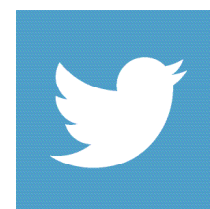

## ROOT SPORTS Players of the Week Sept. 22

### OFFENSE - Quincy Forte, RB, Eastern Washington



Forte, a 5-foot-11, 200-pound senior from Fairfield, Calif., rushed 17 times for 190 yards and scored four touchdowns in No. 2 Eastern Washington's 52-51 road victory over No. 14 Montana State. Forte averaged 11.2 yards per carry. On his second carry, he scored on a 76-yard run. He also added scoring runs of 33, 7 and 4 yards. Forte also had one catch for 9 yards. This is Forte's first career Player of the Week honor.

### DEFENSE - Alex Tillman, CB, North Dakota



Tillman, a 5-10, 190-pound senior from Houston, Texas, registered the first interception of the season for North Dakota and returned it 92 yards for a touchdown in a 13-3 victory over Stony Brook. With North Dakota holding a 6-3 lead late in the third quarter, Stony Brook drove to the North Dakota 7-yard line. Tillman stepped in front of a John Kinder pass, evaded Kinder at midfield and went untouched the rest of the way. It was the longest interception return in North Dakota's Division I history, and longest in school history since 1998. He

also had five tackles and a key pass breakup. This is Tillman's first career Player of the Week honor.

### SPECIAL TEAMS - Shawn Johnson, Ret., Montana State



Johnson, a 5-10, 180-pound senior from Bakersfield, Calif., amassed a school-record 374 all-purpose yards with three touchdowns in Montana State's 52-51 loss to Eastern Washington. Johnson had 141 kick return yards on four returns with a long of 49. He also had 21 punt return yards, 150 rushing yards, and 62 receiving yards. He caught two TD passes and scored on a 70-yard run. Johnson's 374 all-

purpose yards were the sixth-most in single-game Big Sky history. This is Johnson's fourth career Player of the Week honor.

## AROUND THE BIG SKY

**THRILLER IN BOZEMAN:** Eastern Washington won its 12th straight game over a Big Sky opponent in thrilling fashion, beating Montana State 52-51 last Saturday in Bozeman. It was a non-conference game between the long-time rivals. Montana State took a 51-44 lead with 1:55 to play when Dakota Prukop threw a 9-yard TD pass to Shawn Johnson. Eastern Washington drove 75 yards in nine plays in 1:28. The drive featured a 40-yard pass from Vernon Adams Jr. to Kendrick Bourne on a fourth-and-10. Mario Brown scored on a 1-yard run with 27 seconds left. Adams Jr. ran in a 2-point conversion for the game-winning points. The teams combined for 1,129 yards of total offense. Prukop threw for 248 yards with four touchdowns and no interceptions. He also rushed for 68 yards and a touchdown. Quincy Forte rushed for 190 yards and four touchdowns to lead EWU. Cooper Kupp caught nine passes for 152 yards and two touchdowns, hiking his career touchdown total to 27. MSU's Tanner Roderick had five catches for 122 yards and two touchdowns. MSU led 23-14 after the first quarter, and 44-30 late in the third quarter. Since 2010, EWU has won 14 games when trailing or tied in the fourth quarter.

**ADAMS INCHES CLOSER:** Eastern Washington's Vernon Adams, Jr was held to a season-low two touchdown passes in the win over Montana State. Adams Jr. now has 93 career touchdown passes, just five shy of tying the Big Sky all-time record of 98 held by Weber State's Cameron Higgins. Adams and the Eagles take on UC Davis on Saturday. Adams Jr. is fifth on the Big Sky's all-time list for passing touchdowns, one behind former Northern Arizona great Jason Murrietta. Adams threw for 358 yards in the win over Montana State, hiking his career total to 8,455 yards. It was his 15th career 300-yard passing game. Adams has thrown for at least 300 yards in six straight games dating back to last season.

**HORNETS' HOT START:** Sacramento State moved to 3-1 with a 59-14 home win over Menlo on Saturday. It marks the first time since 1999 that a Hornet team has won three of their first four games. Jody Sears, Sacramento State's interim head coach, is just the second coach in school history to start his career 3-1. Sears joins John Baker (1957) as the only Hornet coaches to start 3-1. Eight different Sacramento State players scored touchdowns in the win over Menlo. The 59 points scored were the ninth-most in school history. Sacramento State forced five turnovers and intercepted four passes. The four pass interceptions tied the FCS-era school record. Sacramento State hasn't started a season 4-1 since 1992. The Hornets are at Idaho State on Saturday. Sears went 2-0 against Idaho State in 2012 and 2013 when he was the head coach at Weber State

**BEARS, GRIZZLIES ON ROOT SPORTS:** ROOT SPORTS will televise Saturday's Northern Colorado-Montana game from Washington-Grizzly Stadium. Coverage begins on ROOT SPORTS and DIRECTV's Audience Network at 1:30 p.m. Mountain. Montana brings a 2-2 record into the game. The Grizzlies are 2-0 at home. Northern Colorado is 1-2. The Bears are 0-2 on the road. Tom Glasgow, Jason Stiles and Jen Mueller will call the game. The game will not be video streamed.

