Sacramento State broke its own Big Sky record in points scored in a game. The Hornets scored 111 points against Weber State. The old record of 110 was set against North Dakota.

Another Big Sky record set this past weekend was the combined point total of the two teams. Weber State had 104 points in the 111 loss to Sacramento State. The 215 record broke the 214 record set by SAC and North Dakota.

On Dec. 14th against UC Irvine, SAC set two other Big Sky records. The Hornets made 21 3-pointers and attempted 55. Both of those are records.

Southern Utah set a new Big Sky record in rebounds with 74. SUU did that on Dec. 16th against Arizona Christian.

## IDAHO STATE'S REED NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (February 3, 2014) - Idaho State's Lindsey Reed has been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week for the games played the week of Jan. 27-Feb. 2.

Reed, a senior from Kingman, Ariz., averaged 18.5 points, 10 rebounds and five assists to lead Idaho State to wins over Sacramento State and Northern Arizona.

On Thursday, the Bengals hosted the Hornets and Reed helped Idaho State hold Sacramento State to 37 points below their season average.

Reed was the key ball handler against the Hornets press and had just three turnovers for the game. The guard had a career-high 14 rebounds to go along with 14 points and four assists in the 62-53 win.

On Saturday, Reed had 23 points, six rebounds, six assists and a steal to help ISU defeat Northern Arizona 82-72.

# LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

**Melissa Williams, Eastern Washington** - Nobody came up bigger than Williams in Eastern's one-point road win at Northern Colorado on Saturday, Feb. 1. She scored the Eagles' last two points of the game, converting inside to give EWU a lead it would never relinquish, securing the come-from-behind victory. She also pulled down a game-high 10 rebounds, just the second time this season an EWU player grabbed at least 10 boards. Williams finished with six points and three assists against the Bears. On Thursday at North Dakota, she tallied two points, three rebounds and a blocked shot.

**Torry Hill, Montana** - Hill scored 19 points, one off her career high, and added a game-high five assists as Montana defeated Southern Utah 81-73 Saturday afternoon in the only game of the week for the Lady Griz... Hill had just two points at the half as Montana trailed 35-33, but she hit three 3-pointers in the opening three minutes of second half to rally the Lady Griz. Hill went 5 for 7 from 3-point range in the second half. The five 3-pointers were a career high...Hill also grabbed four rebounds, and she helped Montana to a 45.6 percent shooting performance, the team's best effort since Jan. 11.

**Mia Loyd, North Dakota** - Loyd helped UND improve to 9-2 in the Big Sky Conference with a pair of lopsided home wins this week. Loyd came back from a two-game absence due to injury to average 19 points and seven rebounds with just two total turnovers...In her first game back on Thursday, Loyd came off the bench to score a team-high 16 points while adding eight rebounds in an 82-60 win over Eastern Washington. She returned to the starting lineup on Saturday and contributed 22 points, six rebounds, an assist and a steal in a 69-42 defeat of Portland State...For the season, Loyd is fifth in the league in scoring at 15 per game and tops the conference with her 9.7 rebounds per contest.

**Erikka Banks, Northern Arizona** - Banks averaged 19.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 1.0 steals per game this weekend as NAU split its road trip to Weber State and Idaho State. In the Lumberjacks' 96-87 victory over Weber State on Thursday, Banks was one of six players in double-figures as she finished with 11 points and seven rebounds. She followed that up with 27 points and five rebounds in NAU's 82-72 loss at Idaho State on Saturday. The 27 points were one shy of Banks' career-high set earlier this season and she shot 7-for-10 from the field. She also shot 12-for-14 from the free-throw line, setting a new career-best in free throws made. Banks knocked down a pair of three-pointers after knocking down just four triples all season prior to the weekend. She shot .688 combined in two games from the field and .875 from the free-throw line.

**Gigi Hascheff, Sacramento State** - Hascheff scored a career-high 27 points to help Sacramento State break the Big Sky scoring record in its 111-104 win at Weber State. For the week she averaged 15.0 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists, and 2.5 steals per game while shooting 41.7%...Against the Wildcats Hascheff shot 9-of-18 from the field and hit five 3-pointers while shooting 4-of-4 from the free throw line. She added six rebounds, with five coming on the offensive glass, along with five steals and two assists in a team-high 32 minutes played. On Thursday in the Hornets loss at Idaho State Hascheff totaled three points, three rebounds, and a team-high three assists...Hascheff went 6-of-16 (.375) from 3-point range for the week and had just four turnovers in 55 total minutes played.

**Hailey Mandelko, Southern Utah** - Mandelko averaged 24.5 points per game to help Southern Utah earn a split on its trip to Montana last week. The Lexington, Neb. native scored 22 points to help SUU take a comeback win at Montana State on Thursday, then matched her career-high two days later with 27 points against Montana. The Thunderbirds and Bobcats were level at 75-75 late in the game, but two threes by Mandelko in the final three minutes helped her team come out on top. She went 9-18 from 3-point range for the week as well as 59.2 from the field overall...Mandelko recorded five steals and a pair of assists against the Grizzlies while collecting a total of five rebounds over the two-game stretch. She currently leads SUU in scoring with 13.9 ppg in Big Sky play and is averaging 2.2 3-point field goals per contest.

**Kalie Matthews, Weber State** - Matthews scored 22 points and pulled in 15 rebounds in the Wildcats loss to Sacramento State on Saturday. Matthews was a perfect 9-for-9 from the field in the game. Matthews had 7 points and 5 rebounds against NAU on Thursday.
