#ICYMI

For the second week in a row and the third time this season, the Big Sky Conference has four teams in the top 10. With the final weekend of the regular season upon us, the Big Sky is clogging up the top spots quite nicely in the STATS FCS and AFCA FCS Coaches' Top 25 polls. Montana has its highest ranking of the season at No. 3, while Sacramento State was voted No. 4 - a school best. Weber State was slotted No. 6/7, while Montana State comes in at No. 8. Eastern Washington and UC Davis received votes this week.

Northern Arizona's Case Cookus became the second player in Big Sky history to complete 100 touchdown passes. Eastern Washington's Vernon Adams holds the record with 110.

Cookus and Maier are No. 4 and No. 8 on the Big Sky career passing yards chart. Cookus leads the FCS in season passing yards with 3,664 and ranks third in the nation across all divisions.

UC Davis linebacker Nick Eaton and Northern Arizona wide receiver Hendrix Johnson were named to the Jerry Rice Award Watch List - which recognizes the top freshman in the FCS.

Offensive Player of the Week • Samori Toure, WR, Montana

Junior wide receiver Samori Toure registered a career-high 193 yards in Montana's 35-16 win over No. 3 Weber State. Toure recorded three touchdowns on just eight catches, as he averaged 24.1 yards per reception. In addition to a season-long touchdown reception of 79 yards, he also had touchdowns for 10 and 59 yards.

Defensive Player of the Week • Jace Lewis, LB, Montana

Griz linebacker Jace Lewis was instrumental in holding down Weber State's run game. Lewis and the rest of the Montana defense held the Wildcats to 69 yards on the ground and an average of 1.9 yards per carry. The junior tallied a game-high 16 tackles, including seven solo with a tackle for loss.

Special Teams Player of the Week • Tristan Bailey, K, Montana State

Senior kicker Tristan Bailey scored 9 of Montana State's 17 points in the win at UC Davis, including seven in a 13-point fourth quarter. Bailey's 37-yard field goal less than four minutes into the final quarter began the Bobcats' 13-0 game-closing run, and he nailed a 41-yard field goal with 3:39 to play to seal the victory. Bailey tallied six kickoffs, as two resulted in touchbacks and the other four all pinned the Aggies inside their own 25-yard line. He was also 3-for-3 in made PATs.


