Player of the Week - February 3, 2014

Mikh McKinney, G, Sacramento state



Sacramento State's Mikh McKinney has been selected as the Big Sky Conference men's basketball Player of the Week for games played between January 27 and February 1.

McKinney, a 6-foot-3 junior guard from Union City, Calif., averaged 29 points, 5.5 assists and 3.0 rebounds per game, helping the Hornets to home wins over Idaho State and Weber State. He shot .588 percent from the

floor, .600 percent from 3-point range, and .938 percent from the free-throw line. He had 11 assists and just three turnovers.

McKinney opened with 28 points, five assists, one rebounds and one steal in the Hornets' 84-78 win over Idaho State. McKinney made 10-of-17 shots from the floor and was 6-of-6 from the free-throw line.

On Saturday, McKinney scored a season-high 30 points with six assists and five rebounds in the Hornets' 78-75 overtime win over Weber State. McKinney scored seven of his 30 points in overtime as the Hornets snapped a 12-game losing streak to the first-place Wildcats. McKinney made 10-of-17 shots from the floor, was 9-of-10 from the free-throw line, and made his only 3-point attempt.

This is McKinney's first Player of the Week honor.

THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

The final game of the first half of the conference schedule is Monday night and features rivals Montana and Montana State battling in Bozeman. The game will be televised live on Altitude...Montana State plays three home games this week, also taking on Eastern Washington on Thursday and Portland State on Saturday...Montana is at home vs. Portland State on Thursday and EWU on Saturday. PSU enters the week riding a four-game winning streak...League-leading Weber State returns home to face North Dakota, which is tied for third in the league standings on Thursday, and second-place Northern Colorado on Saturday...Idaho State plays host to Northern Colorado on Thursday and Idaho State on Saturday...Northern Arizona, which is tied with PSU and UND for third place, is at Sacramento State on Thursday, and then returns home to face Southern Utah on Saturday.

Around the Big Sky

HALFWAY HOME: The official halfway point of the conference season comes tonight as Montana and Montana State due battle in Bozeman. Weber State finished the first half of league play 8-2, but five other teams are within two games in the loss column. Weber State also plays six of its final 10 games on the road. Home teams are 41-13 in conference games so far this season, a winning percentage of .759. Second-place Northern Colorado (7-3) also plays six of its final 10 on the road. Portland State, which has won four straight and is tied for third at 6-4, also plays six of its final 10 games on the road. Weber State and Northern Colorado are the only teams yet to lose a home conference game. Both are 6-0. Northern Arizona and North Dakota, who are both 6-4, both have five at home and five on the road to close out the season. Montana State sits at 5-4. The Bobcats have six games at home and five on the road remaining. Two of the last three years the team that led at the halfway point has gone on to win the regular-season title. Northern Colorado was 7-1 in 2010-11 and finished 13-3. Last year, Montana was 10-0 and finished 19-1. In 2011-12, Weber State was 7-1. WSU finished 14-2, but lost the regular-season title to Montana (15-1). The top seven teams advance to the tournament.

HORNET HYSTERIA: Sacramento State won home games over Idaho State and Weber State last week, earning national exposure along the way. Hornet junior Dylan Garrity buried a 70-foot shot as time expired to lift the Hornets to a 78-75 overtime win over first-place Weber State on Saturday. The shot was the top play on SportsCenter on Saturday night, and was also featured on several other national Web sites. Sacramento State snapped a 12-game losing streak to Weber State, and beat the Wildcats for the fifth time in 40 tries. Sacramento State has won back-to-back games for the first time this season. The Hornets finished the first half of conference play 4-6, but plays six of its final 10 at home. Sacramento State is looking to advanced to the conference tournament for the first time since 2005-06.

HARVEY HAMMERS 10 TREYS: Eastern Washington sophomore Tyler Harvey made 10 3-pointers en route to a career-high 38 points in the Eagles' 94-90 overtime home win over Northern Colorado on Saturday. Harvey's 10 3-pointers tied the school record and tied for the third-most in Big Sky history. EWU's Kevin Winford hit 10 3-pointers on Dec. 4, 2010 against New Hope Christian. Portland State's Brian Towne holds the Big Sky record with 12 treys against Idaho State on Feb. 7, 1998. NAU's Cory Schwab hit 11 on Dec. 2, 2000 against Cal Poly. Harvey was 10-of-15 from 3-point range. Harvey leads the Big Sky with 77 3-point field goals made. He is seventh in the nation in 3-pointers per game at 3.67, and 14th in points per game at 21.1.

FOUR STRAIGHT FOR PSU: Portland State beat EWU, NC and UND at home last week to hike its winning streak to four straight games. The Vikings have won six of their last seven to move into a tie for third place in the league standings at 6-4. PSU went 5-15 in conference last season. The Vikings have 11 wins this season, surpassing its win total of eight from a year ago. Junior guard Gary Winston was big in all three wins last week, averaging 16.7 points, 3.0 rebounds and 3. assists. He shot .643 percent from the floor and .600 percent from 3-point range. Portland State is 10-3 at the Stott Center this season. The Vikings have six of their final 10 on the road.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

100 CONFERENCE WINS FOR RAHE:

Weber State's Randy Rahe became the third coach in league history to win 100 conference games on Thursday as his Wildcats beat Northern Arizona 76-67. Rahe ranks third all-time in conference wins with 100, and is just two behind Boise State's Bobby Dye (102). Montana State's Mick Durham is the all-time leader with 123. Rahe is in his eighth season at Weber State. Dye coached at Boise State for 12 seasons. Durham was at Montana State for 16 seasons. Rahe has an overall record of 161-82. He ranks fifth on the all-time wins list, behind Durham (246), Dye (214), Neil McCarthy (200) and Mike Adras (187).

1,000 FOR UNRUH: Northern Colorado senior Tate Unruh scored his 1,000th career point on Thursday night in the Bears' loss to Portland State. Unruh enters this week with 1,012 career points. Unruh has made 205 career 3-pointers, which ranks 16th in league history.

RPI REPORT: Northern Colorado continues to lead Big Sky teams in the RPI. The Bears enter the week ranked 180th. Weber State is next at 188, followed by Montana at 224 and North Dakota at 245. The Big Sky is 27th among Division I conferences.

Tip-ins: Montana's Kareem Jamar enters the week with 1,457 career points. He needs just 43 to become the 32nd player in league history to score 1,500...Weber State enters this week having won 24 straight regular-season home conference game. The record is 26 by Montana. WSU has won 25 straight in a row over Big Sky teams at home, including postseason. UM won 31 straight at home over league teams including postseason games...WSU's Davion Berry has scored at least 23 points in six straight games..WSU's Joel Bolomboy has recorded at least 12 rebounds in five straight games Bolomboy ranks sixth in the nation in rebounds per game at 11.7...Northern Colorado is 11th in the nation in field-goal percentage...UND is 10th in steals per game and 11th in turnover margin...Sac State guard Dylan Garrity needs two assists to reach 400 for his career. He ranks 19th in league history...Northern Colorado is ranked 18th in this week's CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25...Monday's Montana-Montana State game is live on Altitude.
