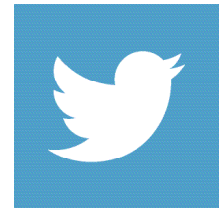



PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Drew Brandon, Sr., G, Eastern Washington



Brandon, a 6-4 senior guard from Corona, Calif., averaged 21 points, nine rebounds, four steals and 2.5 assists per game as the Eagles earned road wins over Montana and Montana State. Brandon had just two turnovers in 79 minutes of action and was counted on to step up with Tyler Harvey, the nation's leading scorer, back home in Cheney recovering from an injury.

Brandon opened with 27 points, six rebounds, five assists and two steals in his team's 75-69 win at Montana on Thursday, Feb. 5. Brandon made 10-of-20 shots from the floor, was 3-of-7 from 3-point range, and 4-of-6 from the free-throw line. Eastern Washington snapped a 10-game losing streak to Montana at Dahlberg Arena.

In Saturday's 61-51 win over Montana State, Brandon recorded his sixth double-double of the season with 15 points and 12 rebounds. He also had six steals. The win completed Eastern Washington's first conference road sweep since the 2003-04 season, and also marked just the fourth time in 28 years the Eagles swept the Montana schools.

Eastern Washington is now 9-1 in conference and 18-5 overall. The 18 wins match the most the Eagles have ever had as a Big Sky member.

The Lumberjacks are at Idaho State on Thursday and then take on Weber State in Ogden on Saturday...Weber State looks to even the season series with Southern Utah on Thursday...Montana State is at Northern Colorado on Thursday and at UND on Saturday...Idaho welcomes Portland State to Moscow on Thursday,

AROUND THE BIG SKY

HISTORIC WEEKEND FOR EAGLES: Eastern Washington swept Montana and Montana State on the road this past weekend, marking the first time since Feb. 5 and Feb. 7, in 2004 that the Eagles swept a conference road trip. EWU's win at Dahlberg Arena on Thursday was the Eagles first win at Montana since 2004. It marked just the fourth time in 28 years the Eagles swept the Montana schools. The Eagles improved their record to 18-5. Eastern Washington has never won more than 18 games in a season since joining the Big Sky in 1987-88. EWU finished 18-11 in 1989-90, and 18-13 in 2002-03. The Eagles are closing in on their first 20-win season since 1985-86 when the program finished 20-8 as a Division I independent. Jim Hayford's club is 11-0 at Reese Court this season. The Eagles welcome Sacramento State and Portland State to Cheney this week. The Eagles are 9-1 in conference, and have never won more than 11 Big Sky games in a season. EWU won both games last week without Tyler Harvey, the nation's leading scorer. Harvey sustained a bruised quad on Jan. 31 against Idaho.

WINNING SEASON FOR THE HORNETS: Sacramento State downed Portland State 64-60 at The Nest on Saturday to improve to 16-6. The victory secured the first winning season for the Hornets in the Division I era, which began in 1991. Previously, Sacramento State had never won more than 15 games in a season as a Big Sky member. The Hornets joined the Big Sky in 1996-97. The Hornets moved to 10-1, tying the mark for its most Big Sky victories set last season. Sacramento State has won seven consecutive games, the program's longest winning streak since the 1975-76 squad won seven in a row. The seven-game streak is tied for the seventh-longest active streak in Division I. Sacramento State is 11-1 at The Nest this season. The 11 wins ties for the most home wins as a Division I team. Sac State has won a school-record eight straight over Big Sky teams at home, and has won 19 of its last 21 home games dating back to last season.

THE 800 CLUB: Weber State junior Joel Bolomboy scored 14 points and pulled down 11 rebounds in Weber State's win over Idaho State on Saturday. Bolomboy became the 17th player in league history to record 800 rebounds. Bolomboy now has 809 in his career and ranks 16th on the Big Sky's all-time rebounding list. Former Boise State player Bruce Bolden is 15th on the list. Bolden recorded 817 rebounds from 1981-85. Bolomboy is 18th among active Division I players in rebounds, but second among juniors. Only Shawn Long of Louisiana-Lafayette has more rebounds among the junior class. Long has 917. Bolomboy is averaging 9.1 rebounds per game in his career, which is fifth among active players.

SURGING LUMBERJACKS: Northern Arizona notched home wins over Northern Colorado and North Dakota to move to 7-3 in conference. The Lumberjacks have won four straight games, tying the longest winning streak under third-year coach Jack Murphy. NAU went 0-5 in 2013-14 against UNC and UND. NAU has not won five in a row since the 2010-11 season. The Lumberjacks are at Idaho State on Thursday and at Weber State on Saturday.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

c. RPI Rankings

d. Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

2. Multiple-team tie

a. Results of collective head-to-head competition (winning percentage) during the regular season among the tied teams.

b. If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (winning percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.
