## BIG SKY HIGHLIGHTS

Montana will host the Big Sky Conference tournament for the 16th time as the Lady Griz earned the Big Sky Conference regular season championship with home wins over Idaho and Eastern Washington last weekend in Missoula, Mont.

Sacramento State's 123-point performance against Portland State on Saturday set a new Big Sky record for points scored in a game.

This year's eight-team tournament will be held March 12 through 14 at Montana's Dahlberg arena. That is, if the Montana men don't win the Big Sky regular season crown. If both the UM men and women host the tournament, the women's action will take place Wednesday March 11 with the semi finals on Friday and the championship on Saturday.

Despite two losses last weekend, North Dakota clinched a spot in the eight-team Big Sky tournament.

With five tournament spots already taken, the battle for the last three slots will be heated as Idaho State and NAU are tied with 8-8 records and Montana State holding eighth place with an 8-9 conference mark. ISU, NAU and MSU can all secure tournament bids with a win. Idaho, Southern Utah and Weber State are still in the hunt.

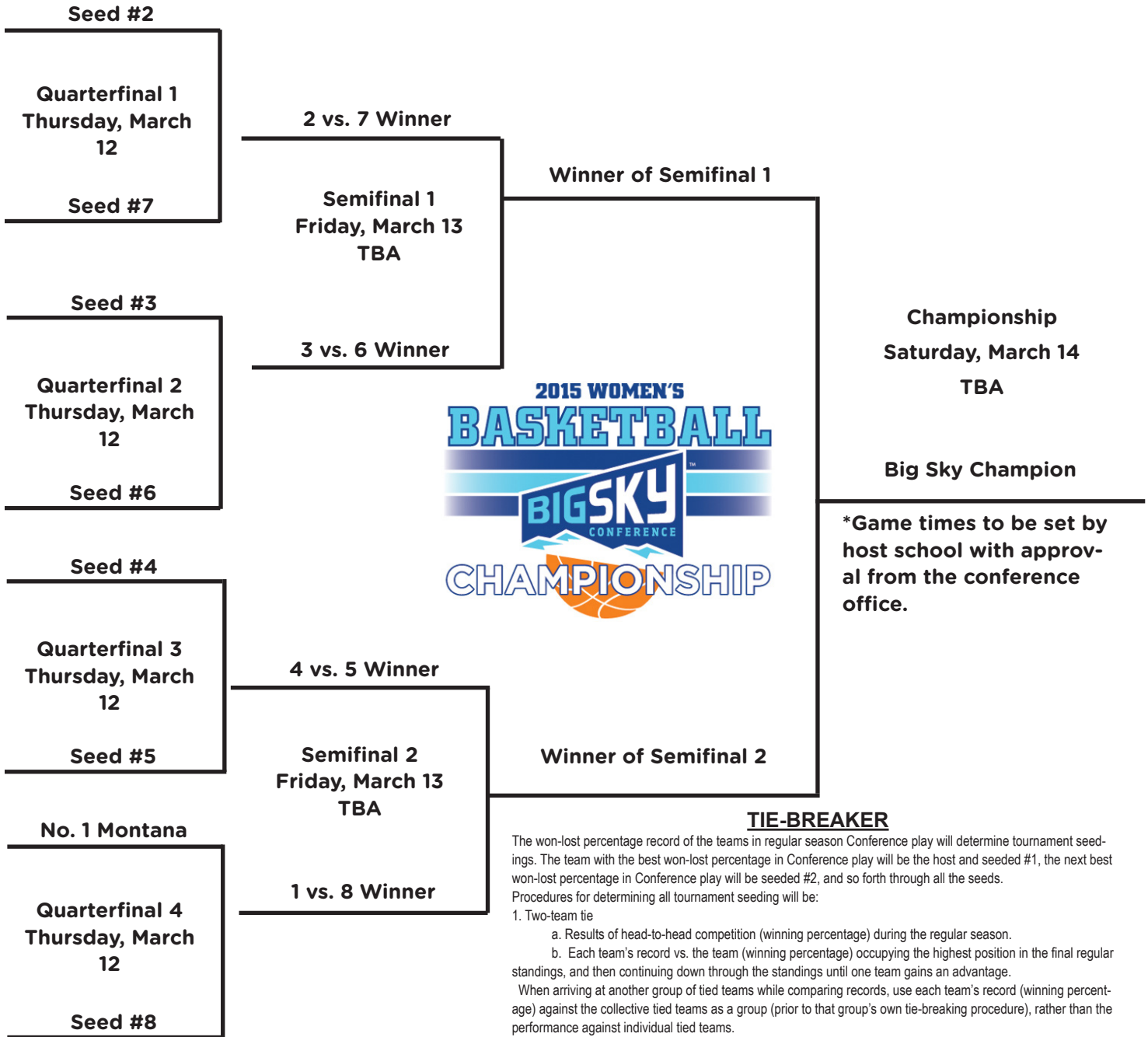

### TIE-BREAKER

The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be the host and seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

Procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

1. Two-team tie
  - a. Results of head-to-head competition (winning percentage) during the regular season.
  - b. Each team's record vs. the team (winning percentage) occupying the highest position in the final regular standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

  - c. RPI Rankings
  - d. Coin toss conducted by the \_\_\_\_\_ Commissioner or designee.
2. Multiple-team tie
  - a. Results of collective head-to-head competition (winning percentage) during the regular season among the tied teams.
  - b. If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (winning percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

**NORTHERN COLORADO'S STRANGE EARNS FOURTH  
BIG SKY WEEKLY HONOR OF THE SEASON**

Northern Colorado's D'Shara Strange was named the Big Sky Conference women's basketball player of the week after leading the Bears to a road sweep of Southern Utah and Northern Arizona this past weekend. This is the fourth Big Sky weekly award for Strange this season.

Strange, a senior from Fountain, Colo., averaged 19 points, 6 rebounds, 5.5 assists and 2.5 steals while helping the Bears complete the road sweep of SUU and NAU. The wins improved the Bears' record to 11-6 in conference play and moved the team into third place in the Big Sky Standings with one week left in the regular season.

On Thursday against Southern Utah, Strange posted 11 points, three rebounds and three assists. Defensively, she had a good night with four seals in just 18 minutes of action.

Against NAU, the senior posted 27 points on 61 percent shooting. She also tied a career-high with eight assists while committing just one turnover. She was one rebound shy of a double-double with nine boards.

Northern Colorado will close out the regular season on the road at North Dakota on Saturday at 1 p.m. Mountain.

**Last Week's Top Performers**

**Kallie Durham (MSU)** - Durham averaged 14.5 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 3.5 assists per game as the Bobcats won a pair of crucial league games over then No. 2 Eastern Washington and Idaho, who was a 1/2 game ahead of MSU. Against Idaho, Durham posted a season-high 20 points, connecting on six-of-12 from the field, three-of-five from beyond the arc and five-of-five at the free throw line. In addition, the Miles City product matched a career-high with five assists against the Vandals. Against Eastern Washington, Durham posted nine points, four rebounds, two assists and a steal.

**Adella Randle-El (SAC)** - Randle-El scored a career-high and team-high 23 points in just 16 minutes played to lead Sacramento State to a Big Sky record 123 points against Portland State in the team's only game of the week. She made a career high five 3-pointers in just six attempts and a 9-of-13 overall from the field. She scored 18 points in the first half alone and also had four assists and a team-high three steals to lead six Hornets in double figures in the 123-77 rout. Randle-El, who recorded her 11th double digit scoring game this season, is in her first year at Sacramento State after transferring from State Fair Community College in Missouri.

**Brittani Lusain (NAU)** - Lusain averaged 19.5 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game last weekend helping NAU move closer to a potential Big Sky Championship bid. In the team's double-overtime victory against North Dakota, Lusain matched her season-high of 21 points while recording a double-double with 10 rebounds. She shot 8-of-17 from the field and knocked down two three pointers. She followed with an 18 point, eight rebound performance against Northern Colorado on Saturday including a 9-for-10 effort at the free throw line.

**McCalle Feller (UM)** - Feller averaged 14.5 points on 50 percent shooting and 7.0 rebounds as Montana defeated Idaho and Eastern Washington at home last week to claim the Big Sky Conference regular-season championship and secure hosting rights to the postseason tournament.

Feller scored 18 points in Thursday's 81-68 victory over the Vandals, going 4 for 4 from 3-point range. She scored 13 of her points in the second half to help the Lady Griz break away from a game that was a two-point margin at the half. Feller scored 11 points and grabbed a career-high eight rebounds in Saturday's 69-59 victory over the Eagles. She scored nine of her points in the second half to break open what was a four-point game at the half.
