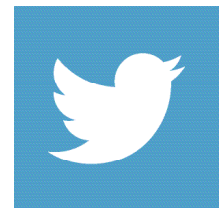



## **PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

### **Martin Breunig, F, Montana**



Breunig, a 6-foot-8 junior forward from Leverkusen, Germany, averaged 20.5 points, nine rebounds, 2.5 assists and one block per game as the Grizzlies beat Idaho State and Weber State to surge into a first-place tie with Sacramento State. Breunig scored 22 points with eight rebounds, two assists and two blocks in an 88-77 win over Idaho State. Breunig followed with 19 points, 10 rebounds and three assists in a 74-63 victory over Weber State on Saturday.

Breunig shot .692 percent from the field in the two games. This is Breunig's first Player of the Week honor.

### **Kris Yanku, F, Northern Arizona**



Yanku, a 6-foot-4 sophomore guard from Chatsworth, Calif., averaged 20.5 points, seven assists, 5.5 rebounds, and 3.0 steals per game as the Lumberjacks beat Idaho and Eastern Washington to hike its conference record to 10-4. Yanku was 7-of-11 from the field, and 3-of-5 from 3-point range as he scored 22 points with six rebounds and five assists with three steals in a 72-65 win over Idaho on Thursday. Yanku scored 19 points

with eight assists, six rebounds and three steals in an 83-79 win over Eastern Washington on Saturday. Against the Eagles, Yanku made 12-of-13 from the free-throw line. This is Yanku's first career Player of the Week honor.

### **Others Nominated**

Venky Jois, F, Eastern Washington: Averaged 18.5 points per game in a win and a loss.

## THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

Just 20 conference games remain in the regular season, and so much is yet to be decided. Sacramento State and Montana are both 12-3 and enter the week with a slim lead over Eastern Washington (11-3) and Northern Arizona (10-4)...Montana hits the road to face Idaho on Thursday and Eastern Washington on Saturday...Sacramento State is on the road at Portland State on Saturday night...Eastern Washington plays host to Montana State on Thursday before the game with the Griz...Northern Arizona ventures to North Dakota and Northern Colorado...Weber State, which sits in eighth place, takes on Idaho State on Saturday night...Southern Utah, which is trying to catch Weber State, is at Northern Colorado Thursday and at North Dakota on Saturday...MSU is at Idaho on Saturday.

## AROUND THE BIG SKY

**FOUR ARE IN:** Sacramento State, Montana, Eastern Washington and Northern Arizona have officially clinched spots in the 2015 Big Sky Championship. Four spots are still open. No team has been mathematically eliminated.

**20 FOR THE EAGLES:** Eastern Washington won its 20th game of the season on Thursday, downing Southern Utah 78-75 in Cedar City. The win secured a spot in the postseason tournament for the Eagles, who failed to make the championship each of the previous two seasons. This marks the first time since EWU joined the Big Sky in 1987-88 that the Eagles have won 20 games in a season. EWU's last 20-win campaign came in 1985-86 when the Eagles finished 20-8 at a Division I independent.

**KATZ KEEPS CLIMBING:** Sacramento State won its 11th and 12th conference games last week with wins over Northern Colorado and North Dakota. Sixth-year coach Brian Katz has now improved the Hornets' conference win total in all six of his season. The Hornets won one conference game in 2008-09, three the following season, followed by four, and then five. The Hornets won eight in 2012-13, and 10 last season....Sacramento State capped a 9-0 conference home season with the win over North Dakota. The Hornets are the only team in the league not to lose a conference home game. Sacramento State's nine-game home winning streak is the longest for the program since 1972, and tied for the second-longest in school history. Sacramento State takes and 18-8 mark into this week's games. The 18 victories are the most since the 1987-88 team, and is tied for the third-most in school history. The win over Northern Colorado on Thursday secured a spot in the postseason tournament for the second straight season.

**JACKS CLINCH:** Northern Arizona became the fourth team to clinch a spot in the 2015 Big Sky Championship with its win on Saturday over Eastern Washington. The Lumberjacks will make their third straight appearance. NAU has won seven of its last eight games, and is just a game behind Montana and Sacramento State. Northern Arizona last won the outright regular-season title in 2006.

**THE WELL, MAYBE:** The Big Sky Conference approved Sacramento State's plan to host the 2015 Big Sky Conference Championship at its on-campus student health and recreation center "The Well." If the Hornets win the regular-season title and the right to host, roughly 3,000 seats and a portable court will be brought in to "The Well." The Hornets can't host the tournament at "The Nest"

**GRIZZLIES IN AGAIN:** Montana clinched a spot in the Big Sky championship with a win over Idaho State on Thursday. The Grizzlies then won their fifth straight game Saturday over Weber State. Montana will play in the Big Sky Championship for the 14th consecutive season, the longest active streak in the league. Montana is 12-3 in conference. This marks the seventh straight season the Grizzlies have won at least 10 conference games. The all-time record is eight set by Weber State. Montana's win over Weber State on Saturday officially ended Weber State's streak, which started during the 2006-07 season. Weber State can finish no better than 9-9. Travis DeCuire's 12 conference wins are the most by a first-year coach in the Big Sky since B.J. Hill led the Northern Colorado Bears to a 13-3 record in 2010-11.

**RPI UPDATE:** Eastern Washington dropped just one spot in the RPI from 71 to 72. The Eagles still hold a commanding lead over other Big Sky teams. Sacramento State moved up four spots to 142. Montana improved two spots to 170. Northern Arizona jumped 26 spots to 182. The Big Sky Conference improved one spot to No. 26 among Division I Conferences.

**NCAA LEADERS:** EWU's Tyler Harvey continues to lead the nation in points per game (22.8) and 3-point field-goals per game (4.04)...Idaho's Connor Hill is fourth in 3-pointers per game (3.52) and in 3-point field-goal percentage (.463)...Sacramento State's Mikh McKinney is fifth in steals per game (2.72)...Idaho's Mike Scott is fifth in assist/turnover ratio (3.38)...Idaho is second in 3-point field-goal percentage (.423), while Sacramento State is fourth (.410)...Eastern Washington is fifth in 3-point field goals per game (9.8) and seventh in scoring offense (80.1 points per game).

**Tip-ins:** Eastern Washington's Parker Kelly became the 20th player in league history and the fourth this season to make 200 career 3-pointers. Kelly enters this week with 201...Northern Colorado's Dominique Lee has recorded a double-double in fourth straight games...Northern Colorado's Tim Huskisson scored his 1,000th career point in a loss to Portland State on Saturday...Portland State's Gary Winston also scored his 1,000th point on Saturday night in a win over Northern Colorado...Weber State's Joel Bolomboy has moved into 13th place on the Big Sky's all-time rebounding list with 858. He needs just 17 more to move into the top 10...EWU's Tyler Harvey needs just three 3-pointers to become the first player in league history to make 100 3-pointers in two different seasons. Just five times has a Big Sky player made 100 3-pointers in a season. Harvey made 109 last year...Montana State has won three of its last four, as has Southern Utah...Home teams won 10 of the 12 games last week. When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

c. RPI Rankings

d. Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

### 2. Multiple-team tie

a. Results of collective head-to-head competition (winning percentage) during the regular season among the tied teams.

b. If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (winning percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.
