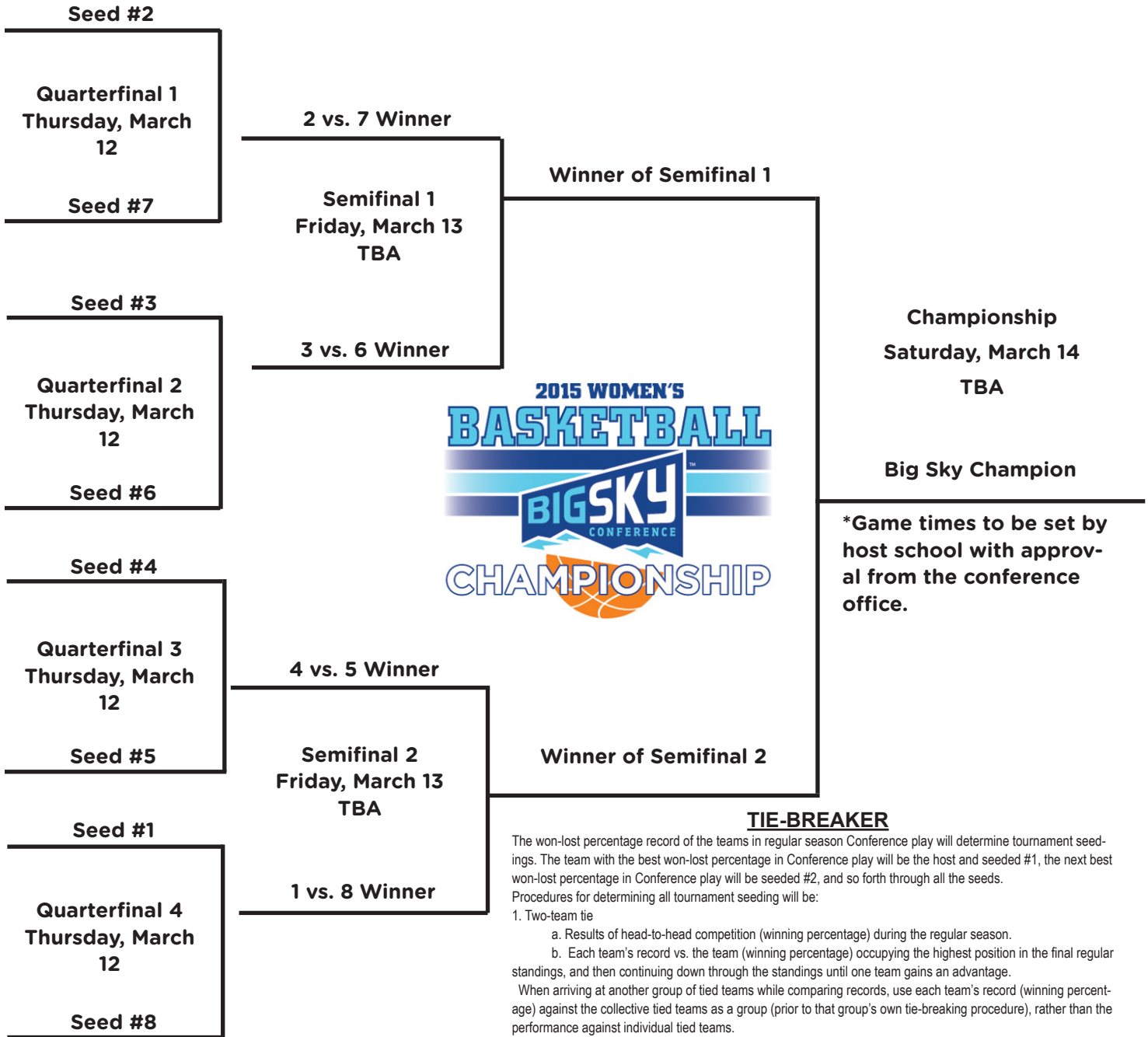

### TIE-BREAKER

The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be the host and seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

Procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

1. Two-team tie
  - a. Results of head-to-head competition (winning percentage) during the regular season.
  - b. Each team's record vs. the team (winning percentage) occupying the highest position in the final regular standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

