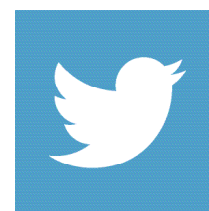

ROOT SPORTS Players of the Week Sept. 8

OFFENSE - Vernon Adams Jr., QB, Eastern Washington



Adams, a 6-foot, 200-pound junior from Pasadena, Calif., threw for a career-high 475 yards and seven touchdown passes in No. 2 Eastern Washington's 59-52 loss to Washington of the Pac-12. Adams completed 31-of-46 passes. His 475 passing yards were the second-most in school single-game history. His seven TD passes surpassed his previous single-game high of six. Adams helped the Eagles rally from a 21-0 first-quarter deficit. The Eagles led twice in the second half. Adams finished with 491 yards of total offense. The reigning Big Sky Offensive MVP hiked his career passing touchdown total to 91, just seven shy of the all-time Big Sky record. This is Adams' second straight Player of the Week honor and the eighth of his career.

DEFENSE - Courtney Hall, CB, Northern Colorado



Hall, a 5-8, 168-pound senior from Pompano Beach, Fla, recorded four tackles and intercepted two passes in Northern Colorado's 13-12 loss to UNLV of the Mountain West Conference. Hall intercepted a UNLV pass in the first half, and nearly made game-winning interception late in the game when he stepped in front of a pass in the end zone with less than 10 seconds to play. Hall advanced the ball to the 15-yard line before he was tripped up. Hall helped the Northern Colorado defense hold UNLV to just 121 passing yards. The Bears picked off three passes. This is Hall's first career Player of the Week honor.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Spencer Cummings, North Dakota



Cummings, a 6-foot-4, 280-pound senior from Hugo, Minn., blocked two second-half field goal attempts by Robert Morris to help preserve a 16-13 victory over the Colonials on Saturday. Cummings' first block came on RMU's ensuing drive after UND went ahead 16-13 midway through the third quarter. His second block and third of the night for UND's special teams came late in the fourth quarter. Cummings also had three tackles from his defensive end position. This is his first career Player of the Week honor.

VA SHINES IN SEATTLE: For the second straight year, Eastern Washington's Vernon Adams Jr. put up huge numbers against a Pac-12 team. Unlike last year, however, Adams Jr. could not lead the Eagles to an upset. Despite 475 passing yards and seven touchdowns, the Eagles fell to Washington 59-52. Adams Jr. completed 31-of-46 passes with no interceptions. His 475 passing yards were the second-most in school history. His seven TD passes set a single-game school record. Adams Jr. has now completed 54-of-76 passes for 886 yards with 11 touchdowns and no interceptions in two games against Pac-12 opponents. In last year's 49-46 upset of Oregon State, he amassed a school-record 518 yards of total offense. Adams is the active FCS leader in yards passing with 8,097 and in total offense with 9,129 yards. Adams has now thrown 91 career touchdown passes, which is tied for fifth-most in league history. He's just seven behind the all-time leader Cameron Higgins of Weber State. His 91 TD passes currently rank tied for 21st all-time in FCS history. Bruce Eugene of Grambling St. holds the all-time record with 140. Houston's Case Kennum holds the all-time Division I record with 155. Adams Jr. has played just 30 career games. Dating back to his six-touchdown effort in the 2012 semifinal against Sam Houston State, Adams Jr., has thrown 77 touchdown passes in his last 19 games. Adams has rushed for five touchdowns his in career, making his responsible for 96 touchdowns, which already ranks seventh in Big Sky single-season history. Dave Dickenson of Montana is the current Big Sky career leader with 116. Adams Jr. has thrown for at least 300 yards 15 times in his career. The Walter Payton Award candidate has thrown 16 touchdown passes with just one interception this season. He leads the nation in total offense, passing yards per game, and ranks fourth in pass efficiency. Adams was named the National Co-Player of the Week by The Sports Network, as well as a Weekly All-Star by College Sporting News.

