>> WEEK 4 STORYLINES <<



• The Big Sky had five teams ranked in the Top 15 once again of both national polls this past week, which is believed to be the first time ever for the conference. Montana led the way for the league, ranked fourth overall.



• Undefeated UC Davis travels to defending Big Sky champ Weber State this week, marking the ranked conference matchup of the year. The Aggies are ranked 10th and 12th in both polls, while the Wildcats are 14th and 15th.



• Northern Arizona knocked off Arizona last week, which marks the fourth FBS win this year for the Big Sky. The four FBS wins are the most for the league since 2012.



• Following NAU's upset of Arizona and Montana's win at Washington, the Big Sky has now defeated two Power 5 teams in the same year for the first time ever.



• EWU's Eric Barriere passed for 487 of his career-high 542 passing yards in the first half of Saturday's 62-56 win, which broke the FCS record for most passing yards in a single half held by Old Dominion's Taylor Heinicke in 2012 (480).



• The Montana at Eastern Washington showdown on Oct. 2 will now be carried nationally on ESPN2. The matchup will mark the first regular-season game for the Big Sky Conference to air on ESPN2.

>> NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE <<

#FEARTHEFCS #FEARTHEBIGSKY

• The Big Sky has flexed its muscle this season against FBS foes, as the league has knocked off four teams from the FBS.

• The four FBS victories are the most for the league since 2012, while the pair of Power 5 wins earned by NAU and Montana over Arizona and Washington are the most ever for the conference.

BARRIERE BREAKS FCS RECORD

• EWU's Eric Barriere showed why he is one of the most exciting players in the FCS after Barriere passed for 487 of his career-high 542 passing yards in the first half of Saturday's 62-56 win at Western Illinois, which broke the FCS record for most passing yards in a single half.

• Barriere also tossed six touchdowns, which was one shy of tying his own school record and marked his fourth game with at least six scores.

• Barriere was named the Big Sky Offensive Player of the Week and earned the National Offensive Player of the Week honor from Stats Perform.

NAU SHOCKS ARIZONA

• Northern Arizona overcame a 13-0 deficit to top Arizona 21-19 and earn their first win against the Wildcats since 1932. The FBS win was the third for NAU since 2010, with the Lumberjacks besting UTEP in 2018 and UNLV in 2012.

• NAU was honored as the Stats Perform National Team of the Week for its efforts, joining Montana as the only other Big Sky squad to earn the honor this year.

BIG SKY DEFENSE

• The Big Sky has two players ranking as the best in the FCS for a pair of notable defensive categories this week.

• Portland State's VJ Malo is tied for the lead in sacks with 5.5 this year, while Northern Colorado's David Hoage has racked up 8.0 tackles for loss to top the FCS.

EWU EXTENDS HOME WIN STREAK

• Eastern Washington blew past Central Washington in its home opener, as the Eagles took a 63-14 decision.

• The home win is EWU's 18-straight at Roos Field, which is the second-longest active streak in the country behind only James Madison at 19-straight home wins.

• EWU is now 61-10 overall at "The Inferno" since 2010. The stadium has been known as Roos Field since 2010 when a new red synthetic Sprinturf surface made its debut. Eastern's last home loss came on Nov. 4, 2017, versus Weber State.

• EWU has more than doubled its opponents 940-407 at home during the current win streak. The margin of victory in 14 of the 18 games has been at least 21 points, nine of them have been by at least 30, four by 40 or more and a pair have been won by at least 50 points (52 and 53, both versus Cal Poly).

SHAHEED TIES FCS KOR RECORD

• After his 100-yard kickoff return for a score at Utah, Weber State's Rashid Shaheed broke the Big Sky career record for most KO return TDs with six and tied the FCS career mark. Shaheed is tied with Jerome Mathis of Hampton, who also returned six kickoffs for scores from 2001-04.

• Furthermore, Shaheed is the only FCS player to have a 100-yard kickoff return touchdown in each of the last two years.