## AROUND THE BIG SKY

**JOHNSON AN ALL-AROUND GREAT GUY:** Montana State senior running back Shawn Johnson amassed 374 all-purpose yards and three in the Bobcats' 52-51 loss to Eastern Washington. Johnson rushed for 150 yards on 14 carries, scoring on a 70-yard run. He caught three passes for 62 yards and two touchdowns, and 141 kick return yards and 21 punt return yards. Johnson's 374 yards ranks sixth in Big Sky single-game history, and the most ever by a Bobcat. Michael Jefferson previously held the school record with 305 all-purpose yards in a 2006 game against Idaho State. Johnson's 150 rushing yards were a career-high. Johnson now has 3,519 career all-purpose yards, which ranks fourth in school history. Johnson was named the National Offensive Player of the Week by The Sports Network.

**KEHANO CATCHING ON:** After missing most of the past two seasons with injuries, Weber State senior wide receiver Shaydon Kehano is off to a monster start. Kehano ranks second in the nation with an average of 9.5 catches per game. Kehano had a career-high 12 catches for 122 yards with two touchdowns in a 35-20 loss last Saturday to Stephen F. Austin. The 12 catches were the most by a Big Sky player this season. He became the first Wildcat with 12 catches in a game since 1996. Kehano has 38 catches for 393 yards and four touchdowns through four games. He also became the 23rd player in school history to amass 100 career receptions.

**IN THE SAGARIN:** The Big Sky remained fourth among FCS conferences in this week's Sagarin Ratings. The Missouri Valley is No. 1, followed by the CAA and the Ohio Valley. Eastern Washington is ranked fourth among FCS teams and 77th overall. Montana is 10th among FCS teams, followed by Montana State (17th) and Cal Poly (23rd). North Dakota State is the No. 1 FCS team and ranked 43rd overall. South Dakota State is second and Villanova is third.

**WALSH FOURTH ON WINS LIST:** Cal Poly head coach Tim Walsh won his 81st game while coaching in the Big Sky last Saturday as his Mustangs beat his former team Portland State 42-14. Walsh now has 81 career victories, moving him into sole possession of fourth place on the all-time win list. Walsh was tied with former Montana coach Bobby Hauck at 80. Walsh was a head coach in the Big Sky at Portland State from 1996-2006. Cal Poly is in its third season in the Big Sky. Nevada's Chris Ault (111) is first, followed by Northern Arizona's Jerome Souers (95), UM's Don Read (85), and Idaho State's Mike Kramer (84). Walsh and Kramer are currently tied for third place with 55 conference wins. Ault is the leader with 68, followed by Souers with 62. Walsh is 6-0 in home openers at Cal Poly.

**IN THE POLLS:** Eastern Washington remained second in both major polls following its 52-51 win over Montana State. The Eagles earned nine first-place votes in The Sports Network poll and 3,819 total points. Montana dropped from fourth to seventh in the Sports Network Poll. Montana State improved one spot to 13. Northern Arizona earned 145 points, but dropped out of the top 25. Sacramento State (17) and Cal Poly (2) also earned votes. In the Coaches' Poll, Eastern Washington earned 623 points. Montana dropped from third to sixth. Montana State dropped from 16th to 17th, and NAU dropped out of the poll. NAU, Sacramento State and Cal Poly earned votes.

**Extra points:** Cal Poly rushed for 470 yards in its win over Portland State...Northern Arizona safety Eddie Horn, a JC transfer, had a career-high 14 tackles in the Lumberjacks' loss to South Dakota. Horn leads the team with 34 tackles and two interceptions... Defensive tackle Lexington Smith had three tackles for loss in Northern Colorado's loss to Northern Iowa...Southern Utah QB Aamon Olsen, a BYU transfer, started his first game against Fresno State. He threw for 309 yards and two touchdowns in the loss... Jeremiah Kose recorded 16 tackles in Montana's 22-10 loss to NDSU. NDSU scored just one offensive touchdown, but made five field goals...The Big Sky went 0-17 this season against FBS teams, marking the first time since 2010 the league failed to beat an FBS squad. It was also the last year a Big Sky team won a national championship...Just two non-conference games remain on the regular-season schedule. Idaho State plays Simon Fraser on Oct. 11. Cal Poly closes on Nov. 22 against San Diego.
