• EWU won a 34-28 thriller over Montana on ESPN2 last weekend, as the Eagles improved to 5-0 overall and climbed up to No. 4 in the nation in both national polls.



• EWU's 5-0 start is the best under head coach Aaron Best, and equals the 1985 team under head coach Dick Zornes as EWU's best start as a member of FCS.



• UC Davis is also off to a 5-0 start, with it matching the best program start since 2004. A 6-0 start would become the program's best since winning 12 straight to start the 2000 season.



• Montana State moved to 4-1 overall and 2-0 in league play with a win over Northern Colorado. MSU's defense has held all five 2021 opponents to less than 20 points, 350 total yards, and 20 first downs.



• Montana plays non-conference foe Dixie State this week as the Griz look to bounce back from their loss at EWU. Dixie State is 0-3 against Big Sky foes (Sac State, Weber State, UC Davis) this season and have been outscored 120-37.



• The Cal Poly/MSU game this Saturday will mark the first of four Big Sky games on ROOT SPORTS this season. The game will be available on ESPN+ subject to blackout in the ROOT SPORTS AT&T Sports Net territories airing the game live.

>> NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE <<

EWU, UC DAVIS OFF TO BEST STARTS

• EWU improved to 5-0 last weekend with a win over Montana, equaling its best start in program history since 1985.

• EWU's 5-0 start is the best under head coach Aaron Best, and equals the 1985 team under head coach Dick Zornes as EWU's best start as a member of FCS. The last time EWU was 6-0 in any season came 54 years ago in 1967 when EWU won its first 11 games before losing in the NAIA Championship Game.

• UC Davis also improved to 5-0 this past weekend after staving off an upset bid from Idaho. The 5-0 start is the best for the program since 2004.

• A 6-0 start for UC Davis would become the program's best since winning 12 straight to start the 2000 season.

• EWU and UC Davis are two of the 11 remaining undefeated teams in the FCS.

THE INFERNO STAYS HOT

• EWU extended its home winning streak this past Saturday with a 34-28 win over Montana.

• EWU has won 19-straight games at The Inferno, while earning a 62-10 mark since installing the iconic red turf in 2010.

• The last home loss for EWU came on Nov. 4, 2017, versus Weber State.

BIG SKY DEFENSE

• The Big Sky defenses have been in the backfield this season, with league players dominating the FCS sack and tackles for loss categories.

BARRIERE LEADING THE NATION

• EWU's Eric Barriere has been one of the best players in college football this season, leading the FCS in passing yards (2,105), total offense (2,189) and ranking passing touchdowns (18).

• Barriere broke the FCS record for most passing yards in a single half, after tossing 487 of his career-high 542 yards in the first half of Sept. 18's win at Western Illinois.

• Barriere threw for 500 or more passing yards in consecutive weeks (9/18, 9/25) to become the first FCS QB to throw for 500-plus in back-to-back games since Cornell's Jeff Mathews did it in 2011.

SHAHEED TIES FCS KOR RECORD

• After his 100-yard kickoff return for a score at Utah, Weber State's Rashid Shaheed broke the Big Sky career record for most KO return TDs with six and tied the FCS career mark. Shaheed is tied with Jerome Mathis of Hampton, who also returned six kickoffs for scores from 2001-04.

• Furthermore, Shaheed is the only FCS player to have a 100-yard kickoff return touchdown in each of the last two years.

RODRIGUES NAMED TO AFCA GOOD WORKS TEAM

• UC Davis QB Hunter Rodrigues earned one of 22 spots on the 2021 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team, the coaches organization announced last week.

• Rodrigues volunteers at "Shining Stars," a prom for teens and young adults with special needs and the Greater Sacramento Capernaum chapter of Young Life, a non-profit organization that serves individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, or IDD.

OFFENSE

QB - RJ MARTINEZ - NAU

Martinez led the Lumberjacks to a 48-17 victory over Idaho State, as the quarterback threw for 369 yards and three touchdowns. The freshman also rushed for a score, after taking a 41-yard scamper the distance against the Bengals. Martinez helped the Lumberjacks score the most points in a game since Nov. 23, 2019.

