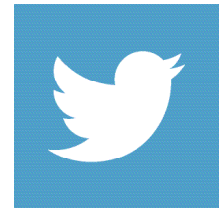

Road to the Big Sky Championship

Sacramento State (13-3)

Games Remaining:
Thursday: at Southern Utah
Saturday at Northern Arizona

The lowdown: Sacramento State has clinched a postseason berth. The Hornets can clinch at least a share of the regular-season title and the right to host the Big Sky Championship with one victory. Sacramento State can finish as high as first, and no worse than third.

Montana (13-4)

Game Remaining
Saturday: at Montana State

The lowdown: Montana has clinched a spot in the Big Sky Championship. The Grizzlies can still potentially host the championship, but needs a win and two Sacramento State losses. UM can be as high as the No. 1 seed and no worse than the No. 4 seed.

Eastern Washington (12-4)

Games Remaining
Thursday: at Idaho State
Saturday at Weber State

The lowdown: Eastern Washington has clinched a spot in the Big Sky Championship. The Eagles can host the Big Sky Championship with two wins, two Sacramento State losses and a loss by Montana. EWU can finish as high as No. 1 and no worse than fourth

Northern Arizona (11-5)

Games Remaining
Thursday: Portland State
Saturday: Sacramento State

The lowdown: Northern Arizona has clinched a postseason bid. The Lumberjacks can tie for the regular-season title, but can't host the championship. NAU can finish as high as the No. 2 seed, but no worse than No. 4.

Northern Colorado (9-8)

Game remaining
Saturday: North Dakota

The lowdown: Northern Colorado has clinched a postseason bid. The Bears can finish as high as No. 5.

Idaho (8-8)

Games remaining:
Thursday: at Weber State
Saturday: at Idaho State

The lowdown: Idaho needs one win or a Southern Utah loss to secure a tournament bid. The Vandals could potentially not make the tournament. In a head-to-head tie with SUU at 8-10, the Vandals would lose a head-to-head tiebreaker. Idaho could finish at high as fifth.

Portland State (8-8)

Games Remaining
Thursday at Northern Arizona
Saturday at Southern Utah

The lowdown: Portland State needs one win or a Southern Utah loss to secure a bid to the tournament. Portland State could not make the tournament if it finishes 8-10. In a tie with SUU at 8-10, which means SUU victories over Portland State and Sacramento State, SUU could have a tiebreaker advantage thanks to the win over Sacramento State.

Weber State (7-9)

Games Remaining
Thursday: Idaho
Saturday: Eastern Washington

The lowdown: Weber State needs a win and a Southern Utah loss to secure a spot in the Big Sky Championship. WSU was swept by SUU, and would lose a head-to-head tiebreaker to Southern Utah. WSU can finish no higher than sixth.

Southern Utah (6-10)

Games Remaining
Thursday: Sacramento State
Saturday: Southern Utah

The lowdown: Sitting in ninth place, the Thunderbirds potentially need two wins to make the tournament. Southern Utah could also make the tournament in a head-to-head tie with Weber State at 7-11 or 8-10. SUU holds the tiebreaker over Weber State. SUU could also make the tournament at 8-10 if Idaho finishes 8-10. Two losses eliminates SUU. SUU can finish as high as seventh.

Idaho State, Montana State and North Dakota have been eliminated from postseason contention.

TIE-BREAKER

The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be the host and seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

Procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

1. Two-team tie

a. Results of head-to-head competition (winning percentage) during the regular season.

b. Each team's record vs. the team (winning percentage) occupying the highest position in the final regular standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

c. RPI Rankings

d. Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

2. Multiple-team tie

a. Results of collective head-to-head competition (winning percentage) during the regular season among the tied teams.

b. If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (winning percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

c. RPI Rankings

d. Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

The final week of the regular season has arrived, and it will be full of drama... North Dakota opens the week with a non-conference game at home on Tuesday against Omaha...Sacramento State needs one win to secure at least a share of the conference title and the right to host the conference tournament. The Hornets are at Southern Utah on Thursday and at Northern Arizona on Saturday. Montana, Eastern Washington and Northern Arizona all enter the week with hopes of at least a share of the regular season title...Montana plays at Montana State on Saturday...EWU is at Idaho State and Weber State, while NAU plays host to Portland State before Saturday's showdown with Sacramento State...Northern Colorado, which secured a bid to the tournament, plays host to North Dakota on Saturday...Portland State, Idaho, Weber State and Southern Utah are gunning for the final three bids...PSU is at SUU on Saturday. Idaho makes the Idaho State-Weber State road trip.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

ONE WIN AWAY: Sacramento State enters the final week of the regular season 13-3 and one win away from capturing at least a share of three regular-season titles. With one win, Sacramento State would secure the right to host the 2015 Big Sky Conference Championship March 12-14 at "The WELL" on the Hornet campus. Sacramento State has never won a regular-season Big Sky title. Its 13 conference wins are the most the Hornets have had since joining the Big Sky in 1996-1997. The Hornets are one victory away from the program's first 20-win season since the 1987-88 team, which competed at Division II level. This is Sacramento State's first winning season as a Division I team. The Hornets became Division I in 1991. Sacramento State is at Southern Utah on Thursday and at Northern Arizona on Saturday.