HEAD TURNERS: Neither Weber State or Northern Colorado picked up victories last Saturday, but the results were encouraging. Weber State, which won two games last season, fell at home to No. 1 North Dakota State 24-7. The Wildcats trailed 14-7 at the half, and held the Bison run game to just 177 total yards. Weber State's defense intercepted two passes. A crowd of 14,577 - the largest at a Wildcat home game since 2005 - was on hand to watch a very competitive game. Weber State QB Billy Green completed 26-of-43 passes for 240 yards with no interceptions. Twice Weber State failed to score inside the NDSU 3-yard line...Northern Colorado nearly ended its 11-game losing streak with an upset of UNLV of the Mountain West. The Rebels held on for a 13-12 victory. Northern Colorado missed a 23-yard field goal with 5:01 to play. Northern Colorado intercepted four passes, and held UNLV's passing game to just 121 passing yards. Sean Rubalcaba completed 16-of-21 passes for 189 yards with no interceptions in his first start for the Bears. Robert Holland rushed 23 times for 98 yards and scored on a 3-yard run to tie the game 10-10 in the third quarter. Northern Colorado has possession on offense for more than 33 minutes.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

VAN-A-GONE: Montana's Travon Van touched the ball on offense just six times in Montana's 48-14 home win over Central Washington. He made the most of those touches, scoring four touchdowns. Van scored on runs of 31, 9 and 43. He also caught an 85-yard touchdown pass. Montana played without starting QB Jordan Johnson, who was out with an injury. Backup Shay Smithwick-Hann completed 10-of-16 passes for 145 yards and a touchdown.

BOBCATS CRUISE: Montana State moved to 8-0 in home openers with a 57-10 win over Black Hills State. Sophomore QB Dakota Prukop, making his second career start, had a big day through the air on the ground. Prukop rushed 13 times for 176 yards and scored on runs of 60, 57 and 6 yards. He also completed 14-of-16 passes for 202 yards and two touchdowns. Montana State amassed 652 yards of total offense.

BUBBA'S FIRST WIN: North Dakota edged Robert Morris of the Northeast Conference 16-13 on Saturday night to give first-year head coach Bubba Schweigert his first victory. North Dakota freshman Reid Taubenheim made field goals of 20, 45 and 35 yards. North Dakota blocked three kicks, including two field goals in the second half. North Dakota has now won 28 consecutive home openers.

IN THE POLLS: Four Big Sky teams are ranked in this week's Sports Network Top 25, while three are ranked in the Coaches' Top 25. Eastern Washington is second in both polls, behind three-time defending national champion North Dakota State. Montana is fourth in both polls. Montana State is ranked 17th in the Sports Network poll, and 18th by the coaches. Northern Arizona is ranked 24th in the Sports Network poll. Southern Utah, Sacramento State, and Cal Poly received votes in the Sports Network Poll. Northern Arizona earned votes in the Coaches' Poll.

IN THE SAGARIN: Montana is the top Big Sky team in this week's Sagarin Ratings. The Grizzlies are ranked seventh in the FCS and 74th overall. Eastern Washington is 10th among FCS teams. Montana State (17), Northern Arizona (25) and Portland State (131) also rank in the top 30. The Big Sky is ranked fourth among FCS conferences behind the Missouri Valley, Ohio Valley and CAA.

ROAD WARRIORS: Northern Arizona picked up its first road win of the season, downing Abilene Christian 27-21 last Saturday. NAU is now 10-4 in road games dating back to the start of the 2012 season. Three of Northern Arizona's road losses have come to FBS teams (Arizona, Arizona State and San Diego State).

Extra points: Cal Poly's Nick Dzubnar tallied a career-high 19 tackles in a loss to South Dakota State. Mustang QB Chris Brown threw for a career-high 202 yards in the loss...Idaho State's Mario Jenkins, a redshirt freshman, recorded a career-high 16 tackles with an interception in a loss to Utah State. The Bengals and Aggies...Eastern Washington's Cooper Kupp hauled in three TD passes in the loss to Washington. Kupp now has 25 TD catches in 17 games. The Big Sky career record for receiving TDs is 46 by EWU's Eric Kimble...James Cowser, a Buck Buchanan Award candidate, recorded 11 tackles - 3.5 for loss - with a sack in Southern Utah's loss to Southeastern Louisiana...Sacramento State's Garrett Safron scored on a 73-yard run in a loss to Cal. It was the longest scoring run by a Hornet since 2004 when Ryan Mole scored on an 87-yard run against Northern Arizona...Sacramento State LB Darnell Sankey recorded a career-high 15 tackles against Cal...PSU's Shaquille Richard rushed 14 times for a career-high 151 yards and a touchdown in a 45-38 win over Western Oregon.