DEFENSE

DB - MORGAN VEST - NAU

Vest helped NAU hold the Idaho State offense at bay, as the safety had two interceptions on the day. Both forced turnovers led to points for the Lumberjacks on the ensuing possession, with scores of 80 and 11 yards. Vest's two-interception day marked the first time a Lumberjack had a pair of INTs in the same game since Khalil Dorsey in 2018. Vest also added a pair of tackles to his stat sheet.

SPECIAL TEAMS

K - JACKSON CLEAVER - EWU

Cleaver stepped in for injured Seth Harrison and delivered eight points in EWU's 34-28 victory over Montana. Cleaver connected on kicks of 32 and 30, with the 30-yarder coming with under two minutes left in the game. Cleaver booted seven kickoffs on the day, averaging 57.1 per attempt for the Eagles. The freshman kicker was also a perfect 2-of-2 on PATs.



>> NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE <<

TRIO NAMED SEMIFINALISTS FOR WILLIAM V. CAMPBELL TROPHY

• Montana's Dylan Cook, Montana State's Troy Andersen and NAU's DJ Arnson were named semifinalists for the 2021 William V. Campbell Trophy this past week by the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF).

• The William V. Campbell Trophy, college football's premier scholar-athlete award, released its list of 176 semifinalists last week with the trio from the Big Sky comprising three of just 36 nominees from the FCS.

• The NFF will announce 12-14 finalists on Oct. 27, and each of them will receive an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship as a member of the 2021 NFF National Scholar-Athlete Class Presented by Fidelity Investments.

#FEARTHEFCS #FEARTHEBIGSKY

• The Big Sky has flexed its muscle this season against FBS foes, as the league has knocked off four teams from the FBS.

• The four FBS victories are the most for the league since 2012, while the pair of Power 5 wins earned by NAU and Montana over Arizona and Washington are the most ever for the conference.

NAU SHOCKS ARIZONA

• NAU overcame a 13-0 deficit to top Arizona 21-19 and earn their first win against the Wildcats since 1932. The FBS win was the third for NAU since 2010, with the Lumberjacks besting UTEP in 2018 and UNLV in 2012.

• NAU became just the third FCS team in 670 games to overcome a 10-point deficit against an FBS foe and win. The other two wins came from Jacksonville State in 2010 against Ole Miss (trailed 21 points) and in 2021 against Florida State (trailed 10 points).

• NAU was honored as the Stats Perform National Team of the Week for its efforts, joining Montana as the only other Big Sky squad to earn the honor this year.

RANKED FBS WINS FOR BIG SKY

• Montana upset No. 20 Washington to open the 2021 season, as the Griz put the nation on notice. The ranked FBS victory was just the second overall for the Big Sky and first since EWU upset No. 25 Oregon State back in 2013. Additionally, there have only been six total ranked FBS wins for the FCS, with the last being North Dakota State's win over No. 13 Iowa in 2016.

FIRST WIN OVER UW FOR MONTANA SINCE 1920

• Entering its game at FBS-foe Washington, Montana was 1-17-1 all-time against UW with its last win coming in 1920 against the Huskies. The victory over the Pac-12 foe was the first for Montana since 1996, and the first FBS overall for the Griz since 2003.

EWU ADDS TO FBS WIN TOTAL

• Eastern Washington downed UNLV in double overtime on Sept. 2. EWU is no stranger to FBS upsets however, as the Eagles have earned 11 total for their storied history. EWU has earned six of its FBS wins since 2000, which is the most for the Big Sky during that time.

UC DAVIS KNOCKS OFF AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE FOE

• UC Davis topped FBS and American Athletic Conference member Tulsa to open the year. The win was the first for a Big Sky team over an AAC member. The victory for UC Davis was its fourth FBS win since its current Division I era that began in 2007.
