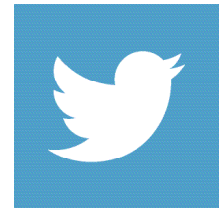



PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MIKH MCKINNEY, SR., G, SACRAMENTO STATE



McKinney, a 6-1, senior guard from Union City, Calif., averaged 28.5 points, six assists, two rebounds and a steal per game as the Hornets beat Idaho State and Weber State on the road. McKinney shot .621 percent from the floor, .615 from 3-point range, and .765 percent from the free-throw line. He committed just one turnover in 78 minutes of action.

McKinney opened with 24 points, five assists, three rebounds and a steal in the Hornets' 62-59 win over Idaho State on Thursday. On Saturday, McKinney scored a career-high 33 points - 27 in the second half - with seven assists, no turnovers, a rebound and a block in Sacramento State's 78-71 win over Weber State. McKinney was 5-of-5 from 3-point range in the second half. He made 8-of-10 free throws, and was 10-of-16 from the field. It marked just the second time Sacramento State has beaten Weber State in Ogden. McKinney scored 41 of his 57 points in the second half of the two games.

TYLER HARVEY, SR., G, EASTERN WASHINGTON



Harvey, a 6-foot-4, junior guard from Torrence, Calif., averaged 30.5 points, 3.5 assists, 3.5 rebounds and one steal per game as the Eagles beat Northern Colorado and North Dakota. Harvey shot .593 percent from the floor, .467 percent from 3-point range, and .880 from the free-throw line.

Harvey opened with a 35-point game in the Eagles' 95-85 win over Northern Colorado on Thursday. Harvey was 9-of-15 from the floor, 5-of-9 from 3-point range, and 12-of-14 from the free-throw line. In Saturday's 102-80 win over North Dakota, Harvey scored 26 points with five rebounds and five assists. He made 7-of-12 shots from the floor and was 10-of-11 from the free-throw line.

THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

The final weekend of January features 10 games, and the schedule features the first return conference games of the season...League-leading Sacramento State (7-1) returns home to The Nest where they are 8-1 at home this season to face Montana State on Thursday and Montana on Saturday...Montana (6-1) enters the week riding a five-game winning streak. The Grizzlies are at Portland State on Thursday...Eastern Washington will play host to Idaho on Saturday. The Eagles (6-1) beat the Vandals by three earlier this month in Moscow... North Dakota returns home to face Weber State on Thursday and Idaho State on Saturday. Weber State is looking to snap three-game losing streak...Northern Colorado, which is 7-1 at home this season, takes on Idaho State in Greeley on Thursday before Weber comes to town...Montana State is at Portland State on Thursday...Northern Arizona treks to Southern Utah on Saturday. The Lumberjacks beat the Thunderbirds by three on Jan. 10 in Flagstaff.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

THREE-TEAM RACE?: History suggests that Sacramento State, Eastern Washington and Montana will be in the Big Sky regular-season title. All three currently have one league loss. Sacramento State has played eight conference games, while Montana and Eastern Washington have played seven. In each of the last six years, the regular-season champion has been 7-1 or 8-0 after eight conference games. Weber State in 2006-07 was the last team to have three losses after eight games and still win the regular-season title. Portland State in 2004-05 and 2007-08 won the league title with a 6-2 mark through eight games.

HORNETS SWEEP ISU, WSU: Sacramento State swept the Idaho State, Weber State road trip for the first time since the 2005-06 season. The Hornets edged Idaho State 62-59 on Thursday and then topped Weber State 78-71 in Ogden. It marked just the second time Sacramento State has beaten the Wildcats at the Dee Events Center. Sacramento State entered 1-20 all-time vs. Weber State on the road. The road sweep was Sacramento State's first in Big Sky play since Feb. 2-4 2012 when the Hornets beat Northern Colorado and Eastern Washington. Sacramento State's 7-1 start in conference is the best for the program, which joined the league in 1996-97. Sacramento State is 13-6, which matches the program's best mark after 19 games in its Division I era, which started in 1991. Its 2005-06 team was also 13-6.

DOING IT WITH DEFENSE: Montana first-year coach Travis DeCuire has the Grizzlies off to a 6-1 conference start. UM was picked fifth by the media and eighth by the coaches in the preseason polls. Montana is allowing just 57.7 point per game in conference. Opponents are shooting .404 percent from the floor and .281 percent from 3-point range. All three lead the Big Sky. the Grizzlies are also +2.9 in rebounding margin at 2.9 and second in steals (7.0 per game). Montana has played five of its first seven conference games at home. The Grizzlies now play four of six on the road.

EAGLES REACH 15: Eastern Washington's wins over Northern Colorado and North Dakota pushed the Eagles' record to 15-5. EWU has not won more than 15 games in a season since 2003-04, the last time the program won the Big Sky and went to the NCAA Tournament. EWU won 15 games in 2005-06, 2006-07, and 2011-12, and last season. Since joining the Big Sky in 1987-88, the Eagles have not won more than 18 games in a season. EWU's 6-1 start in conference matches its best start in Big Sky play.

MCKINNEY, HARVEY NAMED TO WATCH LIST: Eastern Washington junior Tyler Harvey and Sacramento State senior Mikh McKinney have been named to the Lou Henson Mid-Season Award Watch List, CollegelInsider.com announced Wednesday. The Lou Henson Award is presented annually to the Division I "Mid-Major" Player of the Year. The 2015 recipient will be announced at the CollegelInsider.com Awards Banquet on April 3 in Indianapolis, site of the 2015 men's NCAA Basketball Championship.