TOURNEY TALK: Sacramento State, Montana, Eastern Washington, Northern Arizona and Northern Colorado have clinched postseason bids. SAC, UM, EWU, and NAU will be the top four seeds in the tournament, but the order is yet to be determined. All four could tie for the regular-season title at 13-5. Northern Arizona is the only one of the top four that could not host the championship. Portland State, Idaho, Weber State and Southern Utah enter the final week of play in the running for the final three spots. Montana State, North Dakota, and Idaho State have been eliminated from postseason contention. Portland State and Idaho need one victory or a Southern Utah loss to secure a spot in the postseason. Southern Utah holds the tiebreaker over Weber State, so the Wildcats need a win, or two Southern Utah losses to secure a postseason berth.

RPI UPDATE: Eastern Washington continues to lead Big Sky teams in the RPI. The Eagles dropped 17 spots from last week to 88. Sacramento State improved 15 spots to 127. Montana jumped 17 spots to 152. Northern Arizona dropped five spots to 187. EWU's non-conference RPI is 46, while Sacramento State's is 221. The Big Sky's non-conference strength of schedule is rated 11th among all Division I Conferences. The Big Sky is rated 27th among DI conferences in the RPI.

HARVEY HITS 100: Eastern Washington junior Tyler Harvey became the first player in league history to make 100 3-pointers in back-to-back seasons. Harvey enters the final week of the regular season with 103 made 3-pointers, which is tied for fourth-most in Big Sky single-season history. Harvey made 109 last season, the second-most in Big Sky history. The single-season record is 124 by Northern Arizona's Stephen Sir in 2006-07. Harvey has made 235 career 3-pointers, which is tied for 11th in Big Sky history.

TWO EARN ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICA HONORS: Eastern Washington junior Tyler Harvey and Montana senior Jordan Gregory were named to the prestigious Division I Men's Basketball Capital One Academic All-America Team last week. The team was selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). Harvey was one of five players in the nation named to the First Team. He is the first Eastern men's basketball player to earn First Team honors at the NCAA Division I level. Harvey maintains a 3.6 GPA in Communication studies. Gregory, from Pueblo, Colo., was tabbed to the Third Team. Gregory maintains a 3.69 GPA in psychology.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

BOLOMBOY 11th IN REBOUNDS: Weber State's Joel Bolomboy has moved into 11th place on the Big Sky's all-time rebounding list with 866. Bolomboy needs eight to tie Montana's Darren Engellant (1988-92) for 10th place. Bolomboy is just 14 rebounds away from tying Doug Hashley of Montana State for seventh place. Bolomboy has 275 rebounds this season. He ranks 15th in the nation in an average of 10.3 per game.

NCAA LEADERS: EWU's Tyler Harvey continues to lead the nation in scoring at 22.8 points per game, and is also first in 3-point field goals per game (3.96)...Idaho's Connor Hill is fourth in 3-point field-goal percentage (.451) and fourth in 3-point field goals per game (3.56)...Sacramento State's Mikh McKinney is sixth in steals per game (2.69), while Idaho's Mike Scott is ninth in assist/turnover ratio (3.29)...EWU's Venky Jois is 10th in field-goal percentage (.599)...Idaho is second in 3-point-field goal percentage (.416). Sacramento State is sixth (.405), and EWU is seventh (.404)...EWU is fifth in scoring offense (80.4 points per game), and fifth in 3-point field goals per game (9.8).

Tip-ins: Home teams won six of the 10 conference games last week. Home teams are 60-38 (.612 winning percentage) in conference games. Last year, home teams won .691 percent of conference games...Northern Colorado's Dominique Lee recorded five consecutive double-doubles before the streak ended Saturday in a win over NAU. During the five games, Lee averaged 16.6 points and 11.8 rebounds per game, and shot .625 percent from the floor...PSU's Collin Spickerman set the single-game school record for blocked shots in a game with seven in a loss to Sacramento State on Saturday. The seven blocked shots tied for the eighth most ever by a Big Sky player...EWU's 12 Big Sky conference victories are the most ever for the Eagles. The previous high was 11...UM's Jordan Gregory scored a career-high 36 points - including 23 in 10 minutes of overtime - in a 92-87 2OT loss to Idaho...Idaho's Connor Hill needs four 3-pointers to become the sixth player in league history to make 100 in a season.
