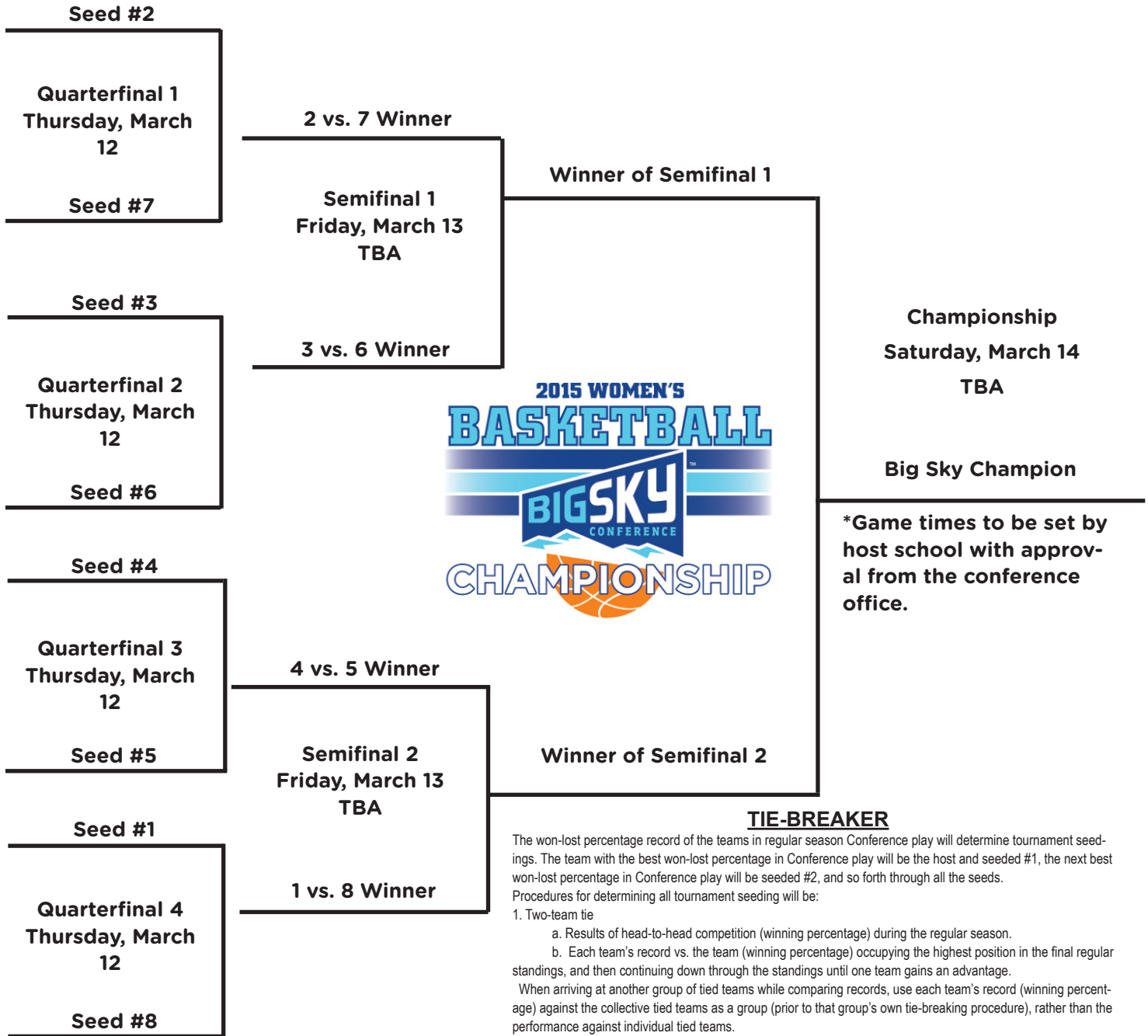

TIE-BREAKER

The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be the host and seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

Procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

1. Two-team tie
 - a. Results of head-to-head competition (winning percentage) during the regular season.
 - b. Each team's record vs. the team (winning percentage) occupying the highest position in the final regular standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

 - c. RPI Rankings
 - d. Coin toss conducted by the _____ Commissioner or designee.
2. Multiple-team tie
 - a. Results of collective head-to-head competition (winning percentage) during the regular season among the tied teams.
 - b. If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (winning percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

UND's LOYD NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

North Dakota's Mia Loyd was named the Big Sky Conference women's basketball player of the week for the fourth time this season after leading her team to two wins last week.

