## >> WEEK 3 STORYLINES <<



• The Big Sky had five teams ranked in the Top 15 of both national polls this week, which is believed to be the first time ever for the conference in both polls. Montana led the way for the league, ranked fourth and fifth overall.



• No. 8 Weber State will host No. 2 James Madison on Saturday, which will go down as the biggest FCS non-conference game of the year. It will be the farthest travel west for a game in JMU's history.



• EWU won its 18th-straight home game last weekend, which is the second-longest active streak in the FCS behind only James Madison's 19-straight home wins.



• UC Davis rolled over San Diego 53-7, as the Aggies took home both the Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week honors. It was the second-straight week for QB Hunter Rodriguez to win the offensive honor.



• Northern Colorado defeated Houston Baptist 45-13 on the road last Saturday, which was the first Bear win since its 26-20 win over Idaho State on Nov. 2, 2019. The win also marked the first collegiate victory for head coach Ed McCaffrey.



• With over 600 days between home games, Montana State got into the win column with a 45-7 victory over Drake last Saturday. The win also marked the first collegiate victory for head coach Brent Vigen.

>> NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE <<

**UCD SWEEPS WEEKLY HONORS**

• UC Davis QB Hunter Rodrigues repeated his ROOT Sports Big Sky Offensive Player of the Week award while backup quarterback Trent Tompkins captured the league's Special Teams Player of the Week nod, both for their contributions in Saturday's 53-7 win at San Diego.

• Rodrigues posted career highs for passing yards (322) and touchdowns (4), spreading 27 completions to nine different targets, and ran in a TD as well.

• Tompkins returned a punt 85 yards for a TD, which is the longest in the FCS so far this season, while catching four passes for 52 yards, 15 yards on the ground and another TD. He also converted a pair of two-point conversions on the ground and through the air.

**EWU EXTENDS HOME WIN STREAK**

• Eastern Washington blew past Central Washington in its home opener, as the Eagles took a 63-14 decision.

• The home win is EWU's 18-straight at Roos Field, which is the second-longest active streak in the country behind only James Madison at 19-straight home wins.

• EWU is now 61-10 overall at "The Inferno" since 2010. The stadium has been known as Roos Field since 2010 when a new red synthetic Sprinturf surface made its debut. Eastern's last home loss came on Nov. 4, 2017, versus Weber State.

• EWU has more than doubled its opponents 940-407 at home during the current win streak. The margin of victory in 14 of the 18 games has been at least 21 points, nine of them have been by at least 30, four by 40 or more and a pair have been won by at least 50 points (52 and 53, both versus Cal Poly).

**#FEARTHEFCS STRIKES AGAIN**

• Three Big Sky teams will have their sights set on FBS upsets this week, as the league looks to continue #FearTheFCS this Saturday.

**VIGEN, MCCAFFREY EARN WINS**

• Montana State's Brent Vigen and Northern Colorado's Ed McCaffrey each earned their first collegiate head coaching wins last week. MSU downed Drake 45-7 for Vigen's first victory, while UNC defeated Houston Baptist 45-13 to give McCaffrey his first.

**HAUCK GETS 100TH WIN AT UM**

• Montana's Bobby Hauck earned his 100th career win at UM last Saturday, as the Griz defeated Western Illinois 42-7.

• Hauck's 100 wins at UM are the most by any active Big Sky head coach at their current school, while his 115 career wins are the second-most among active Big Sky head coaches overall, behind UC Davis' Dan Hawkins who owns 136 for his 20-year career.

**SHAHEED TIES FCS KOR RECORD**

• After his 100-yard kickoff return for a score at Utah, Weber State's Rashid Shaheed broke the Big Sky career record for most KO return TDs with six and tied the FCS career mark. Shaheed is tied with Jerome Mathis of Hampton, who also returned six kickoffs for scores from 2001-04.

• Furthermore, Shaheed is the only FCS player to have a 100-yard kickoff return touchdown in each of the last two years.

