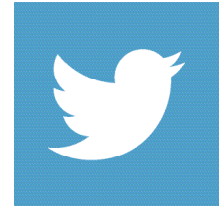

Tournament Tidbits

This is the 40th Big Sky Conference men's basketball Championship. It will mark the third time in four years and seventh time overall the Big Sky championship has been played at Montana's Dahlberg Arena.

Four of the previous six times the tournament has been played in Missoula, the Grizzlies won the championship on their home court. UM was victorious at Dahlberg Arena in 1991, 1992, 2012 and 2013. UM lost in the 1978 championship game, and was upset in a 2000 semifinal.

Montana, Weber State, Portland State, Northern Colorado, Northern Arizona and Sacramento State were all in last year's championship.

Montana is making its 14th consecutive championship appearance, the longest active streak in the league. Weber State is in the field for the ninth consecutive season, and the 38th time in the tourney's 40-year history. Northern Colorado and Northern Arizona are in the field for the third straight season. Sacramento State is making its second straight appearance.

Eastern Washington and Idaho are the lone newcomers to this year's field. Eastern Washington last made the tournament in 2012, and will make just its fourth appearance since 2007. Idaho left the Big Sky following the 1996 season, but returned this year. The Vandals went 15-13 in 17 appearances during their first stint in the Big Sky. Idaho won four championships and finished second twice.

Of the coaches in this year's field, only Weber State's Randy Rahe and Northern Colorado's B.J. Hill have won Big Sky Championships. Rahe led Weber State to championships in 2007 and 2014. Hill led Northern Colorado to the 2011 championship.

Weber State and Montana square off in the quarterfinals on Thursday. This will mark the fifth time in six years the two traditional Big Sky powers have played each other in the championship, and the 13th meeting between the programs overall in the championship. UM holds a 7-5 edge over the Wildcats in the championship, and has won six in a row dating back to Weber State's 1995 win over the Grizzlies in the Championship.

Coaches: Idaho's Don Verlin is in his seventh season at the helm of the Vandals. Verlin has an overall record of 110-112. Verlin is in his first season coaching in the Big Sky. Verlin, a former Division I assistant at Colorado State and Utah State, has more wins than any coach in Idaho history. He guided Idaho to the 2014 WAC Championship game, where his team lost to New Mexico State...Eastern Washington is led by fourth-year coach Jim Hayford, who is 63-62 with the Eagles. HE is 1-1 in the Big Sky Championship. Hayford has an overall coaching record of 317-146. He was the head coach at Sioux Falls from 1999-01 and at Whitworth from 2011-11.

MCKINNEY CLAIMS HORNETS' FIRST MVP AWARD

OGDEN, Utah (March 10, 2015) -For the first time since Sacramento State joined the Big Sky Conference in 1996-97, a Hornet has been selected as the men's basketball Most Valuable Player.

Sacramento State senior guard Mikh McKinney took the honor Monday, and was one of three unanimous selections to the All-Conference First Team. The conference coaches selected the individual award winners and All-Conference team. They were not allowed to vote for their own players.

McKinney, a 6-foot-1 senior from Union City, Calif., finished the regular season second in the Big Sky with an average of 19 points per game. He also led the league in steals (2.6 pg), was second in assists (5.0 pg), and shot .515 percent from the field, .423 percent from 3-point range, and .780 percent from the free-throw line.

McKinney, selected First Team All-Conference as a junior, ranked in the top 15 in seven major statistical categories. McKinney also helped Sacramento State to its first winning season since joining the Big Sky. The Hornets tied for third at 13-5 in conference and take a 19-9 overall record into this week's 2015 Big Sky Conference Championship. He is the first Hornet men's basketball player to win a conference MVP award since 1977.

Montana junior Martin Breunig was named the Newcomer of the Year and was also a unanimous All-Big Sky selection. Eastern Washington's Bogdan Bliznyuk was selected as the Freshman of the Year. Montana State junior Marcus Colbert garnered Top Reserve honors, while Northern Arizona's Jordyn Martin was tabbed as the Defensive Player of the Year.

