North Dakota looks to move to 3-0 at home...Northern Arizona, which earned an exciting last-minute win over Cal Poly in its conference opener, travels to Northern Colorado...In a game that will be televised live by ROOT SPORTS, Portland State plays host to UC Davis. It's the conference opener for the Vikings, who are coming off an open week...Cal Poly guns for its first league victory as it plays host to Southern Utah. The Thunderbirds notched their first win of the season last week, downing Weber State...The Wildcats have a bye week...Five of this week's games will be on Watch Big Sky. 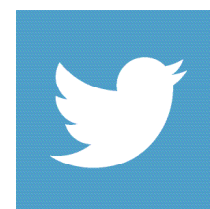

ROOT SPORTS Players of the Week Sept. 29

OFFENSE - Justin Arias, QB, Idaho State



Arias, a 6-foot, 213-pound senior from Agoura Hills, Calif., completed 30-of-42 passes for 413 yards and two touchdowns in Idaho State's 44-24 victory over Sacramento State. Arias connected with Broc Malcom on a 19-yard score in the second quarter, and an 11-yard score to Madison Magnum in the fourth quarter to put the Bengals ahead 37-17. Arias guided an offense that rolled up 639 yards of offense.

DEFENSE - Chinedu Ahanonu, LB, Southern Utah



Chinedu Ahanonu, a 5-11, 240-pound sophomore from West Jordan, Utah, tallied 10 tackles, intercepted a pass and recovered a fumble in Southern Utah's 31-28 victory over Weber State. Ahanonu recorded six solo tackles and was credited with two tackles for loss. He intercepted a pass in the first quarter that led to a Southern Utah touchdown, and recovered a fumble on the 2-yard line late in the fourth quarter that halted a potential go-ahead touchdown by the Wildcats. This Ahanonu's first career Player of the Week honor.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Luke Daly, K, Montana State



Daly, a 6-2, 180-pound freshman from Billings, Mont., made three field goals in Montana State's 28-19 win over North Dakota on a windy day at Bobcat Stadium in Bozeman. Daly connected on kicks from 34, 38 and 32 yards. Daly also made two extra points, and four of his seven kickoffs went for touchbacks. Daly is 8-of-10 on field goals this season, and hasn't missed from inside of 40-yards. This is Daly's first Player of the Week honor.

Adams now ranks fourth in league history, and is just one behind former EWU QB Matt Nichols and former Montana QB Dave Dickenson. Adams needs just three to tie former Weber State QB Cameron Higgins for the all-time conference record. Adams is five TD passes away from becoming the 14th player in FCS history to pass for 100 scores. Grambling's Bruce Eugene is the all-time leader with 140. Adams enters Saturday's game against Idaho State with 9,824 yards of total offense, just 176 shy of the 10,000-yard barrier. He currently has 8,758 passing yards. Adams leads the nation in passing yards per game at 361.6 passing yards, total offense (385.4 ypg), passing TDs (20), points responsible for per game (25.6), and is second in pass efficiency (176). Adams threw five touchdown passes in a win over Idaho State last season.

ASH, BALDWIN REACH MILESTONE: Montana State's Rob Ash and Eastern Washington's Beau Baldwin each recorded their 60th career win while coaching in the Big Sky last Saturday. The two became the seventh and eighth coaches respectively to reach the 60-win plateau. Ash is 60-29 in his eighth season with the Bobcats. He has an overall coaching record of 236-128-5 in his 35th season as a head coach. Ash was previously at Drake and Juniata. Baldwin is 60-23 in his seventh season with the Eagles. He has an overall coaching record of 70-26 in eight seasons with a one-year stint at Central Washington. Of the eight coaches in league history with 60 wins, five are currently coaching in the league. Northern Arizona's Jerome Souers ranks second in all-time wins with 96. Idaho State coach Mike Kramer moved into a tie for third place last Saturday, earning his 85th career win. Cal Poly coach Tim Walsh is fifth on the all-time list with 81. Former Nevada coach and college football Hall of Famer Chris Ault is the all-time leader with 111. Kramer is tied with former Montana coach Don Read with 85. Former Montana coach Bobby Hauck is sixth on the list with 80.

A LOOK AT ATTENDANCE: Montana currently leads the FCS in average attendance at 25,423 fans per game. Montana State is fourth with an average of 18,955. Weber State ranks 14th thanks to a crowd of 14,577 in its own home game. Northern Arizona is 31st with an average of 10,525. The Lumberjacks drew 11,545 in last week's win over Cal Poly. The Skydome currently seats 10,000. Eastern Washington, Montana State, Montana and Northern Arizona are all averaging more than the listed capacities at their respective stadiums.

