North Dakota became the first team to qualify for the Big Sky Championship on March 13-15.

Southern Utah and Montana are tied in the rankings for second with 11-5 conference record.

First game on the week starts tonight when Eastern Washington travels to Portland State for a 7:05 p.m. Pacific tip off. Conference action will continue on Wednesday when Southern Utah hosts Montana at 7:05 p.m. Mountain.

Conference action will then continue on Thursday with four games and five on Saturday. Catch all the action this week on WatchBigSky.com.

The Big Sky Conference's Watch Big Sky App was released Friday (Jan. 31), and is available for free through the Apple Store, and on Google Play for Android.

On Thursday, Idaho State will travel to Northern Arizona and on Saturday the Lumberjacks will host Weber State. Catch both games on NAU-TV at 6:35 p.m. Mountain.

Sacramento State broke its own Big Sky record in points scored in a game. The Hornets scored 111 points against Weber State. The old record of 110 was set against North Dakota.

Another Big Sky record set this past weekend was the combined point total of the two teams. Weber State had 104 points in the 111 loss to Sacramento State. The 215 record broke the 214 record set by SAC and North Dakota.

On Dec. 14th against UC Irvine, SAC set two other Big Sky records. The Hornets made 21 3-pointers and attempted 55. Both of those are records.

Southern Utah set a new Big Sky record in rebounds with 74. SUU did that on Dec. 16th against Arizona Christian.

The Thunderbirds set a new Big Sky record in field-goal percent in a single game. SUU shot .667 from the floor against SAC on Saturday (2/8).

UND'S BUCK & WSU'S MATTHEWS NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (February 24, 2014) - North Dakota's Madi Buck and Weber State's Kalie Matthews have been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Players of the Week for the games played the week of Feb. 17-23.

Buck a senior from Bismarck, North Dakota, led first-place North Dakota to a pair of convincing 30-point wins this week, defeating Northern Arizona, 71-41 Thursday and Sacramento State, 87-57 Saturday.

Buck scored 18 points and added five rebounds and two steals in Thursday's win. She followed that up with a team-high 20-point effort Saturday, shooting 9-of-13 from the floor in her final regular season home game of her career. It was her seventh 20-point game of the season and 10th straight game in double figures.

For the week, she averaged 19 points, 3.5 rebounds and was a perfect 10-10 from the free throw line.

She leads UND in scoring and has helped North Dakota become the first team to earn a berth in the Big Sky Conference Tournament. UND holds a game and a half lead in the league standings with three games remaining.

Matthews, a sophomore from Glendale, Ariz., helped Weber State go 2-1 this week defeating Idaho State (84-71) on Monday, Montana (56-54) on Thursday and falling to Montana State (71-75) on Saturday. The win on Monday was the first conference win for the Wildcats in their previous 51 tries.

Matthews averaged 10.3 points per game and 8.7 rebounds. She pulling down 13 rebounds in Weber State's win over Montana and scored 14 points. She followed that up with scoring 13 points and added eight rebounds in the loss on Saturday.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Lexie Nelson, Eastern Washington - Nelson poured in a team-high 17 points in Eastern's 59-54 win over Southern Utah on Thursday, Feb. 20. She shot 6-of-12 from the field and 4-of-5 from three-point range, scoring 10 of her points in the first half. Nelson connected on her final three-pointer of the game at the 1:46 mark of the second half, giving EWU a four-point cushion it would not relinquish. She now has a team-high 21 double-figure scoring games this season.

Lindsey Reed, Idaho State - Reed averaged 23.7 points, 8.3 rebounds and 3.3 assists in ISU's three games last week. She had a career-high 34 points in the win over Montana State and tallied her third double-double of the season against Montana with 21 points and 10 rebounds.

Torry Hill, Montana - Hill averaged 14.5 points and 4.5 assists as Montana split on the road, with a loss at Weber State Thursday and a win at Idaho State on Saturday. Hill had 10 points and three assists while shooting 50 percent in the Lady Griz' 56-54 loss to the Wildcats and 19 points, six assists and five rebounds in their 76-67 victory over the Bengals. Hill went 9 for 10 from the line against ISU.

Amanda Frost, Northern Arizona - Frost erupted for a career-high tying 34 points and became the new NAU single-season scoring record holder in the Lumberjacks' 86-70 victory on the road at Northern Colorado on Saturday. Frost bounced back from a six-point outing at North Dakota, a game in which she left early with an injury, for her historic performance against the Bears. With NAU down by 10 in the first half, Frost led the Lumberjacks on a 12-0 run with 10 points during the spurt to settle the team down in a virtual must-win to keep pace in the Big Sky standings. She would finish with an 8-for-12 performance from long distance, setting a new career-best and equaling the single-game school mark in three-pointers made. Overall she shot 11-of-19 from the field and a perfect 4-for-4 from the line in addition to two rebounds, an assist and a steal. She now holds the school record with 543 points this season and counting and moved into sixth all-time in the career three-point charts and third all-time in the season three-point charts in the victory. For the week, Frost averaged 20.0 points per game, shot 46.7 percent from the field and 50 percent from behind the arc and now has five 30-point games this season, most in the Big Sky.

Kim Lockridge, Northern Colorado - Lockridge led the team in scoring with 19 points against Sacramento State and followed up with 15 points and a game-high five assists against Northern Arizona. For the week, Lockridge shot .560 from the field and .857 from the free throw line - well above her season averages. She also averaged 4.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 1.5 steals over the weekend to go along with her 17.0 points.

Mikaela Rivard, Portland State - Rivard posted a career-high 22 points in the Viking's loss to Southern Utah Saturday night. Rivard matched her career-high in field goals with seven going 7-for-10 from the floor. She also hit a season-high three three-pointers in the game and went a perfect 5-for-5 from the floor. She matched her career high in assists with four....Rivard, a junior from Tri-Cities, Wash., has scored in double figures six times this season and has matched or set career scoring marks twice. She is averaging 6.3 points per game this season and is shooting .431 from the floor.

Hailey Mandelko, Southern Utah - Mandelko averaged 21.5 ppg while shooting 42.9 percent from 3-point territory during Southern Utah's two-game trip to Eastern Washington and Portland State. The junior guard scored 19 while hitting a pair of threes and handing out two assists against the Eagles, then put up 24 in an 86-79 win over the Vikings. Mandelko hit six threes on the week and went 17-19 at the free throw line. She also collected two steals, four rebounds and three assists...Mandelko is the Thunderbirds' leading-scorer on the year and has increased her average to 15.5 ppg in Big Sky play. She is shooting over 40 percent from the field in conference, and has gone 35-96 from the outside. Saturday's win at Portland State kept SUU even with Montana for the second-best record in the Sky with postseason positioning on the line.