Breunig, a 6-foot-8 forward from Leverkusen, Germany, helped Montana to the Co-Big Sky Conference regular-season title, and the No. 1 seed in the tournament. The transfer from Washington was a force down low for Travis DeCuire's club. Breunig finished the regular season sixth in the league in scoring with an average of 16.6 points per game. He pulled down 6.9 rebounds per game and shot .602 percent from the field.

Eastern Washington junior guard Tyler Harvey was the third unanimous selection to the First Team. Harvey, who garnered First Team accolades for the second consecutive season, leads the nation in scoring with an average of 22.9 points per game. Harvey also leads the nation with an average of 4.0 3-point field goals per game. Harvey has made 112 3-pointers so far, which ranks second in league single-season history. Harvey also ranks second in the league in free-throw percentage (.841)

McKinney, Breunig and Harvey were joined on the First Team by Northern Arizona sophomore guard Kris Yanku, Grizzly senior guard Jordan Gregory, and Eastern Washington junior forward Venky Jois.

Jois, from Boronia, Australia, teamed with Harvey to help Eastern Washington share the conference regular-season title with Montana. Jois ranks fourth in the league in scoring at 17.1 points per game and is third in rebounds (7.6 pg). Jois is also third in field-goal percentage (.604), and first in blocked shots (2.4 pg)

Gregory ranks fifth in scoring at 16.8 points per game. He also averaged 3.3 assists per game.

Yanku, the lone freshman or sophomore on the First Team, averaged 13.6 points, five assists, and 4.6 rebounds per game.

Bliznyuk was a unanimous selection as the Freshman of the Year. The 6-foot-6 native of Lusk, Ukraine, shined during conference play. In the 18 league games, he averaged 12 points, 5.6 rebounds, and shot .580 percent from the floor.

Colbert, a junior from Post Falls, Idaho, began the season as a starter, but played great for the Bobcats coming off the bench most of the conference season. In conference play, he averaged 13.5 points and 4.4 assists per game.

Martin, a 6-7 forward from Las Vegas, was a key cog defensively for the Lumberjacks, who tied for third in the league at 13-5. He averaged 7.2 points and 7.1 rebounds per game. He helped Northern Arizona allow just 67.4 points per game. Opponents shot a league-low .331 percent from 3-point range against Northern Arizona.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Venky Jois, Jr., F, Eastern Washington



Eastern Washington's Venky Jois has been selected as the final Big Sky Conference men's basketball Player of the Week for the 2014-15 season.

Jois, a 6-foot-8 junior forward from Boronia, Australia, recorded consecutive double-doubles as the Eagles beat Idaho State and Weber State on the road to clinch a share of the Big Sky regular season championship. Jois averaged 21.5 points and 13 rebounds per game, and shot .655 percent from the field.

In an 85-81 win over Idaho State on Thursday, Jois made 8-of-10 shots from the field en route to 21 points and 10 rebounds. He also had an assist, a block and a steal. In Saturday's 79-71 overtime win over Weber State, Jois had 22 points and pulled down a career-high 16 rebounds. He made 11-of-19 shots from the field and also had a block, an assist, and a steal.

Eastern Washington finished the regular season 14-4 in conference, tying Montana for the regular-season title. Eastern Washington had not won a regular-season title since 2003-04.

This is Jois' second Player of the Week honor this season.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

RETURN TO MISSOULA: Montana captured the No. 1 seed and the right to host the 2015 Big Sky Conference Championship with a 70-54 win over Montana State on Saturday in Bozeman. Montana finished 14-4, tying Eastern Washington for the regular-season title. The Big Sky Championship will be in Missoula for the third time in four years. Prior to hosting in 2012, Montana had not hosted the tournament since 2000. Since 2005, Montana has won five Big Sky Championships. Larry Krystkowiak, now the head coach at Utah, led Montana to championships in 2005 and 2006. Wayne Tinkle, now the coach at Oregon State, led the Grizzlies to titles in 2010, 2012 and 2013. DeCuire will become the third straight Griz coach to play and coach in the Big Sky Championship. Montana went 8-1 in home conference games this season, with the only loss coming to Eastern Washington. In the last four seasons, Montana is 60-14 in Big Sky regular-season games. If Montana doesn't win the championship, it will receive an automatic bid to the NIT.