OFFENSE

QB - ERIC BARRIERE - EWU



Barriere wins his second weekly honor of the young season, after passing for 487 of his career-high 542 passing yards in the first half of Saturday's 62-56 win at Western Illinois, which broke the FCS record for most yards in a single half. Barriere also tossed six touchdowns, which was one shy of tying his own school record and marked his fourth game with at least six scores.

DEFENSE

DB - HUNTER BEEMILLER - NAU



Beemiller earned his first Player of the Week honor of the year, as he was instrumental in NAU's 21-19 upset at Arizona. Beemiller finished the game with 10 tackles, 4.5 for loss, a forced fumble and a QB hurry to lead a Lumberjack defense that forced three Wildcat turnovers.

SPECIAL TEAMS

P - DJ ARNSON



Arnson earned his first Player of the Week honor of the year, as he was instrumental in NAU's 21-19 upset at Arizona. Arnson averaged 51.6 yards per punt on nine attempts, with six punts going over 50 yards and three landing inside the 20-yard line. Arnson's longest punt of the day came on his last kick, going 62 yards to put the Wildcats at their own 15-yard line with 4:30 left in the game.



>> NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE <<

RANKED FBS WINS FOR BIG SKY

• Montana upset No. 20 Washington to open the 2021 season, as the Griz put the nation on notice. The ranked FBS victory was just the second overall for the Big Sky and first since EWU upset No. 25 Oregon State back in 2013. Additionally, there have only been six total ranked FBS wins for the FCS, with the last being North Dakota State's win over No. 13 Iowa in 2016.

FIRST WIN OVER UW FOR MONTANA SINCE 1920

• Entering its game at FBS-foe Washington, Montana was 1-17-1 all-time against UW with its last win coming in 1920 against the Huskies. The victory over the Pac-12 foe was the first for Montana since 1996, and the first FBS overall for the Griz since 2003.

EWU ADDS TO FBS WIN TOTAL

• Eastern Washington downed UNLV in double overtime on Sept. 2. EWU is no stranger to FBS upsets however, as the Eagles have earned 11 total for their storied history. EWU has earned six of its FBS wins since 2000, which is the most for the Big Sky during that time.

UC DAVIS KNOCKS OFF AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE FOE

• UC Davis topped FBS and American Athletic Conference member Tulsa to open the year. The win was the first for a Big Sky team over an AAC member. The victory for UC Davis was its fourth FBS win since its current Division I era that began in 2007.

BACK TO FOOTBALL

• Just 126 days will separate the end of the spring season on April 24, 2021 and the start of the fall campaign officially on Aug. 28, 2021. The fall will also mark the first game action for Montana State (Dec. 21, 2019), Northern Colorado (Nov. 23, 2019) and Sacramento State (Dec. 7, 2019) in nearly two years. Northern Colorado has spent the most time away from live game action, with last contest for the Bears coming 650 days ago.

WELCOME TO THE BIG SKY

• Montana State and Northern Colorado each made new hires at head coach following the 2019 season. MSU hired Brent Vigen as the program's 33rd head coach on Feb. 8, 2021. UNC hired Ed McCaffrey as the program's 16th head coach on Dec. 12, 2019.

BARRIERE, WALKER NAMED BIG SKY PRESEASON MVPS

• QB Eric Barriere of EWU and LB Tre Walker of Idaho were tabbed as the league's Preseason MVPs ahead of the 2021 season. Barriere earn the offensive honor, while Walker was picked on the defensive side.

• Barriere, who is now a back-to-back Preseason Offensive MVP, earned All-America honors from six different publications following the spring season, along with being the FCS ADA and Big Sky Offensive Player of the Year. Additionally, he was one of three finalists for the Walter Payton Award.

• Walker finished Idaho's 2021 spring campaign with 54 total tackles, splitting evenly at 27 between solo and assisted. That resulted in him being named to five different All-American teams, along with being named a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award. He also racked up 4.5 tackles for loss on the season.