**OFFENSE**

QB - HUNTER RODRIGUES - UC DAVIS



Rodriguez wins his second weekly honor of the young season, after the quarterback threw a career-high 322 yards passing in the 53-7 victory at San Diego this past Saturday. Rodriguez tossed four touchdowns, while running one in on the ground, to keep his touchdown-to-interception ratio at a perfect 5-0 for the season.

**DEFENSE**

LB - DAVID HOAGE - UNC



Hoage earned his first Defensive Player of the Week honor after wreaking havoc for the Bears in their 45-13 win at Houston Baptist. The sophomore had eight tackles, four for loss, three sacks, three quarterback hurries and recovered two fumbles. All five stats listed were career highs for the Denver native.

**SPECIAL TEAMS**

PR - TRENT TOMPKINS - UC DAVIS



Tompkins did a little bit of everything for UC Davis this past Saturday, as the red-shirt freshman returned an 85-yard punt return for a touchdown, ran for 15 yards and another score, while also catching four passes for 52 yards. The 85-yard punt return score is the longest in the FCS so far this season. The quarterback also converted a pair of two-point conversions for the Aggies in the 53-7 victory over San Diego.

**RANKED FBS WINS FOR BIG SKY**

- The biggest of those three wins came when Montana upset No. 20 Washington, as the Griz put the nation on notice. The ranked FBS victory was just the second overall for the Big Sky and first since EWU upset No. 25 Oregon State back in 2013. Additionally, there have only been six total ranked FBS wins for the FCS, with the last being North Dakota State's win over No. 13 Iowa in 2016.

**FIRST WIN OVER UW FOR MONTANA SINCE 1920**

- Entering its game at FBS-foe Washington, Montana was 1-17-1 all-time against UW with its last win coming in 1920 against the Huskies. The victory over the Pac-12 foe was the first for Montana since 1996, and the first FBS overall for the Griz since 2003.

**EWU ADDS TO FBS WIN TOTAL**

- Eastern Washington downed UNLV in double overtime on Sept. 2. EWU is no stranger to FBS upsets however, as the Eagles have earned 11 total for their storied history. EWU has earned six of its FBS wins since 2000, which is the most for the Big Sky during that time.

**UC DAVIS KNOCKS OFF AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONF. FOE**

- UC Davis topped FBS and American Athletic Conference member Tulsa to open the year. The win was the first for a Big Sky team over an AAC member. The victory for UC Davis was its fourth FBS win since its current Division I era that began in 2007.

**BACK TO FOOTBALL**

- Just 126 days will separate the end of the spring season on April 24, 2021 and the start of the fall campaign officially on Aug. 28, 2021. The fall will also mark the first game action for Montana State (Dec. 21, 2019), Northern Colorado (Nov. 23, 2019) and Sacramento State (Dec. 7, 2019) in nearly two years. Northern Colorado has spent the most time away from live game action, with last contest for the Bears coming 650 days ago.

**WELCOME TO THE BIG SKY**

- Montana State and Northern Colorado each made new hires at head coach following the 2019 season. MSU hired Brent Vigen as the program's 33rd head coach on Feb. 8, 2021. UNC hired Ed McCaffrey as the program's 16th head coach on Dec. 12, 2019.

**BARRIERE, WALKER NAMED BIG SKY PRESEASON MVPs**

- QB Eric Barriere of EWU and LB Tre Walker of Idaho were tabbed as the league's Preseason MVPs ahead of the 2021 season. Barriere earned the offensive honor, while Walker was picked on the defensive side.

- Barriere, who is now a back-to-back Preseason Offensive MVP, earned All-America honors from six different publications following the spring season, along with being the FCS ADA and Big Sky Offensive Player of the Year. Additionally, he was one of three finalists for the Walter Payton Award.

- Walker finished Idaho's 2021 spring campaign with 54 total tackles, splitting evenly at 27 between solo and assisted. That resulted in him being named to five different All-American teams, along with being named a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award. He also racked up 4.5 tackles for loss on the season.