CO-CHAMPS IN CHENEY: Eastern Washington made it interesting last weekend in wins over Idaho State and Weber State to capture a share of the regular-season title. Eastern Washington led Idaho State by 19 points in the second half, only to see the Bengals claw back to within one point in an 85-81 win. On Saturday, EWU rallied from a 19-point deficit to beat Weber State 79-71 in overtime. Eastern Washington won its first Big Sky regular-season title since the 2003-04 season, and just the third since joining the Big Sky in 1987-88. Eastern Washington won 23 regular-season games, a Division I record for the program. EWU's 14 Big Sky victories eclipsed its previous high by three. Eastern Washington is returning to the Big Sky Championship for the first time since the 2011-12 season. EWU hasn't played in the championship game since 2003-04.

LOOK OUT FOR THE LUMBERJACKS: Northern Arizona won 10 of its last 12 games, including a thrilling 70-68 win over Sacramento State on Saturday in Flagstaff. Northern Arizona finished league play 13-5, NAU has improved its conference win total in each of Jack Murphy's three seasons. NAU won eight conference games in 2012-13, and 12 last season. Northern Arizona's wins over Portland State and Sacramento State were led by gaudy rebounding numbers. NAU outrebounded Portland State 55-32, including a 25-7 edge on the offensive end. Against Sacramento State, NAU won the rebounding battle 43-17, including 21-4 on the offensive end. In the two games, NAU now leads the Big Sky in rebounding margin at +5.8.

FIRST-YEAR SUCCESS: Montana's Travis DeCuire became the third first-year Big Sky coach to lead his team to at least a share of the regular-season title since 2007. Weber State's Randy Rahe accomplished the feat in 2007. Northern Colorado's B.J. Hill led the Bears to the 2010-11 regular-season title in his first season. Both Rahe and Hill guided their teams to Big Sky postseason titles.

BEYOND THE ARC: EWU's Tyler Harvey finished the regular season with 112 3-pointers. He's just 12 away from tying the Big Sky single-season record of 124 set by Northern Arizona's Stephen Sir in 2006-07. Harvey's 109 3-pointers last season ranks third on the all-time list. Harvey enters the championship with 244 career 3-pointers, which ranks eighth all-time in Big Sky history. He needs two to tie former Weber State great Damian Lillard, and one to tie former NAU star Gabe Rogers. Idaho's Connor Hill became the sixth player in league history to make 100 3-pointers in a season. Hill, who is first in 3-pointers made among active Division I players with 334, poured in 102 during the regular season. He currently ranks seventh in Big Sky single-season history, but needs just one more to move into a tie for fourth place.

BOLOMBOY SEVENTH ALL-TIME IN REBOUNDS: Weber State's Joel Bolomboy recorded 21 rebounds last week to hike his career total to 887. The junior now ranks seventh in Big Sky history. Unless Weber State makes a run in the tournament, he will likely remain seventh entering his senior season. Gonzaga's Gary Lechman tallied 910 rebounds from 1964-67. Bolomboy is on pace to break the all-time league record of 1,143 held by Idaho State's Steve Hayes (1973-77).

Northern Arizona improved 20 spots from last week. The Big Sky is ranked 27th among Division I conferences. Kentucky is No. 1 in the nation in RPI. Kansas and Villanova are second and third.

NCAA LEADERS: Eastern Washington's Tyler Harvey finished the regular season ranked first in the nation in scoring with an average of 22.9 points per game. He was also first in 3-point field goals made per game (4.0)... Idaho's Mike Scott is sixth in assist/turnover ratio (3.28)... Sacramento State's Mikh McKinney is seventh in steals (2.61)... Idaho's Connor Hill ranks fourth in 3-point field goals per game (3.52) and is seventh in 3-point field-goal percentage (.442)... Eastern Washington's Venky Jois is ninth in field-goal percentage (.604)... Idaho is fifth in the nation in 3-point field-goal percentage (.408), while Sacramento State is sixth (.406)... EWU is sixth in scoring offense (80.5 ppg) and sixth in 3-point field goals per game (9.8)... Sacramento State is 10th in field-goal percentage (.485).
