The Montana Lady Griz will make their 21st trip to the NCAA Tournament with a 60-49 win in the Big Sky Conference women's basketball championship. The Lady Griz will find out who they will face in the Big Dance when ESPN broadcasts the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Selection Show Monday at 5 p.m. Mountain.

Senior Maggie Rickman led UM with 20 points, 18 of which came in the second half. Fellow senior and tournament MVP, Kellie Rubel, was second in scoring with 14 points. UM dominated the boards with a 47-26 rebounding advantage. Rubel picked up her third double-double of the tournament with a game high 11 rebounds.

Northern Colorado was all-tournament selections and seniors D'shara Strange and Stephanie Lee. Strange led all scorers with 23 points on 8-of-14 shooting while Lee added 11.

UNC dominated the first half and entered the locker room with a 29-16 lead. The Bears also shot 50 percent in the first half while holding the Lady Griz to under 30 percent.

The second half was a different story as UM shot 54.5 percent while holding the Bears to just over 21 percent.

## SELVIG NAMED BIG SKY COACH OF THE YEAR

MONTANA HEAD WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH ROBIN SELVIG HAS BEEN NAMED THE BIG SKY CONFERENCE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH OF THE YEAR BY HIS PEERS. THIS MARKS THE 20TH TIME SELVIG HAS EARNED AT LEAST A SHARE OF THE HONOR AND THE 17TH TIME HE HAS EARNED THE HONOR OUTRIGHT.

SELVIG IS IN HIS 37TH SEASON AT THE HELM OF THE LADY GRIZ PROGRAM. IN THAT TIME, HE HAS LED MONTANA TO 35 WINNING SEASONS, 30 20-WIN SEASONS, 23 CONFERENCE TITLES AND 20 NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES. HEADING INTO THE 2014-15 SEASON, HE HAD AMASSED A RECORD OF 821-266, A WINNING PERCENTAGE OF .755 AND AN AVERAGE OF 22 WINS A SEASON.

THIS SEASON HE HAS LED THE LADY GRIZ TO ANOTHER BIG SKY REGULAR SEASON CHAMPIONSHIP AND THE RIGHT TO HOST THE BIG SKY TOURNAMENT FOR THE 20TH TIME. UM POSTED A 20-7 OVERALL RECORD IN THE REGULAR SEASON AND A 14-4 CONFERENCE RECORD.

SENIOR GUARD KELLIE RUBEL EARNED BIG SKY UNANIMOUS FIRST-TEAM ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS AND WAS NAMED CO-MVP BY THE LEAGUE'S COACHES. TEAMMATE CARLY SELVIG EARNED HER SECOND STRAIGHT DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD AND UM SENIOR MAGGIE RICKMAN, JUNIOR MCCALLE FELLER AND SOPHOMORE KAYLEIGH VALLEY WERE ALL NAMED HONORABLE MENTION.

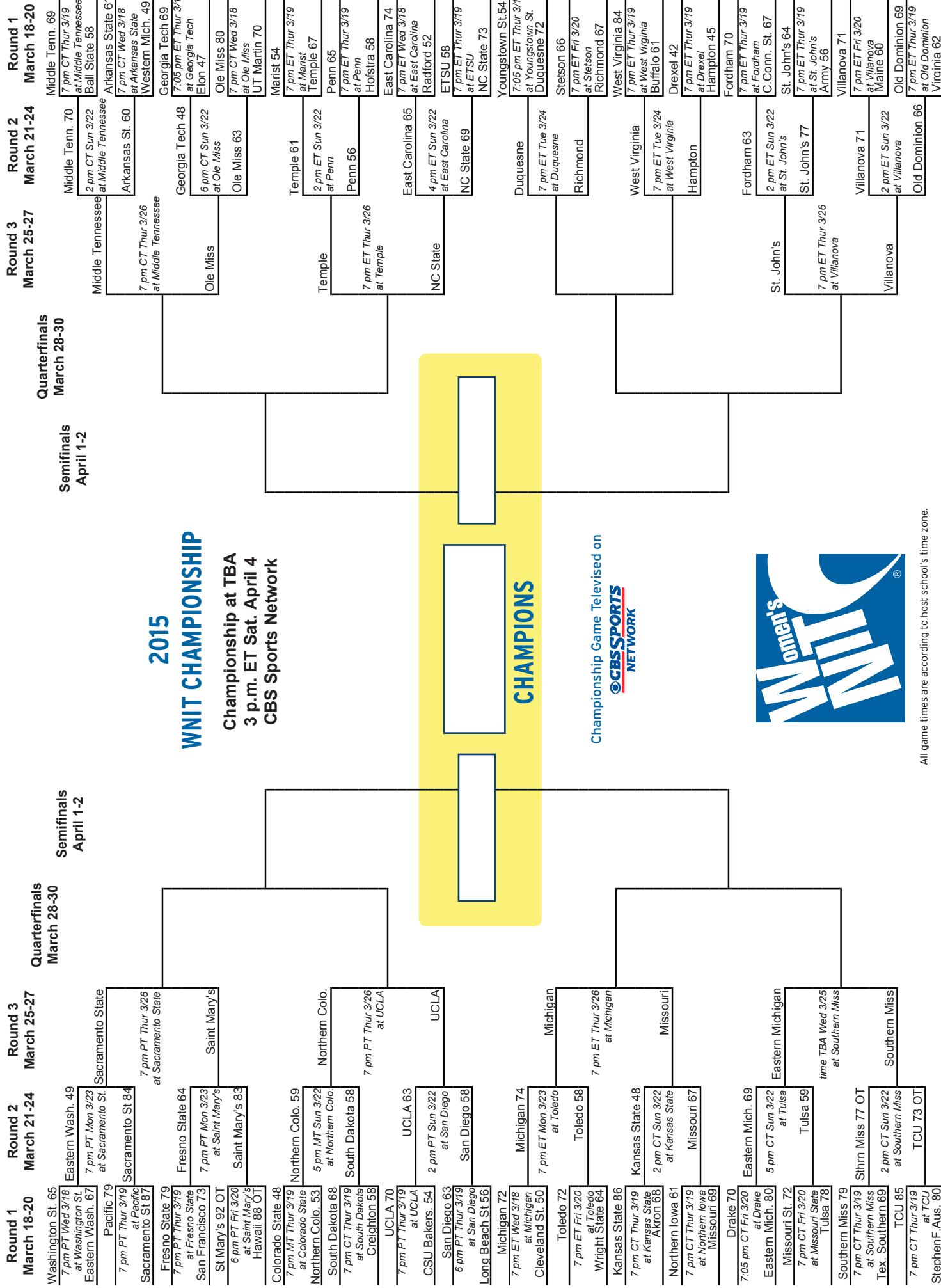
