Performance against Conference teams in descending order of finish, beginning with the No.1 team. (Example: Teams B and C remained tied after head-to-head criteria from above. Team A has been declared the Conference Champion based on the above criteria. Team B has split the Conference season games with team A and team C has lost both of the Conference games to team A. Team B is now placed in second place ahead of team C.)