  - c. RPI Rankings
  - d. Coin toss conducted by the \_\_\_\_\_ Commissioner or designee.
2. Multiple-team tie
  - a. Results of collective head-to-head competition (winning percentage) during the regular season among the tied teams.
  - b. If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (winning percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

## NORTHERN COLORADO'S STRANGE EARNS THIRD BIG SKY WEEKLY HONOR

Northern Colorado's D'Shara Strange was named the Big Sky Conference women's basketball player of the week after leading the Bears to a road sweep of Montana State and conference-leader Montana this past weekend. This is the third Big Sky weekly award for Strange this season.

Strange, a senior from Fountain, Colo., averaged 24.0 points, 14.5 rebounds, two assists and two steals while helping the Bears complete the road sweep of Montana and Montana State. It was the first time a Big Sky school has achieved the feat since Eastern Washington in January of 2012.

On Thursday against Montana State, Strange posted 31 points and 17 rebounds, both of which were career-highs.

Against Big Sky leader Montana, Strange made the game winning shot with 2.6 seconds remaining to end the Lady Griz's 23-game home conference winning streak. She finished the game with 17 points and 12 rebounds, pacing the Bears in both categories.

Northern Colorado currently sits in sixth place in the Big Sky standings. The Bears will have a chance to make a push for a higher seed in the Big Sky tournament as they host Sacramento State and Portland State this weekend

### Last Week's Top Performers

**Hayley Hodgins (EWU)** - Hayley Hodgins played an integral role in leading Eastern Washington to a pair of road Big Sky victories this past week, averaging 19.0 points and 7.0 rebounds on 48.5 percent shooting. Against Sacramento State on Thursday, she scored a game-high 27 points on 12-of-22 shooting while pulling down 10 rebounds, good for her first career double-double. She scored 15 of her points in the second half, including the go-ahead basket that put EWU up for good with 17 seconds remaining. She added three assists, two steals and one block to her impressive stat line, playing 39 minutes.

It was Sacramento State's first home loss in Big Sky play, and just its second home loss of the season.

She went for 11 points in the Eagles' convincing 77-63 win over Portland State on Saturday, adding four rebounds, two steals and an assist.

**Stacey Barr (UI)** - Stacey Barr averaged 24 points for the Vandals last week, notching 15th and 16th game of the season with 20 or more points. Idaho split the roadtrip, getting the win at Portland State, before falling short at Sacramento State. She also averaged four rebounds and two and a half assists.

The Australian senior opened the week with 20 points in 29 minutes against the Vikings. Barr was able to take a breather with the game in hand in the second half. Idaho finished the contest 20 points better than Portland State, 69-49. Barr spearheaded Idaho's comeback effort against the Hornets. Idaho trailed by 22 with 5:08 to play. The Silver and Gold cut the gap to eight points before running out of time. Barr scored a game-high 28 points, adding five rebounds and three assists. She went 3-of-5 from the free-throw line, good enough to push her into fifth all-time with 341 career free throws made.

Barr improved to 20th in the NCAA with a Big Sky best 20.7 points per game.

**Fantasia Hilliard (SAC)** - Hilliard had a monster week to lead the Hornets, totaling 40 points, 17 assists, 13 rebounds, and five steals in two games. Averaging 20.0 points, 8.5 assists, and 6.5 rebounds per game Hilliard also shot 15-of-28 (53.6%) overall, 6-of-9 (66.7%) from 3-point range, and a perfect 4-of-4 from the free throw line.

She nearly had the first triple-double in program history on Saturday against Idaho, totaling 22 points, nine rebounds, and nine assists. She led the Hornets to a 92-84 home win over Idaho shooting 8-of-13 from the field and 4-of-5 from 3-point range. On Thursday Hilliard scored 18 points with eight assists, four rebounds, and three steals in the Hornets narrow 80-79 loss to Eastern Washington. For the week Hilliard had a 17-6 assist turnover ratio and played 63 minutes in Sacramento State's fast paced style (no other Hornet played more than 42 minutes).