Loyd, a junior forward from Minneapolis, Minn., averaged 19.5 points and 9.5 rebounds in two home wins this week. In Thursday's 67-52 win over Southern Utah, she posted 16 points and 12 rebounds to earn her 14th double-double of the season.

On Saturday, Loyd hit 9-of-11 from the field (81 percent) on her way to a 23-point performance in UND's 78-62 win over Northern Arizona.

Loyd leads the Big Sky Conference in double-doubles with 14, five more than the second-place player. She also holds the top spot in rebounding in the conference with 9.8 boards per game. Loyd is second in the Big Sky in field goal percentage (.555) and fourth in scoring with 16.3 points per game.

UND holds a 16-7 record overall with an 8-3 conference mark. The Green and White are 9-1 at home this season and 24-2 in Grand Forks, N.D., over the past two years.

North Dakota will travel to Missoula, Mont., to take on the Big Sky leader, Montana, on Thursday. UND defeated the Lady Griz 59-52 on January 3, at home in the two teams' first meeting.

Last Week's Top Performers

Jade Redmon (EWU) - Redmon averaged 17.5 points per game on 66.7 percent shooting from the field and 81.8 percent from the free throw line over the two games to go along with averages of 6.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.5 steals. Against Big Sky-leading Montana on Thursday, she continued her streak of scoring in double figures with 13 points on 5-of-9 shooting, adding seven rebounds and five assists while committing just two turnovers in 32 minutes. Against Montana State on Saturday, she went for a game-high-tying 22 points on just nine shots while playing 30 minutes. She finished 7-of-9 from the field and a perfect 2-of-2 from three-point range, and made all six of her free throw attempts. She pulled down five rebounds and registered a pair of assists and two steals to complete her impressive display. She has now scored in double figures in Eastern's last five games, and eight of its last nine. She is averaging 13.4 points per game in Big Sky play while shooting 56.8 percent from the field, the third-highest percentage among conference players.

Stacey Barr (UI) - Senior Stacey Barr scored 53 points and totaled 21 rebounds in Idaho's two games last week. She now is averaging a Big Sky-best 20.4 points per game (23rd in the NCAA). Barr started the week with a 26-point performance against Montana State. She hit four 3-pointers and went 10-for-15 from the free-throw line. Barr set a season-high in rebounding with 15, good for her 21st career double-double. She bested her Thursday scoring total Saturday against Montana. She scored a game-high 27 points for Vandals, shooting 47.6 percent from the floor. Saturday marked the 14th time this season she has scored 20 or more points. Barr has also reached double-figure scoring in 56 of Idaho's last 61 games.

Gretchen Harrigan (SAC) - Harrigan filled the stat sheet with a game-high 18 points and seven rebounds, five steals, two assists, and a block while playing just 18 minutes in Sacramento State's 92-60 win at Portland State in its only game of the week. Harrigan shot 8-of-13 (61.5%) from the field and was 2-of-2 from the free throw line. Six of her seven rebounds were on the offensive glass and her five steals helped the Hornets break the Big Sky record with 30 steals in the game. She also had two assists and one block and did not commit a single turnover in an incredibly efficient 18 minutes of play, totaling 10 points, three rebounds, and three steals in 10 minutes in the first half as the Hornets opened up a big early lead.

Brittani Lusain (NAU) - Lusain averaged 13.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.5 steals this past weekend as NAU traveled to Northern Colorado and North Dakota. On Thursday, Lusain helped NAU pick up its first road win of the season, 51-49, over the Bears tallying 13 points, seven rebounds and four assists. She then posted a team-high 14 points on Saturday at UND, while also notching a career-high tying four steals. For the season, the sophomore is averaging 10.2 points, 6.0 rebounds and 4.3 assists per game.