CALL IT A STREAK: For just the fourth time since 2004, Idaho State has picked up back-to-back wins. The Bengals beat Sacramento State 44-24 at Holt Arena to improve to 2-2. Idaho State notched back-to-back wins over Division II teams in 2013. The Bengals also had back-to-back wins in 2011 and 2005. Idaho State is seeking its first three-game winning streak since 2003 when it travels to Eastern Washington on Saturday. Idaho State rolled up 693 yards of offense against Sacramento State, the second-most by a Bengal team since 2004. It was ISU's first homecoming win since 2007.

LATE HEROICS IN FLAGSTAFF: Northern Arizona edged Cal Poly 38-35 last Saturday in front of a standing-room only crowd of 11,545. The Lumberjacks scored the game-winning touchdown with 21 seconds to play when Chase Cartwright threw a 12-yard TD pass to Casey Jahn on fourth down. NAU drove 71 yards on 10 plays in 1:15 for the game-winning drive. Cartwright threw for 279 yards and four touchdowns. Jahn had 103 receiving yards and 61 receiving yards. Ify Umodu hauled in a pair of third-quarter TD passes for the Lumberjacks. Northern Arizona retired the No. 9 of former great Archie Amerson, the 1996 Walter Payton Award winner.

VIKINGS, AGGIES ON ROOT SPORTS: Saturday's conference game between Portland State and UC Davis will be televised live on ROOT SPORTS and DIRECTV's Audience Network. Portland State is coming off a bye. This is the conference opener for the Vikings. UC Davis opened conference with a 37-14 loss to Eastern Washington. Tom Glasgow, Jason Stiles and Brad Adam will call the game from Providence Park.

IN THE RANKINGS: Three Big Sky teams are ranked in this week's Sports Network Top 25, while four are ranked in the FCS Coaches' Poll. In the Sports Network Poll, Eastern Washington remained second, Montana stayed at seventh, and Montana State remained 13th. Northern Arizona received the third-most votes of teams not in the top 25. In the Coaches' Poll, Eastern Washington checked at No. 2 behind North Dakota State. Montana slipped a spot seventh, and Montana State rose two spots to 15th. Northern Arizona returned to the Coaches' Poll, checking in at 25.

IN THE SAGARIN: The Big Sky Conference remained fourth among FCS conferences in this week's Sagarin Ratings. The Big Sky trails the Missouri Valley, CAA and Southland Conferences. Eastern Washington is ranked fourth among FCS teams and 77th overall. Montana is 12th among FCS teams, followed by Montana State (20th) and Cal Poly (24th).

Extra points: Montana State senior wide receiver Brian Flotkoetter's career has ended, the school announced. Flotkoetter, who finished his career with 75 catches for 1,014 yards and six touchdowns, will undergo shoulder surgery... Montana scored 28 first-quarter points in a 38-13 win over Northern Colorado... The Bears played without starting QB Sean Rubalcaba, who was a late scratch with a shoulder injury. Backup Brock Berglund was also hurt, leaving junior Jonathan Newsom to go the distance...Northern Colorado ranks second in the nation with 11 interceptions...Montana State honored the 1984 National Championship team last Saturday by wearing throwback uniforms...North Dakota linebacker Will Ratelle returned a fumble 21 yards for a touchdown in the loss to MSU. Ratelle leads the team with 56 total tackles...Weber State's Billy Green threw for 341 yards and three touchdowns in a loss to Southern Utah...UC Davis held Eastern Washington to nine first-half points in a 37-14 loss. EWU had scored 106 points in the first half in its first four games...Sacramento State's DeAndre Carter had 14 catches for 158 yards and three touchdowns in a loss to Idaho State. The 14 catches were one shy of the single-game school record... Southern Utah's James Cowser had 1.5 sacks and 3.5 tackles for loss in the win vs. Weber State. Cowser leads the nation with 14.5 tackles for loss...Montana's Zack Wagenmann tallied a sack and a forced fumble against UNC. Wagenmann leads the Big Sky and is tied for third in the nation with seven sacks...Cal Poly's Nick Dzubnar recorded 13 tackles in the loss to NAU. He has recorded at least 10 tackles in all four games this season...Home teams went 5-1 the opening week of conference play. Big Sky teams are now 4-31 in road games. Eastern Washington has won twice on the road. Sacramento State and Northern Arizona each have one road win...EWU's Cooper Kupp caught his 28th career TD pass in the win over UC Davis. The sophomore has caught at least one TD in all four of his games this season, and 18 of 19 in his career...Cal Poly QB Chris Brown has rushed for two touchdowns in each of the past three games.
